

General Information

ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Booking Direct with Silversea gives you peace of mind. Our local tour operators are fully insured and have been comprehensively vetted. In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Looking for a special program with your travelling companions? In a nod to our Italian heritage, let us reserve for you our Silver Shore "Privato" service - a private vehicle with driver and/or guide. Create your own itinerary or leave it to us. This service is available in most ports which you can reserve on MySilversea (my.silversea.com) or at the Shore Concierge desk onboard for a truly tailor-made arrangement. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore excursions must be purchased on or before the booking deadline for each port of call. Tours are available on a first-come, firstserved basis; some tours are very popular with guests often ending up being wait-listed: in order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com from 120 - 7 days prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate on excursions are subject to space availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. Please note that certain shore excursions may have different reservation deadlines and may incur cancellation fees if cancelled after the deadline. Unless otherwise indicated in the tour description for a particular shore excursion a 100% cancellation fee will be charged for shore excursions cancelled within 48 hours of the scheduled start time. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge desk within the cancellation deadline period.

ONLINE ADVANCE RESERVATION OF SHORE EXCURSIONS

For those of you that are not aware, at Silversea you can pre-reserve your excursions at leisure prior to your journey on the internet, log on to MySilversea (my.silversea.com) up to 7 days prior to your sailing date. If you have pre-reserved your excursions on line, your tickets will be delivered to your suite upon embarkation and all charges will be billed to your shipboard account.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

Once on board, you may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a consolidated tour booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the tours in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Tour tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

SHORE EXCURSION PRICING

Prices are generally quoted per person, per tour, with the exception of Silver Shore Privato or group-designated excursions. Prices are subject to change without notice. Please visit MySilversea (my.silversea.com) for the most up-to-date information. Discounts for children under 12 years of age are available on some, but not all tours. Prices for children, if available, will be adjusted onboard. Please meet with the Shore Concierge team prior to your excursion to discuss the availability of children's pricing.

ON-TIME TOUR DEPARTURES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, tour departures generally will not be announced unless there is an unforeseen change. Departure times from the ship are published in the ships daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicle. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least ten minutes prior to the tour departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pier-side to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore.

Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and tour departures as local conditions dictate. Please note that pier departure times are also listed in MySilversea (my.silversea.com)

TOUR SUITABILITY

At Silversea we offer a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. Some excursions are decidedly only for the physically fit and active guest. Each excursion offered is clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain you're selecting excursions that meet your physical capability. We therefore encourage guests to review the tour description carefully including the PLEASE NOTE section which includes useful information and attend the port talks onboard. ONBOARD SHORE CONCIERGE TEAM

Whether you wish to participate in an organised shore excursion or bespoke tailor-made tour, Silversea's experienced Shore Concierge team are happy to assist you in ensuring your shore- side experiences are nothing less than a memory that lasts forever.

The Shore Concierge team is available onboard on sea days from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Office opening hours in port may vary whilst staff is shore-side assisting you on tour. Please refer to the Silversea Chronicle for daily office opening hours.

When contemplating a tailor-made program onboard, please contact the Shore Concierge team as early as possible at the beginning of your cruise, as time may be a factor in reaching local contacts. Please be aware that once arrangements have been confirmed, 100% cancellation fee will be applied. Unfortunately, we are unable to change or cancel airline tickets, car rental, hotel or any other reservations you made previously with your travel agent or on your own. In many ports of call there may be a local hospitality representative on board to provide additional information, for two hours after the ship's arrival. In some ports, local information may be found in the tourist information centre ashore.

PORT TALKS

Throughout your cruise we'll be offering Port & Shore Excursion information given by our Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant prior to arrival in each port of call. Our aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and many of your questions about our ports of call will be answered in these briefings, giving you more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port. The information is presented in the theater or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicle. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. To ensure the safety of our younger guests, children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service, if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment, to accommodate a child. Such harnesses' and secure seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

GRATUITIES

Gratuities for local guides and drivers are not included in the excursion price. It is customary to tip tour guides and drivers. Such gratuities if extended, should be done so on a voluntary, individual basis.

MOBILE TELEPHONES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, kindly refrain from using mobile telephones while on tour so as not to interfere with the guide's explanation. Most tours make frequent stops, allowing time for guests to use their mobile telephones. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.

