

General Information

ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Booking Direct with Silversea gives you peace of mind. Our local tour operators are fully insured and have been comprehensively vetted. In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Looking for a special program with your travelling companions? In a nod to our Italian heritage, let us reserve for you our Silver Shore "Privato" service - a private vehicle with driver and/or guide. Create your own itinerary or leave it to us. This service is available in most ports which you can reserve on MySilversea (my.silversea.com) or at the Shore Concierge desk onboard for a truly tailor-made arrangement. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our quests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore excursions must be purchased on or before the booking deadline for each port of call. Tours are available on a first-come, first-served basis; some tours are very popular with guests often ending up being wait-listed: in order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com from 120 - 7 days prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate on excursions are subject to space availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. Please note that certain shore excursions may have different reservation deadlines and may incur cancellation fees if cancelled after the deadline. Unless otherwise indicated in the tour description for a particular shore excursion a 100% cancellation fee will be charged for shore excursions cancelled within 48 hours of the scheduled start time. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge desk within the cancellation deadline period.

ONLINE ADVANCE RESERVATION OF SHORE EXCURSIONS

For those of you that are not aware, at Silversea you can pre-reserve your excursions at leisure prior to your journey on the internet, log on to MySilversea (my.silversea.com) up to 7 days prior to your sailing date. If you have pre-reserved your excursions on line, your tickets will be delivered to your suite upon embarkation and all charges will be billed to your shipboard account.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

Once on board, you may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a consolidated tour booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the tours in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Tour tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

SHORE EXCURSION PRICING

Prices are generally quoted per person, per tour, with the exception of Silver Shore Privato or group-designated excursions. Prices are subject to change without notice. Please visit MySilversea (my.silversea.com) for the most up-to-date information. Discounts for children under 12 years of age are available on some, but not all tours. Prices for children, if available, will be adjusted onboard. Please meet with the Shore Concierge team prior to your excursion to discuss the availability of children's pricing.

ON-TIME TOUR DEPARTURES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, tour departures generally will not be announced unless there is an unforeseen change. Departure times from the ship are published in the ships daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicle. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least ten minutes prior to the tour departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pier-side to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore.

Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and tour departures as local conditions dictate. Please note that pier departure times are also listed in MySilversea (my.silversea.com)

TOUR SUITABILITY

At Silversea we offer a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. Some excursions are decidedly only for the physically fit and active guest. Each excursion offered is clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain you're selecting excursions that meet your physical capability. ONBOARD SHORE CONCIERGE TEAM

Whether you wish to participate in an organised shore excursion or bespoke tailor-made tour, Silversea's experienced Shore Concierge team are happy to assist you in ensuring your shore- side experiences are nothing less than a memory that lasts forever.

The Shore Concierge team is available onboard on sea days from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Office opening hours in port may vary whilst staff is shore-side assisting you on tour. Please refer to the Silversea Chronicle for daily office opening hours. When contemplating a tailor-made program onboard, please contact the Shore Concierge team as early as possible at the beginning of your cruise, as time may be a factor in reaching local contacts. Please be aware that once arrangements have been confirmed, 100% cancellation fee will be applied. Unfortunately, we are unable to change or cancel airline tickets, car rental, hotel or any other reservations you made previously with your travel agent or on your own. In many ports of call there may be a local hospitality representative on board to provide additional information, for two hours after the ship's arrival. In some ports, local information may be found in the tourist information centre ashore.

PORT TALKS

Throughout your cruise we'll be offering Port & Shore Excursion information given by our Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant prior to arrival in each port of call. Our aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and many of your questions about our ports of call will be answered in these briefings, giving you more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port. The information is presented in the theater or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicle. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. To ensure the safety of our younger guests, children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service, if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment, to accommodate a child. Such harnesses' and secure seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

GRATUITIES

Gratuities for local guides and drivers are not included in the excursion price. It is customary to tip tour guides and drivers. Such gratuities if extended, should be done so on a voluntary, individual basis.

MOBILE TELEPHONES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, kindly refrain from using mobile telephones while on tour so as not to interfere with the guide's explanation. Most tours make frequent stops, allowing time for guests to use their mobile telephones. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.

