ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Looking for a special program with your travelling companions? In a nod to our Italian heritage, let us reserve for you our Silver Shore "Privato" service - a private vehicle with driver and/or guide. Create your own itinerary or leave it to us. This service is available in most ports which you can reserve on MySilversea (my.silversea.com) or at the Shore Concierge desk onboard for a truly tailor-made arrangement. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore excursions must be purchased on or before the booking deadline for each port of call. Tours are available on a first-come, first-served basis; some tours are very popular with guests often ending up being wait-listed: in order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com from 120 - 7 days prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate on excursions are subject to space availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. Please note that certain shore excursions may have different reservation deadlines and may incur cancellation fees if cancelled after the deadline. Unless otherwise indicated in the tour description for a particular shore excursion a 100% cancellation fee will be charged for shore excursions cancelled within 48 hours of the scheduled start time. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge desk within the cancellation deadline period.

ONLINE ADVANCE RESERVATION OF SHORE EXCURSIONS

For those of you that are not aware, at Silversea you can pre-reserve your excursions at leisure prior to your journey on the internet, log on to MySilversea (my.silversea.com) up to 7 days prior to your sailing date. If you have pre-reserved your excursions on line, your tickets will be delivered to your suite upon embarkation and all charges will be billed to your shipboard account.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

Once on board, you may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a consolidated tour booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the tours in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Tour tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

As a courtesy to fellow guests, tour departures generally will not be announced unless there is an unforeseen change. Departure times from the ship are published in the ships daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicle. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least ten minutes prior to the tour departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pier-side to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore.

Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and tour departures as local conditions dictate. Please note that pier departure times are also listed in MySilversea (my.silversea.com)

Hong Kong - China

HKG-A1 / FOR IN-TRANSIT GUESTS - HIGHLIGHTS OF HONG KONG

DIFFICULTY



Price:\$69; Duration:4.50 hrs

Explore some of Hong Kong's most popular historic landmarks during this half-day orientation tour of the city.

Depart the pier for the drive across the harbour via the sub-ocean tunnel, and on to Hong Kong Island. Your scenic orientation tour begins with a visit to Victoria Peak.

Victoria Peak

From Garden Road, a tram takes you for the five-minute ride uphill to the 1,300-foot (396-metre) Victoria Peak. After taking in spectacular views and photo opportunities of Hong Kong and Kowloon, board a coach for the drive downhill. Next, your drive continues on to Aberdeen via Deep Water Bay.

Aberdeen

Upon arrival, a sampan boat ride provides a fascinating look at this floating settlement. As you glide along the city's oldest harbour, your cruise takes you past houseboats, fishing sampans and floating restaurants. At the end of the cruise, re-board your coach for the ride to the Stanley Market via Repulse Bay.

Stanley Market

Once a fishing village, Stanley Market has earned a reputation as a paradise for bargain hunters as well as for its interesting scenery. The narrow lanes are lined with small shops selling the latest in fashion clothing, such as overruns of designer jeans and sportswear, leather and silk clothing in Western sizes. In addition, a good selection of souvenir items can be found here.

During your visit, you can stroll around the market and perhaps make a few purchases. Serious shoppers will want to return and explore the market at their leisure.

Leaving Stanley Market, your tour concludes with a brief drive back to the port.

Please note: This tour, available only to guests continuing on from the previous cruise, a moderate amount of walking, with some stairs to climb and guests must be able to embark and disembark the coach and boat via steps. This tour is not suitable for guests who utilise a wheelchair. Comfortable shoes are recommended.

HKG-C1 / LANTAU ISLAND & MONASTERY

Experience the scenic beauty and most renowned destinations of Hong Kong's largest outlying island during this day trip to Lantau Island. Depart the port for the scenic drive via coach to Lantau Island.

Tai O Fishing Village

This fishing village, renowned for the stilt houses built by the river's shore, was the centre of Hong Kong's salt-panning industry for 100 years.