SMOKING

For reasons of safety and comfort, smoking is not permitted on any tour vehicles used by Silversea. Your understanding in this matter is appreciated.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY CHARGES



Piraeus (Athens) - Greece

PIR-C / ACROPOLIS & ITS MUSEUM (FOR IN-TRANSIT GUESTS)

Price: \$89; Duration: 5.00 hrs

Journey back in time to Ancient Greece during this scenic, half-day excursion to the Acropolis, and a sightseeing drive through historic Athens. Scenic Drive through Athens

Depart the pier for the approximate 30-minute drive to Athens. Upon arrival, begin your sightseeing tour of the city. Pass by the Olympic Stadium, home of the first modern-day Olympic Games in 1896, the former Royal Palace at Constitution Square and Syntagma Square, home of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. After seeing these and other ancient and contemporary sites, proceed to the Acropolis.

Acropolis

Upon arrival, climb the smooth marble steps of the Acropolis. After passing through the Propylaea, the entrance to the complex of buildings, view the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erectheum and its classical Porch of Maidens, the Caryatids. From here, visit the Parthenon, considered the world's most perfect example of classical architecture. Looking down from the Acropolis, see the ancient Greek theatre of Dionyssos and the ancient Roman theatre of Herod Atticus.

Acropolis Museum

After visiting the Acropolis, take a stroll to the nearby Acropolis Museum, which features approximately 150,696 square feet (about 14,000 square metres) of exhibition space. Here, the treasures from the previous museum area are displayed alongside other surviving antiquities discovered from the remains of an ancient Athenian city that is visible through the museum's glass floor. Following your guided visit, commence the approximate 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately three hours, at times over uneven and slippery paths, with 80 steps to negotiate at the Acropolis. This tour is not suitable for quests with limited mobility and quests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing and non-slip, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sunscreen, a hat and sunglasses from the ship. Please be aware that ongoing restoration work is often carried out at the Acropolis. Security restrictions at the museum prohibit entrance with large bags or backpacks; flash photography is not permitted inside. The museum visit is by appointment only. Expect lines and crowds at the Acropolis and museum. The tour sequence and timeline may vary. The tour requires a minimum amount of participants to operate.

October 10 2018, Wednesday Limassol - Cyprus

LIM-A / ACCESSIBLE OMODHOS

Price:\$139; Duration:4.00 hrs

Explore the ancient history and architecture of Cyprus during this scenic, half-day accessible sightseeing excursion to Omodhos. Omodhos

Depart the pier in your accessible vehicle and drive to Omodhos, one of the most picturesque villages in Cyprus located in the heart of the wine region. Upon arrival, visit the Monastery of the Holy Cross, which features excellent wood-carvings and icons, then proceed for a look at the old wine press and a wine tasting.

Afterward, some free time is made available to explore the village at your leisure. Take a stroll through the narrow streets, and see some of the old houses and artisans who are renowned for their stained glass work. In the village square, you can stop in at one of the many coffee shops for refreshments. Your tour concludes with an approximate 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour is designed for guests who utilise a wheelchair and those who have walking limitations. A specially equipped vehicle is utilised for this programme to accommodate wheelchairs and scooters. The capacity of this tour is limited. A strict dress code is observed at the churches in Cyprus. Women must cover their shoulders and knees; no shorts or short skirts are permitted inside. The order of sights visited may vary. Guests must be at least 21 years of age to consume alcohol on this tour.

LIM-B / PAPHOS MOSAICS & THE TOMBS OF THE KINGS

DIFFICULTY

Price:\$89: Duration:4.50 hrs

Experience the ancient grandeur of Cyprus during this scenic and memorable visit to Aphrodite's Rock, the Tombs of the Kings, and picturesque Paphos.

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately one-hour drive to Petra tou Romiou, or 'Aphrodite's Rock'. En route, a photo stop is made as you pass through the citrus groves and vineyards of the Phassouri Plantations.

Petra tou Romiou

Legend claims that Aphrodite, Goddess of Beauty and Love, was born from the sea foam and carried by waves to this spot. In the ancient Greek civilisation, the cult of Aphrodite, the 'Cypriot Goddess', was undeniably the most important. Archaeological evidence and inscriptions throughout Cyprus bear witness to the numerous sanctuaries and temples dedicated to her.