Casablanca - Morocco

CAS-A / CASABLANCA & THE GRAND MOSQUE DIFFICULTY

Price: \$99; Duration: 4.00 hrs

Experience the historic splendour and landmarks of Casablanca during this scenic, half-day sightseeing tour of the city.

Hassan II Mosque

Depart the pier and proceed to the awe-inspiring Hassan II Mosque. The Mosque is the second-largest mosque in the Islamic world. This magnificent building is both overwhelming in its grandeur and exquisite in its detail. The Mosque can hold 25,000 people and the foundations are built partly on land and partly over the water. Some of the ceilings are over 200 feet tall (70 metres), and a part of this amazing and sacred building has a retractable roof. The construction of the Mosque began in 1980 and was completed in 1993. From here, depart to another viewpoint of the mosque, looking along the coastline of the city the towering mosque appears to float on the sea.

A refreshment stop is then made at a local beach club restaurant on the Corniche and overlooking the ocean.

Panoramic Casablanca

After re-boarding the coach drive through the elegant residential district of Anfa, the original site of Casablanca, and a far cry from the hustle and bustle of this large commercial city. From here proceed to the New Medina, or 'Habous Quarter' for a short stroll through this historic part of

the city, lined with souks, shops, and a warren of alleyways. Your tour concludes with a stop at Mohammed V Square where you will see examples of many Moslem-styled buildings, a monumental fountain, a public garden and the statue of Marshal Lyautey.

Time permitting; a stop is made here for time at leisure before re-boarding the coach for the return drive to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking, and is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. The tour sequence may vary. During Saturday or Sunday visits, only exterior visits are permitted at the Mahakma Traditional Court Palace. Conservative dress is required for the interior visit to the Mosque - men must have long pants and shoulders covered, and women must have minimum knee length garments and their shoulders covered.

CAS-B / THE FORTRESS CITY OF RABAT

DIFFICULTY

The stunning beauty and architecture of Morocco is yours to discover during this sightseeing tour of Rabat, a newly designated UNESCO World Heritage site.

Enchanting City of Rabat

Depart the pier for the 1.5-hour drive to the city of Rabat. Sitting on the Atlantic coastal plain, Rabat is the capital city of Morocco. This modern city is filled with wide boulevards, gardens, and white buildings. A far cry from the hectic warrens of the other Imperial cities of Marrakech and Fes, but no less steeped in history, its origins date back to the 7th Century. This enchanting city is home to many historic monuments and has some superbly preserved relics of its Moorish past.

Mohammed V Mausoleum & Kasbah Oudaya

Your first stop will be at the ornate Mausoleum of Mohammed V, which was completed in 1971 and contains the tombs of the late Moroccan king and his two sons. This site is an architectural marvel and a monument that is truly a final resting place fit for a king. Re-board the coach for a drive past the Royal Palace, before moving on to explore la Kasbah Oudaya. Here, you will experience a taste of a traditional medina in Morocco. Meander down the hill slope to the colourful Andalusian Gardens to enjoy a cup of tea overlooking the river and the city of Sale.

The coach continues on a tour of several architectural highlights and a panoramic view of the Chellah Fortress before returning to the pier in Casablanca.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking and it is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and those who utilise a wheelchair. Morocco being a Muslim country, recommend modest attire - covered shoulders, long pants, comfortable shoes.

CAS-C / PORTUGUESE TOWN OF EL JADIDA

DIFFICULTY

Explore the Portuguese old towns or 'Medinas' of El Jadida and Azemmour which exude the charm of yesteryear in a collection of narrow streets, beautiful buildings, gates to mysterious passageways and a mixture of Portuguese, Arab, Andalusian and Berber architectural styles.

Azemmour Village

Depart the pier for the drive to Azemmour village. A stop will be made en-route to view the outside of the Hassan II Mosque before continuing to Azemmour village via the charming coastal road. From the entrance of Azemmour you will see the stunning panoramic view of the whitewashed buildings clustered on the banks of the Oum Rabiaa River.