Po Lin Monastery

Your tour continues on through beautiful mountain scenery en route to the Po Lin Monastery, the principal centre of Buddhism in Hong Kong. The monastery houses the world's tallest outdoor seated bronze Buddha statue, the Tian Tan Buddha. This imposing statue of Buddha weighs over 250 tonnes (227,000 kilos), and is more than 100 feet high (34 metres).

After a vegetarian lunch served at the monastery, return to Tung Chung town via cable car. Should the cable car be out of service, the 3.5-mile (5.6-kilometre) drive to Tung Chung will be by bus.

Upon arrival at Tung Chung, re-board your coach for the return drive to the port.

Please note: This tour, available only to guests continuing on from the previous cruise, requires an extensive amount of walking, with an incline to the platform. The road to Lantau is very narrow and full of turns; therefore, this tour is not recommended for guests who suffer from travel motion sickness. There are narrow lanes and an uneven floor at the fishing village. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended. The lunch served is vegetarian cuisine. Expect lines at the Skyrail; your patience is appreciated. This tour is available for guests who are in transit only.

Explore the surrounding at your leisure during your private tour. Customize your own itinerary or choose to see and overview of the area's highlights. Please note: This tour is non-refundable if cancelled within 48 hours prior to arrival in the port. Actual vehicle type varies depending on availability. Guide is English-speaking. Manila - Philippines

MNL-A / SITES OF OLD MANILA

Price:\$69; Duration:3.75 hrs

Explore the history, architecture and landmarks of Manila during this scenic, half-day tour of the Old City.

Fort Santiago

Depart the pier for the brief drive along Roxas Boulevard, a six-mile-long (10-kilometre-long) promenade that was reclaimed from Manila Bay. From here, proceed to the heart of the old walled Spanish city of Intramuros, where the history of Manila as a capital city began.

Your first stop is at Fort Santiago, which overlooks the Pasig River. It is the country's foremost cultural relic, and the site of key moments in Philippine history. Following your visit, walk to the local handicraft store just outside the fort to browse for souvenirs.

San Agustin Church & Museum

Next, re-board your coach and proceed to the San Agustin Church and Monastery, also located within the walls of Intramuros. The church dates from the 16th century, and is the country's oldest structure. Its extensive collection of religious artefacts makes the San Agustin Church and Monastery the country's largest ecclesiastical museum.

Rizal Park and Manila Hotel

Your tour continues with a brief visit to Rizal Park. The park is the former site of a native community, Bagumbayan, which stood beyond the Spanish walls of Intramuros.

Following a photo stop at the park's Rizal Monument, commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier, with a welcome drink at the Manila Hotel en route.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking for approximately 328 yards (about 300 metres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 30 steps at the venues (including some uneven and narrow steps at Fort Santiago). This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, non-slip walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. No photography is permitted inside the San Agustin Church.

MNL-B / MODERN MANILA

DIFFICULTY



Price: \$79; Duration: 4.00 hrs



Explore the history of Manila during a memorable, half-day excursion to this modern metropolis.

Ayala Museum

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive to the Ayala Museum. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the museum, whose core historical collections include 60 handcrafted dioramas that chronicle the rich tapestry of the Philippine's evolution. The museum also features a one-of-a-kind boat gallery, showcasing miniatures of some of the watercraft that have contributed to the development of Philippine maritime trade and its Colonial economy. Archaeological and ethnographic objects from the country's northern and southern communities complement the historical collection. The Fine Arts collection features important works by three painters considered pioneers in Philippine art; *Juan Luna, Fernando Amorsolo, and Fernando Zobel.*

American Cemetery and Memorial

Next, re-board your coach and proceed to the 152-acre (62-hectare) American Cemetery and Memorial, perhaps the largest and most beautiful Armed Forces resting place outside the continental United States. With a total of 17,206 graves, it is home to the largest number of graves of any cemetery for U.S. personnel killed during World War II, and holds war dead from the Philippines and other Allied nations. The marble headstones are aligned in eleven plots forming a circular pattern, and set amidst a wide variety of tropical trees and shrubbery. Following your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately one-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 656 yards (about 600 metres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility, but is not wheelchair-accessible. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. No photography is permitted inside the Ayala Museum. The Ayala Museum is closed on Mondays and on holidays.