Next, re-board your coach for a brief exterior visit to the Church of St. Solomoni before continuing on to the Tombs of the Kings.

Tombs of the Kinas

Located northwest of Paphos, this necropolis (burial site) dates from the 3rd-century B.C. and features open, peristyle courtyards surrounded by burial chambers.

Paphos

Leaving the tombs, your tour concludes with a visit to Paphos. This small harbour town and popular holiday resort is among the most beautiful places on the island, and served as the ancient capital of Cypress in Hellenistic and Roman times. Today, the entire town is designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

House of Dionysos

Next the tour heads to the House of Dionysos, to see the breathtaking mosaics unearthed during the excavation of a 3rd century AD Roman nobleman's villa. The mosaics depict Roman legends with scenes from Greek mythology and are considered to be some of the finest in the region.

Afterward re-board the coach for the approximately one-hour return drive to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking and is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and those who utilise a wheelchair.

LIM-D / CYPRUS QUAD BIKE ADVENTURE

Price:\$159; Duration:6.00 hrs

Experience the thrill and adventure of discovering Cyprus by quad bike during this full-day tour.

Depart the pier for the approximate one hour drive via Kissonerga Village, to Coral Beach where your adventure begins. After receiving a safety briefing, mount your very own quad bike and head off-road to places some people do not even know exists. Your ride will take you into the hills of Paphos, its dusty, its dirty, but the best way to experience the countryside.

The quad bikes are easy to handle as you follow your guide along the trail that leads you to visit the Sea Caves and St. Georges Church. After, drive to Lara Bay which is a very famous breeding place for sea turtles. It is here that a stop will be made to enjoy the view, swim in the bay and relax with a light snack and beverage.

Following your free time at the beach, remount your quad for the exciting return ride to the base via Avagas Gorge. Your transport back to Limasol will end your fantastic outing that combines exploration with pure adrenaline.

Please note: This tour involves moderate to extensive levels of physical activity and is recommended for guests who are in good physical condition. This tour is not recommended for guests who may suffer from back / neck problems, asthma, heart conditions or those who may be pregnant. Closed-toe shoes, sun protection, and a swimsuit worn under your seasonal clothing are recommended. Guests are also advised to bring a towel from the ship.

LIM-E / KOLOSSI CASTLE, ANCIENT KOURION & LIMASSOL'S OLD TOWN

Price: \$89; Duration: 4.75 hrs


Explore the ancient treasures of Limassol and its surrounds during this picturesque, half-day sightseeing excursion.

Phassouri and Kolossi Castle

Depart the pier for the short, scenic drive through the citrus groves and vineyards of Phassouri en route to the Kolossi Castle. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of this 12th-century castle and learn about is history. Leaving the castle, re-board your coach and head for a visit to the Temple of Apollo, erected in honour of the ancient Greek god. The southwest side of the temple has been restored, and excavations have also revealed other structures in this important sanctuary, such as the Bath Complex, Pilgrims Halls, 'Paliastra' and a Holy Precinct.









Kourion and Greco-Roman Theatre

Next, proceed to the remains of the ancient city of Kourion. This impressive, Greco-Roman site features wonderfully-preserved floor mosaics, including the fine, four-panel design in the central room of the House of Eustolios. Nearby, visit the superb Greco-Roman Theatre, which was built in the 2nd century B.C. and is still used for performances today. This beautiful, unspoilt site is perched high on a cliff, and offers a dazzling panoramic view of the ruins and sea below.

Old Town of Limassol

Your last stop is at the Old Town of Limassol. Here, ample free time is made available to browse for local and international items, including jewellery, leather goods, souvenirs, clothing, and local artefacts. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board the coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.68 miles (about 1.1 kilometres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 5-10 steps at the sites visited. Walking in Limassol's Old Town is at the discretion of each guest. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Guests must be at least two years old to participate on this tour.

LIM-F / LARNACA & LEFKARA

Price:\$79; Duration:4.75 hrs

Enjoy the traditions and culture of Cyprus during this half-day tour.

Larnaca

Depart the pier for the approximate 1-hour drive to Larnaca. The modern city of Larnaca is built on the site of the ancient kingdom of Kition, birthplace of the philosopher Zenon, founder of the Stoic School of Thought. Larnaca's other famous historic resident was none other than Lazarus who having been raised from the dead by Jesus chose to spend his second life in Kition later being ordained the town's bishop by the apostles Barnabas and Mark.