Morocco's Portuguese Town El Jadida

Next, continue to Morocco's Portuguese town - 'Mazagan' - also known as El Jadida meaning 'new one' to the Arabs. This new name was first used just after the departure of the Portuguese. Explore El Jadida on foot accompanied by your tour guide and experience one of the first settlements created in Africa by Portuguese explorers on their way to India. The most interesting part of El Jadida is the Old Portuguese quarter and the underground cistern, an immense square hall supported by 25 columns and lit only by a circular opening in the roof. The Portuguese built it originally as an arsenal but in the 16th century, they transformed it into a cistern. A mark on the wall records the water level at that time. It was discovered in 1916 by chance, having been sealed off for hundreds of years. Orson Wells used it in his film 'Othello' and also many other directors have filmed in this dramatic area.

Lastly, enjoy a short refreshment stop before re-boarding the coach to return to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a minimal amount of walking, approximately 3.4 mile (1.2 km). This tour is not recommended for guests who utilise a wheelchair. Modest attire is highly recommended - covered shoulders, long pants and comfortable shoes.

CAS-E / LOCAL FLAVOURS & COOKING DEMO

Discover the secrets to preparing a variety of Moroccan specialities during this memorable, half-day cooking excursion with lunch.

Hassan II Mosque, Corniche, Atlantic Ocean and Anfa

Depart the pier for the short drive to the awe-inspiring Hassan II Mosque. The second-largest mosque in the world, it can hold 25,000 people. This magnificent building is overwhelming in its grandeur, and exquisite in its detail. The foundations are built partly on land, and partly over the water. Some of the ceilings in this sacred building are over 200 feet (about 70 meters) tall, and part of it has a retractable roof. It is the only mosque in Morocco where non-Muslims are allowed to enter inside.

Anfa and Central Market

Following a photo stop at the Hassan II Mosque, re-board your coach and continue on for a scenic drive along the Corniche adjoining the Atlantic Ocean en route to Anfa. An elegant residential district perched on a hill overlooking the city, Anfa was the original site of Casablanca, and is highlighted by main avenues, green parks and magnificent villas in a variety of architectural styles. Leaving Anfa, a visit is made to the bustling Central Market, home to a cavalcade of colour, charm, street musicians, a fish market, scenic handicrafts, and spices.

Umayyas Restaurant, Cooking Demo and Lunch

Next, proceed to the exclusive and renowned *Umayyas* restaurant. Your arrival is greeted with refreshments and pastries, followed by an informative and interactive cooking demonstration. Learn the spices and methods used in the creation of a variety of Moroccan entrees and desserts. After your cooking demo, you are served a lunch consisting of the traditional Moroccan fare you have helped to prepare. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking and standing for approximately 601 yards (about 550 metres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Proper attire is required to enter the mosque; men should wear pants or shorts that cover the knees, and women should cover their heads, arms and legs. Guests must be at least 12 years old to participate on this tour, and at least 21 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. Guests must be at least three feet (about 0.9 metres) tall to participate on this tour. Guests must weigh less than 300 pounds (about 136 kilograms) to participate on this tour. Guests are advised not to take photos of military personnel without their consent. Guests are advised to mind their belongings at all times, particularly at tourist points of interest or crowded places. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is very limited; we suggest you book in advance to avoid disappointment.

CAS-F / CITY HIGHLIGHTS & ART HISTORY WITH LUCH AT RICK'S CAFE'

Experience the historic splendour and artistic highlights of Casablanca during a scenic, full-day sightseeing excursion to this legendary city. Hassan II Mosque

Depart the pier for the short drive to the awe-inspiring Hassan II Mosque. The second-largest mosque in the world, it can hold 25,000 people. This magnificent building is overwhelming in its grandeur, and exquisite in its detail. The foundations are built partly on land, and partly over the water. Some of the ceilings in this sacred building are over 200 feet (about 70 meters) tall, and part of it has a retractable roof. It is the only mosque in Morocco where non-Muslims are allowed to enter inside. Following your guided visit, re-board your coach and drive to a vantage point for a unique view of the Hassan II Mosque. From this spot, the city can be seen along the coastline and the towering Hassan II Mosque appears to float on the sea.