MNL-C / PAGSANJAN RAPIDS AND FALLS

DIFFICULTY



Price:\$139; Duration:9.00 hrs



Embrace the picturesque beauty of Manila in a unique and exciting new way during this memorable, full-day excursion to the Pagsanjan River.

Pagsanjan River

Depart the pier for the approximately three-hour drive southeast of Manila to the town of Pagsanjan, with a comfort stop made en route. Located in the scenic native countryside, Pagsanjan is the home of the famous Pagsanjan River and Falls.

Scenic Canoe Ride

Upon arrival at the *Pagsanjan River View Resort*, proceed to the canoe launching area. Receive your safety instructions, then embark in a canoe manned by able-bodied boatmen for a ride upstream to the falls. Along the way, skim by rocks and boulders amidst steep gorges and lush vegetation.

Pagsanjan Falls

Upon reaching the falls, some free time is made available for you to relax and take in your idyllic surroundings. During your visit, you can take an optional bamboo raft-ride through the pounding curtain of water, which falls from a height of 70 feet (21 metres) above the gorge.

'Shooting the Rapids' & Lunch

Your ride back is a more thrilling experience. 'Shoot the rapids' while going downstream, with your boatmen skilfully manoeuvring the canoe between rocks and boulders until you reach calm waters. At the conclusion of your river excursion, change into dry clothing and proceed for lunch at the resort.

After lunch, commence the approximately three-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of activity, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach, and a canoe and optional bamboo raft ride over choppy waters, rapids and falls. This tour is recommended for guests in good physical condition. This tour is not suitable for pregnant women, guests with back and/or neck problems, or limited mobility, or those who utilise a wheelchair. All guests will get wet on this tour. The speed of the river varies depending on rains and volume of water, which can fluctuate. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing, and bring a swimsuit, flip-flops, sun protection and a change of clothing from the ship. The duration of the drive between the pier and Pagsanjan is approximately 3 hours in each direction.

MNL-E / PANORAMIC MANILA

Discover the splendid highlights of Manila during this picturesque, half-day excursion through the city and its surrounds.

Manila City and Intramuros

Depart the pier for a scenic, approximately 30-minute orientation drive through Manila. Along the way, take in a panoramic view of the old walled city of Intramuros, built during the Spanish Colonial period, and Fort Santiago, which served as the headquarters of Spanish, American and Japanese colonizers until its destruction in 1945.

Manila Cathedral, Casa Manila and San Agustin Church

Next, pass by the Manila Cathedral, Casa Manila, a reconstructed 19th century landmark, and San Agustin Church. Constructed between 1587-1604, the San Agustin Church is the oldest surviving church in the Philippines, and the only building left intact when Intramuros was reduced to rubble during the liberation of Manila in 1945.

Coconut Palace, American Cemetery and Manila Hotel

Your drive continues past the Coconut Palace, Cultural Centre of the Philippines, and Philippine Convention Centre en route to the Makati Financial District and American Cemetery and Memorial. Your tour concludes with a stop for refreshments at the Manila Hotel before commencing the short drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a minimal amount of walking for approximately 109 yards (about 100 metres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended.

MNL-F / INTRAMUROS TOUR

Your last stop is at the University of Santo Tomas Museum, the oldest existing museum in the Philippines. During your guided walking tour, explore its diverse collections of historical artefacts. Only 11 prisoners survived to tell the story of the atrocities that took place here during World War II.