Your tour today will start with a visit to the church of St. Lazarus; this magnificent stone edifice was built in the 9th century by the byzantine emperor Leon the Wise and restored in the 17th century. The original church had 3 domes and it is still one of the most remarkable examples of byzantine architecture on the island, the tomb of St Lazarus can be seen under the sanctuary.

Then take a leisurely stroll around the fascinating old town of Larnaca and along the famous 'Foinikoudes' promenade and enjoy some free time.

Lefkara

Leaving Larnaca, travel to the picturesque village of Lefkara famous for its 'lefkaritika' lace work and its silverware. The lace making tradition goes back to the medieval period and legend has it that Leonardo da Vinci himself visited the village during the Venetian era and bought an altar cloth of the traditional lace which he donated to Milan Cathedral. The village today retains its original architecture and is a maze of winding alleys begging to be explored. You will also see the village women sitting outside their houses and working on their embroidery as their ancestors have done for generations.

Following this visit, re-join your coach for the return drive to Limassol and your awaiting ship.

Please note: Tour involves minimal to moderate walking and is suitable for guests with limited mobility. It is recommended that guests dress in seasonal clothing and wear flat walking shoes. Conservative attire is required to enter the religious venues in this programme; shoulders and knees must be covered and shorts are not permitted.

LIM-G / GOLF - APHRODITE HILLS



DIFFICULTY

Price:\$299; Duration:5.50 hrs

Enjoy a round of play at Aphrodite Hills. The first ever leisure and golf development of its kind in Cyprus, Aphrodite Hills Resort is home to a magnificent 18-hole championship golf course, spreading over 6,299 metres and overlooking the site where Aphrodite, the goddess of love, is said to have emerged from the sea.

The golf course also has a dedicated 3-hole Golf Academy and magnificent Clubhouse. This award-winning golf course was officially opened in 2002 and was designed by the acclaimed architect, Cabell Robinson. Robinson believes Aphrodite Hills to be the perfect mix of challenging pot bunkers, manicured fairways of lush Bermuda grass and generous tiered greens. Visually spectacular, the course expands through indigenous olive and carob trees and is built on two plateau separated by a dramatic ravine with outstanding views over the Mediterranean. A 130 meter gorge dividing tees at the par 3, the 7th hole is the perfect opportunity to put your skills to the test.

Depart the pier for the approximate 30-minute transfer to the golf resort. Upon arrival, check-in at the pro shop and secure any rentals you wish to hire.

Upon completion of your round of golf, your driver will be waiting to return you to the pier and your awaiting ship.

Please note: Tour included roundtrip transfers, green fees and ½ shared cart. Rental clubs are available at the pro shop for a fee of €52,00 and must be requested in advance. Proper golf attire is required. This programme must be confirmed a minimum of 30-days prior to arrival. Cathedral of St. John

Depart the pier for the short drive to Archbishop Kyprianos Square. Upon arrival, proceed to the renowned Cathedral of St. John. Located adjacent to the Palace of the Archbishop, the Cathedral of St. John was constructed in 1665, and features lovely, picturesque frescoes. Following a cathedral visit and comfort stop, some free time is made available to explore your surroundings before re-boarding your coach for the transfer to Eleftheria Square.

Eleftheria Square and Ledra Street

Also known as 'Freedom Square', Eleftheria Square is the main square of the city, and highlighted by the lovely City Hall, Post Office and Library. The square connects the old city with the new city, home to the main shopping streets such as the elegant Stasikratous Street, Themistokli Dervi Avenue and Makarios Avenue. Upon arrival at Eleftheria Square, take a guided stroll down Ledra Street en route to the check point. Located the middle of the walled city, Ledra Street has historically been the busiest shopping street of the capital. Ledra and its adjacent, narrow streets feature boutiques, bars and art-cafés, and connect the south and north parts of the Old City.