Anfa and New Medina

Your drive continues through Anfa, an elegant residential district perched high on a hill overlooking the city. Anfa was the original site of Casablanca, and is highlighted by main avenues, green parks and magnificent villas in a variety of architectural styles. Leaving Anfa, drive to the New Medina, or 'Habous Quarter', for a guided stroll through this historic part of the city, which is lined with souks, shops and a warren of alleyways.

United Nations Square, Mohammed V Boulevard, Rick's Café and Lunch

Next, re-board your coach and drive to the vast United Nations Square. Upon arrival, take another guided walk down the long, palm-lined Mohammed V Boulevard, the heart of Old Casablanca. On the surface, it may appear more than a little tatty at the edges, but this gleaming, Art Deco-styled jewel was once synonymous with all that was dazzling, exciting and new. Proceed for lunch at the famous *Ricks Café*, the mythical saloon from the 1942 film, 'Casablanca'. Set in an old, courtyard-style mansion built against the walls of the Old Medina, this restaurant and piano bar is filled with architectural and decorative details reminiscent of the film. Alcohol is not available in the restaurant.

La Villa des Arts, Abderrahman Slaoui Museum, Antique Jewellery and Art

After lunch, re-board your coach and head to La Villa des Arts. Located in a converted Art Deco building with a pleasant garden near the Parc de la Ligue Arabe, this gorgeous, 1930s gallery holds exhibitions of contemporary Moroccan and international art. Your last stop is at the Abderrahman Slaoui Museum, located inside the home of a charming Art Deco building dating from the 1940s. Dedicated to Moroccan jewellery

and décor, the museum features a unique collection of antique jewellery, vintage posters by great artists such Dinet, Majorelle and De La Neziere, miniatures, 19th-century Bohemian crystal boxes, illuminations and other objects collected from around the world. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

Depart the pier for the short drive to the awe-inspiring Hassan II Mosque. The second-largest mosque in the world, it can hold 25,000 people. This magnificent building is overwhelming in its grandeur, and exquisite in its detail. The foundations are built partly on land, and partly over the water. Some of the ceilings in this sacred building are over 200 feet (about 70 meters) tall, and part of it has a retractable roof. It is the only mosque in Morocco where non-Muslims are allowed to enter inside. After an exterior photo stop here, re-board your coach and drive to a vantage point for a unique view of the Hassan II Mosque. From this spot, the city can be seen along the coastline and the towering Hassan II Mosque appears to float on the sea.

New Medina, Anfa and Mohammed V Square

Next, head to the New Medina, or 'Habous Quarter', for a guided stroll through this historic part of the city, which is lined with souks, shops and a warren of alleyways. Your drive continues through Anfa, an elegant residential district perched high on a hill overlooking the city. Anfa was the original site of Casablanca, and is highlighted by main avenues, green parks and magnificent villas in a variety of architectural styles. A photo stop is then made at Mohammed V Square. Here, see examples of many Moslem-styled buildings, a monumental fountain, public garden and the statue of Marshal Lyautey.

Rabat, Le Ziryab Restaurant and Lunch

Leaving Mohammed V Square, re-board your coach and transfer to Rabat, the capital city of Morocco. Nestled on the Atlantic coastal plain, Rabat is a modern city with wide boulevards, gardens and white buildings. A far cry from the hectic warrens of the other Imperial cities of Marrakech and Fes, Rabat is no less steeped in history, with its origins dating from the 7th century. This enchanting city is home to many historic monuments, and has some superbly preserved relics of its Moorish past. Upon arrival in Rabat, proceed for lunch at *Le Ziryab*, one of the finest restaurants in the city.

Mohammed V Mausoleum and Kasbah Oudayas Medina

After lunch, re-board your coach and drive to the must-see Mohammed V Mausoleum, which contains the tombs of the late Moroccan king and his two sons. This spectacular site is an architectural marvel, and monument to a great ruler. Your last stop is at the traditional Kasbah Oudayas Medina for Moroccan tea and refreshments. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 1.5-hour drive back to the pier.

Hassan II Mosque and Panoramic Casablanca

Our tour of this bustling metropolis begins with a stop at the famous Central Market and scenic drive through Mohamed V square in the heart of the city, with lovely French colonial architecture, and from there we will stop by Mohamed V Square the heart of the city, standing between the two contrasting sides of this Metropolis: The Medina or old Town and the elegant modern section with its sky scuppers and large boulevards. We drive to one of Casablanca's most modern structures, the Hassan II mosque. Inaugurated in 1993, the massive mosque features the world's highest minaret, and room for 25,000 worshipers inside and another 80,000 outside. The mosque is the brainchild and crowning achievement of King Hassan II, and it is the world's third-largest mosque, built to commemorate the former king's 60th birthday. It is the only mosque in Morocco where non-Muslims can enter. This law dates to a French governor who passed it to ensure that none of his countrymen inadvertently offended

the local Muslim communities by entering mosques without following the correct protocol - this law still stands today.

Domaine Ouled Thaleb and Wine Tasting

From here we drive to the Domaine Ouled Thaleb. The domaine was established in 1923. Located in the Zenata coastal appellations between Casablanca and Rabat, Ouled Thaleb led the renewal of the Moroccan wine industry in the 1990's. While most of their fruit is Estate grown, Ouled Thaleb partners with neighbouring growers in order to produce classic style wines under the direction of winemaker, Stephane Marriot. Here we have the pleasure of meeting the owner of the vineyard who will be our host for the tour of the vineyard and the tastings. The tour will include, visiting the caves, production areas, and a small portion of the actual growing area, before settling in for a comprehensive tasting of several of Domain Thalvin best offerings.

Typical Moroccan lunch

Enjoy a typical Moroccan lunch.

Having learned why Morocco is up and coming in the wine world, and tasted some of her best offerings, reboard the motor coach for the return journey to Casablanca, and your ship.

FNC-A / CABLE CAR & TOBOGGAN RIDE

DIFFICULTY

Experience the wonderful views of Funchal all the way up to Monte in a unique and exciting new way during this half-day excursion via cable car and toboggan. This picturesque city is set perfectly on the sunny south coast of Madeira; it's backdrop a protective ring of green mountains; a huge natural amphitheatre that faces the balmy blue Atlantic Ocean.

Cable Car Ride

Depart the pier for the brief drive to the cable car station and board your cable car for a panoramic, approximate 15-minute ride to Monte.

Monte

Perched on a hill 1,677 feet (511 metres) above Funchal, the village is renowned for its lovely setting and landmark twin-towered church. Monte has been a favourite destination for visitors to Madeira since the late-19th century, when a rack and pinion railway was built to haul cruise-ship passengers up from Funchal. Coming down, they would take the famous toboggan ride, which is still a popular attraction today. The railway closed in 1939, and was replaced by the cable car.

Toboggan Ride

Following this introduction to Monte, those who would like to, may take a seat in the typical wicker basket for a fairly bumpy yet exciting, 10-minute downhill run. Two men control the sled with ropes on each side, steering the toboggan over the smooth-worn cobblestones. At the finishing point, board your awaiting coach for a scenic drive that includes a stop at Pico dos Barcelos for breath-taking views over Funchal, the bay and surrounding hills before returning to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking over uneven ground, and a short walk from the cable car station in Monte to the toboggan departure point. Approximate distance walked will be 1.5km (1 mile). Guests opting not to take the toboggan ride may drive down via coach. The sled ride is not recommended for pregnant women, guests with back and/or neck problems, guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. The cable car and toboggan rides are popular attractions; expect slight delays prior to boarding. We recommend wearing comfortable clothing, walking shoes and sun protection.

FNC-B / MONTE & BOTANICAL GARDENS

The village of Monte sits above Funchal at a height of 550 metres (1,804 feet). The cool mountain air and dramatic views made it a healthy retreat for the islands wealthy in the mid-19th century. The Monte Cable Car connects the historic centre of Funchal and Monte. Visit the village of Monte, known for its twin towered church of Our Lady of Monte and the Botanical Gardens with more than 2000 plants. Depart the pier for the approximate 30-minute drive to Monte Village.