Northern Nicosia

Following the check point procedure, walk across the U.N.-controlled green line into northern Nicosia, a feat that was unimaginable not too long ago. Once in the north, a visit is made to Buyuk Han, the Cathedral of St. Sophia and the Old Marketplace. Some free time is made available on both sides of the green line for shopping and exploration. At the conclusion of your foray into the north, pass back through the check point, reboard your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

Labouris Winery and Omodhos

Apsiou Village

Following an early departure, your excursion begins with a 135-mile (216-kilometre) journey inland through rugged desert toward the foothills of Mount Sinai, site of St. Catherine's Monastery. This Greek Orthodox holy place is the oldest Christian monastery in the world, with ties going back to the prophet Moses and the exodus of the Jews from Egypt.

St. Catherine's Monastery

The monastic order was founded in the 4th century AD by the Byzantine empress Helena, who had a small chapel built next to what is believed to be the Burning Bush from which God spoke to Moses. The chapel is dedicated to St. Catherine, the legendary martyr of Alexandria. According to legend, her body was transported by angels to an area just south of Mount Sinai, where it was found some 300 years later by monks from the monastery. In the 6th century, Emperor Justinian ordered the building of a fortress, including a basilica and a monastery to serve as a refuge for the monks of St. Catherine's.

Today, the monastery is still in use and inhabited by Greek Orthodox monks. Despite its remote location, the monastery attracts a great number of visitors and pilgrims. Its attractive scenic location is in itself a highlight. Until a road was built, the only way to enter the monastery was by being hauled up the steep walls in a basket. The guided tour of the monastic complex includes viewing what is believed to be Moses' Burning Bush and visits to the chapel to admire a collection of icons and jeweled crosses, as well as to the Library Museum which contains an impressive collection of precious icons and manuscripts.

Leaving the monastery, re-join the coach and commence the return journey to Sharm-el-Sheikh.

Please note: This tour involves a 3-hour drive each way to reach St. Catherine's Monastery. It requires a moderate amount of walking for approximately 1640 yards (1500 meters) over paved and unpaved surfaces with an incline ramp, some cobblestones inside the monastery and various steps throughout. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility however not for those who utilize a wheelchair. Staff inside the Monastery will encourage guests to move quickly. Petra

Depart the port in comfortable coaches and travel north along the Desert Highway. The last stretch is on country road through several small villages. Upon arrival at Petra, begin your visit on foot, walk through the half-mile-long (800 metre) siq, or chasm. The long, narrow gorge with steeply rising sides all but obliterates the sun. For those who wish, the entrance to the siq may be reached on horseback - at your own risk. (There is no charge for this service but the horseman will expect a gratuity.)

Khazneh (Treasury)

As you exit the gorge, it suddenly opens into a natural square dominated by Petra's most famous monument, the Treasury. Its intricately carved façade presents a magnificent sight in the dazzling sun. If you have seen the movie Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade, you will no doubt recognize the façade. Follow the guide farther into the site and discover other impressive structures carved out of the rose-coloured stone. They include temples, royal tombs and an amphitheatre that could seat 3,000 spectators. The Petra basin boasts over 800 individual monuments; to explore it all would take several days.

Your visit of approximately three hours concludes with the walk back via the same way. Optionally, a horse-drawn buggy or carriage can be hired to take you through the narrow pathway of the Petra Valley. It is the only transportation permitted. Buggies/carriages are limited and cannot be reserved in advance. However, local staff will provide assistance. The charge is \$40 USD per two-person (at the time if printing) carriage to be paid on the spot. Be aware that you may have to wait in line. Each buggy carries two persons; the ride can be quite bumpy.

Afterwards, re-join the coach for the 2.5-hour drive back to Aqaba. Lunch and entrance fees are included.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking through the half-mile-long (800 metres) defile and within Petra; in total about 3 hours, much of it on uneven ground. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilize a wheelchair. Comfortable walking shoes are essential. Be aware that the weather is often unpredictable - it may be cool and windy among the rocks, but hot in open areas. Don't forget to bring a sweater or jacket for cool weather after sunset and remember your camera. We suggest you carry a bottle of water with you. The duration of the drive between the pier and Petra is approximately 1.5-2.5 hours in each direction. Restrooms are of local standard and may fall below Silversea expectations. This tour offers a unique Jordanian experience; a sense of adventure is required.

Wadi Rum

As you enter the Wadi Rum region, its captivating and mystical beauty will astound you. Black, wind-sculpted hills stand like sentinels upon pale sands, interspersed by dramatic rock formations. Drive past the Wadi Rum Rest House and a small Bedouin community with its prized possession - camels. Farther into the desert, you may be able to spot a few of the traditional black tents dotting the arid landscape.