Monte

On arrival to the village of Monte enjoy some time to explore this small village perched up in the hills overlooking Funchal, approximately 3.7 miles (6 km) away from the centre of the capital, and formerly a health resort for Europe's high society.

Cable Car Ride

Next, experience an unforgettable voyage by cable car with Nature at your feet. This unforgettable voyage to the Botanical Gardens will take about 8 minutes and offers its visitors a new panoramic route with privileged sights of not only the Funchal bay but also over the River of João Gomes, a place of rare and exotic beauty made up by an important nucleus of Laurissilva forest. The Laurissilva of Madeira is an outstanding relic of a previously widespread laurel forest type. It is the largest surviving area of laurel forest and is believed to be 90% primary forest. It contains a unique array of plants and animals, including many endemic species such as the Madeiran long-toed pigeon.

Botanical Gardens

At the end of the cable car ride the tour continues at the Botanical Gardens located 1.8 miles (3 km) from the centre of Funchal at Quinta do Bom Sucesso - a private Quinta belonging to the Reid family - where the climatic conditions are much in favour of exuberant vegetation. The Botanical Garden boasts harmonious forms, contrasting colours and more than 2000 plants. Throughout the gardens you can find the plants labeled with their scientific names, common name and origin.

Re-board your coach for the drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.5km (1 mile) and is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. FNC-F / PANORAMIC MADEIRA

Experience some of the most spectacular scenery for which Madeira is renowned. Right in the middle of the Atlantic, the island of Madeira is a haven of natural beauty. The exotic colours of the flowers stand out from the blue sea and the emerald green vegetation; this is an archipelago where two thirds are a protected area and where the largest Laurisilva forest in the world is located.

Ponta do Garajau

Depart the pier for the 30-minute drive to Ponta do Garajau which is famous for the statue of Christ the Redeemer that stands looking out at the sea with outstretched arms, as well as its views over Funchal and the Natural Park of Garajau.

Machico

Continue along the Southern coast past the village of Machico, hidden in the bay and stretching out over the hillsides. Legend has it that the first two settlers to Madeira landed at Machico: Robert Machim (hence the name of the town) and Ana D'Arafet. Once a small fishing village, Machico is now a holiday resort.

Next, the road continues to the north of the island and a stop at Portela Pass (2,197 ft. / 670m), where the views over the mountains and down to the sea are magnificent on all sides.

Ribeiro Frio

The route turns inland past Faial to Ribeiro Frio, where a short stop is made to visit the carefully cultivated grounds of the trout hatchery. From here, the road climbs steeply through woodlands and lush green vegetation, passing through Poiso Pass (4,308 ft. / 1413m), from where the summits of the island's highest peaks Pico Ruivo (6,104 ft. / 1862m), and Pico do Arieiro (5,937 ft. / 1818m) should be visible at a distance.

Once over the pass, the road descends rapidly to Terreiro da Luta. At approximately 2670 feet (886m), this was once the terminus of the old funicular railway, long since dismantled, by which visitors traveled from town to the mountain scenery. The nearby Peace Monument is a large column of rough basalt erected in 1925 and surmounted by a statue of the Virgin and Child.

The tour concludes back at the pier, passing by the village of Monte.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking, approximately 1.5km (1 mile) and 35 steps. This tour is not suitable for guests who utilize a wheelchair. FNC-G / GOLF AT PALHEIRO

Once described as one of the world's most beautiful places to play golf, Madeira is home to the Palheiro Golf Club Championship course. At nearly 500 metres (1640 feet) above sea level, this course offers stunning views over the Bay of Funchal across the ocean and due to the climate; golf can be played all year round.

Palheiro Golf

Depart the pier for the approximate 30-minute drive to the golf course. Designed by renowned golf architect Cabell B. Robinson, this picturesque layout with year-round appeal takes full advantage of Madeira's hilly terrain, with abrupt ridges and deep valleys providing a compelling challenge for even the most seasoned golfer.

Teeing off here is to walk through a verdant and tranquil 200-year-old country estate, and an abundance of fragrant, exotic flora lends the course a unique and singular quality. Melodic birdsong enriches the experience.

Play calls for a fair degree of accuracy - the contoured fairways and strategically placed bunkers guarding fast, undulating greens mean there's little room for error. A halfway house, The Tea House, offers refreshments and a chance to pause and assess scorecards. Indeed, a round of golf at Palheiro engages all the senses and rewards those of all abilities with an enjoyable and memorable experience.

The 6086 meters, par 72 course is set amongst magnificent trees, shrubs and formal gardens, and makes full use of the hills; ridges and deep valleys of the Quinta do Palheiro estate. Nearly two thirds of the course has been carved out of pine forest and botanical woodland established over the last 100 years.

Palheiro Golf in Madeira has been ranked in the new Golf World's TOP 200 European Courses list.

The island of Madeira is noted for its natural beauty and exotic vegetation abounds in a carpet of green. The terrain is rugged with imposing valleys and some of the highest sea-cliffs in the world while the climate is temperate and the winters are mild, perfect for growing grapes. Madeiran wine is a trademark of Portugal, and its value is almost equal to gold. The wine has a long history, dating back to the discovery of the New World. This tour will help you discover the Madeiran wine tradition in Funchal.

Cabo Girão

Depart the pier area and drive west from Funchal to Cabo Girão, the second highest sea cliff in the world, and the highest in Europe. It rises sheer from the sea, so that the viewpoint offers breathtaking views along the coast, over Funchal, and out over the distant horizon.

The road then heads down towards the coast passing by the vineyards of Estreito de Câmara Lobos, one of the most important winegrowing areas of the island. The steep valleys offer good examples of the terraced cultivation seen throughout Madeira.

Câmara de Lobos

Reaching the village of Câmara de Lobos "The Sea Wolves' Lair", a picturesque fishing village, once painted by Sir Winston Churchill. The village was given its name by the explorers João Gonçalves Zarco and Tristão Vaz Teixeira because of the shape of its bay and the many sea lions ("lobos") living there at the time. Have the opportunity to view this fishing village from a viewpoint.

Blandy Wine Lodge

On return to Funchal, the tour stops at The Blandy Wine Lodge and here you will have the chance to sample two of the famous Madeira wines, world famous for centuries. Acquired in 1840 by Charles Ridpath Blandy, the Blandy's Wine Lodge has always been and is still an integral part of the production of Blandy's Madeira Wine. Blandy's Madeira celebrated its bicentennial in 2011. Blandy Wine Lodge gives you a privileged perspective on 200 years of Madeira Wine. Located in the centre of Funchal, Blandy's Wine Lodge allows visitors to Madeira an opportunity to experience first-hand wine in the making.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking over uneven ground and cobblestones, and a short 5 minute walk from the bus to the Wine Lodge. FNC-I / WALKING MADEIRA'S TRAILS

Experience the scenic interior of Madeira during a guided walking tour through the island's 'levadas', and a visit to a wicker factory. The levadas crisscross the mountains and cover a vast distance dating back to as far as the early 16th century. The mini-canals are irrigation systems developed to distribute water from the rainfall heavy and wet regions on the north of Madeira Island to the drier sun parched regions of the south.

Levadas

Amongst Madeira's unique features are 'levadas', or canals dug by hand to carry irrigation water from the mountains toward the agricultural terraces on the lower slopes. Many 'levadas' are accompanied by footpaths; hiking along these trails is one of the best ways to explore the interior, take in majestic panoramas and get an up-close look at Madeira's vast array of plants, trees, bushes and ferns.

Vale Paraiso Walking Tour

Depart the pier for the approximately 30-minute drive to the Vale Paraiso. Upon arrival, leave your van or coach and begin your approximately one-hour guided walking tour along the winding 'levadas' to Camacha, located at an elevation of approximately 2,296 feet (700 metres). Along the way, admire stunning scenery and an abundance of luxurious vegetation whilst learning informative details about the beautiful 'Garden Isle'.

Camacha and Wicker Factory

A refreshment stop is made at a local bar before commencing the second part of the walk, which takes you to the Rochão Plateau, the highest point in the parish of Camacha. Here, re-join the van or coach for the drive to a wicker factory.