This trip into the desert provides awesome and ever-changing vistas of multi-coloured granite and limestone cliffs rising amid the vast expanse of sand. Parts of Wadi Rum resemble a lunar landscape, aptly called the 'Valley of the Moon'. Here, the legend of Lawrence of Arabia was born. A rock formation known as The Seven Pillars of Wisdom was immortalised in the book and film about the legendary figure.

This Wadi Rum adventure concludes back at a Bedouin tent in the desert. Enjoy a cup of coffee or tea before heading back to Agaba and the ship by coach.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of activity and it is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. The desert drive is mostly over rugged and bumpy terrain and is not suitable for those with neck or back problems. We recommend light comfortable clothing, comfortable shoes, sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat or scarf. Shorts, skirts or revealing clothing are not recommended. AQJ-G / SHOUBAK CASTLE

Explore the grandeur and history of Jordan during this memorable, half-day excursion to Shoubak Castle. Depart the pier for the scenic, approximate two-hour drive through Agaba City and along the desert highway en route to Shoubak Castle. Located at the top of a hill north-east of the modern town of Shoubak in Jordan, this Crusader castle was originally known as 'Krak de Montreal', or 'Mont Real' (Montreal).











Shoubak Castle was erected in 1115 A.D. as the first of many fortifications built by King Baldwin I of Jerusalem to guard the road from Egypt to Damascus. Despite successfully rebuffing numerous sieges, the fortress finally fell in 1189, but was restored by the Mamluks in the 14th century.

Although little of the original fortifications remain today, the castle still features several original Crusader characteristics, and it is still possible to view some of the existing rooms and part of the tower. Upon arrival, stop by the Visitor's Centre to admire the remaining crusader features of the fortress. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board the coach and commence the approximately two-hour drive back to the pier.



In bygone days, export was done through caravan routes and by sea across the Indian Ocean, Today, Dhofar residents still use frankincense to add fragrance to their homes.

Take ashort walk and admire the 2-mile (3 kilometres) stretch of unspoilt, white sandy beach with steep cliffs at both ends. If your arrival coincides with the high tides, you may be able to witness the spectacular 'Blow Holes'shoot jets of water into the air. Next, depart Mughsail Beach towards town and the Al Husn Souq. See the lush vegetation the city is known for during the drive along the outskirts of Salalah.

Al Husn Souq

Take the time to stroll through the bazaar area and browse in the colourful shops and stalls. Marvel at displays of frankincense, spices, bottles of fragrant perfume oils, fabric, jewellery and a variety of fascinating artefacts. Most vendors here accept U.S. Dollars. Following the visit to the souq, travel into the Jubriah plain where a winding road takes you to the hillside location of Job's Tomb.

Job's Tomb

According to legend, the small mausoleum contains the remains of the Prophet Job. It is a sacred site of pilgrimage for Moslems, Christians and Jews. Take photos and admire the views of the striking Qara Mountains and the Jubriah plain below.

As you make your way back down, pass the walled complex of the Sultan's Palace. Photographs are only allowed from the coach.

Your tour concludes at the port to embark the ship.

Al Balid

The ancient city known as Dhufa grew in this area between the 12th and 16th centuries. Today, the ruins of this magnificent city can be seen at the Al Balid archaeological site in the Haffa district of Salalah. Dhufa was once surrounded by water and a massive wall complete with gates and turrets. There is evidence of a grand mosque, palaces, houses and tombs that indicate the historical standing of the area. There was a thriving export of frankincense and Arab horses to India and the Far East from Al Balid.

Enjoy a photo stop of the beautiful Grand Mosque with its exquisite art work and stained tiles.

Al Husn Palace

Next, drive through the grounds of the magnificent Al Husn Palace where photos can only be taken from the coach. The Palace is the personal residence of His Majesty, The Sultan of Oman.

Al Husn Souq

Lastly, stop at the Al Husn Souq and stroll among the vendors. The colourful stalls are heaped with mounds of frankincense, myrhh, incense, bottles of fragrant perfume oils and a large variety of fascinating artefacts.

Your tour concludes with a short ride back to the pier to embark the ship.