The village of Camacha (2,296 ft/700m),is one of the largest inland villages of the island and is the centre of the wicker industry producing the well-known Madeira wicker-work. Visit the showrooms to purchase a few wicker-work souvenirs or view the many examples of wicker-work on display.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking over uneven grounds for four miles (six kilometres), with some inclines. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to dress in layers, wear sturdy, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sunscreen, a light raincoat, a hat and sunglasses from the ship. As the lava came down to the sea, the outer portion was exposed to lower temperatures and solidified rapidly, while inside, the lava continued to flow with many gases and created a series of lava tubes that form the caves of São Vicente, which one can walk through. Visit the caves and the beautiful village located next to them with free time to explore.

Serra de Agua

Leaving the pier by bus you will drive along the south-western coast of Madeira to the picturesque village of Serra de Agua situated in a ravine were your first stop will be made at a local bar to try out a local drink "poncha" made from rum and honey.

Caves at São Vicente

Continue to the village of São Vicente along the north-western coast of Madeira were you will be taken to visit the Caves at São Vicente. Enjoy an approximate 60-minute visit to the natural caves and the Volcanism Centre, featuring a 3D film explaining the formation of Madeira.

Village of São Vicente

Visit the picturesque village of São Vicente. São Vicente, with its breathtaking scenery and the recently restored village centre, along with a remarkable and exemplary architectural framework, is one of the most picturesque spots in Madeira.

Your tour will end with the ride back to Funchal and the pier area and your ship.

Once ashore, visit the exotic wildlife exhibits and learn all about some the most endangered and fearsome animals that thrive in this 'River of Grass'. A visit is made to the shop for some souvenirs or refreshments before the transfer back to the pier.

Guests with flights departing after 4:00 p.m. from Fort Lauderdale International Airport and after 5:00pm from Miami International Airport can explore the expansive Flamingo Gardens during this picturesque, half-day sightseeing excursion.

Wray Home and Museum

Depart the pier for Flamingo Gardens, an approximately 60-acre (about 24-hectare), not-for-profit wildlife sanctuary, aviary and botanical garden located just west of Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Upon arrival at this Trip Advisor 'Award of Excellence' winner, your guided tour begins with a visit to the original home of Floyd L. and Jane Wray, who built a home and citrus grove on what was then the edge of the Everglades, and started a botanical collection of tropical and subtropical fruit trees and shrubs. Now a museum, the Wray Home depicts a country home of the early-1930s. Leaving the Wray Home, proceed to the Botanical Gardens.

Botanical Gardens and Tram-Ride

The Botanical Gardens are one of the most beautiful, inspiring and adventurous, yet tranquil, tours offered in Fort Lauderdale. The grounds contain more than 3,000 species of tropical and subtropical plants, including orchids, ferns, bromeliads, 200-year-old live oak trees, and over 300 species of palms. A narrated tram ride leads through the site's tropical rainforest, native hammock, wetland areas and groves. The Tropical Plant House displays orchids, calatheas and other plants. The Arboretum contains one of the largest collection of non-indigenous champion trees in the region, and the Xeriscape Garden demonstrates low maintenance, minimally-watered gardening.

Everglades Wildlife Sanctuary

Next, take a guided tour of the Everglades Wildlife Sanctuary section, which provides care for permanently injured, non-releasable wildlife. Fauna includes an American black bear, otters, alligators, bobcats, Florida panthers, tortoises, freshwater turtles, geese, swans, sandhill cranes, blue-beaked ducks, flamingos, bald eagles, golden eagles, owls, peacocks, macaws, and iguanas. The 25,000-square-foot (about 2,300-square-metre) Everglades aviary houses one of the largest collection of wading birds in the U.S. The aviary exhibits five native Florida ecosystems; coastal prairie, mangrove swamp, cypress forest, sub-tropical hardwood hammock, and sawgrass prairie. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute transfer to Fort Lauderdale International Airport or a one-hour transfer to Miami International Airport.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately 3/4 of a mile (1.2 Km), at times over uneven and gravel surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and tram. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair.