Palawan Heritage Centre and World War II Battalion Museum

Next, re-board your coach and drive to the Palawan Heritage Centre. This educational, highly-informative and interactive museum, designed and operated by the provincial government, preserves and promotes the rich cultural heritage of the province. Afterward, proceed to the World War II Battalion Museum, which features a display of tools and equipment owned by World War II veterans. Leaving the museum, continue on to the lwahig Penal Colony.

Iwahig Penal Colony and Crocodile Farm

The Iwahig Penal Colony is a unique prison without bars established by the Americans in 1904. The inmates tend vast tract of land rather than remaining imprisoned inside cells. The more enterprising inmates earn a living by making handicrafts, which you can browse at the Souvenir Shop during your visit. Your last stop is at the Crocodile Farm. Here, hundreds of baby crocodiles are bred in captivity, placed in batches inside a huge tub and fed twice a week. They are then transferred into a bigger pool when they grow up to a mature size, and most are eventually released into the wild. Following your visit, re-board your coach for the short transfer back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 547 yards (about 500 metres), at times on uneven surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach, 26 steps at the Iwahig Prison Colony, eight steps at the Palawan Heritage Centre, six steps at the Souvenir Shop and 10 steps at the Crocodile Farm. Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately two-hour drive through the picturesque countryside en route to the Sabang Wharf. Upon arrival, a comfort stop is made before embarking a local outrigger boat for the picturesque, approximately 30-minute ride to Sabang Beach.

From Sabang Beach, walk to Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park. One of Puerto Princesa's most renowned destinations, this national park is a model of biodiversity, with more than 800 plant species, 300 tree species, 195 bird species, 30 mammals, 19 reptiles, and eight bat species. Once at the park, embark a smaller outrigger canoe for the journey along the underground section of the Subterranean River, an UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the New Seven Wonders of the Natural World.

The boat travels approximately two miles (about 3.2 kilometres) into the cave. Along the way, you are treated to a spectacular display of rock formations and cathedral-like chambers, which nature has sculpted over millions of years. Following your Subterranean River-cruise, walk back to Sabang Beach, then embark your outrigger boat for the approximately 30-minute ride back to the Sabang Wharf. Upon arrival, transfer to the Sheridan Beach Hotel, then proceed for a buffet lunch. After lunch, re-board your coach and commence the approximately two-hour drive back to the pier.

MUR-A / THE SULTANATE OF BRUNEI AND ROYAL REGALIA

Jame Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque

Stop for photos and a look at Istana Nurul Iman, the world's largest residential palace, designed by a prominent Finnish architect.

Kampong Ayer

Next, enjoy a boat ride around this enormous water village, which was once the centre of a trading empire. Your cruise passes under walkways, between houses, schools, and civic building. Visit a boatman's house for a treat of local cakes and tea, a traditional form of welcome. Kampong Ayer was described by European travellers in the 16th century as the 'Venice of the East'.

Royal Regalia Centre

Finally, not to be missed, visit the Royal Regalia Centre. It was opened in 1992 to commemorate the Silver Jubilee of His Majesty's ascension to the throne. The centre houses a collection of royal regalia including the royal chariot, gold and silver ceremonial armoury, the crown used during the coronation, and a replica of the throne His Majesty uses for state occasions.

This tour concludes with the drive back to the port of Muara.

Marvel at the breath-taking residence of the Sultan's family, the Royal Family's lush Polo Grounds and luxurious Empire Hotel and Country Club, where the Sultan hosts his guests.

Diamond Arch and Empire Hotel and Country Club

Continue on for a photo stop at the Diamond Arch, a diamond ring-shaped sculpture which stands as the gateway to Jerudong Amusement Park, before commencing the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

The pendulous pink noses and potbellies of the adult males reminded locals of some Europeans, and this gave them their local name of Monyet Belanda, or 'Dutch Monkey'. Local populations have been rapidly decreasing but through education and proper exposure, residents hope to prevent them from becoming an endangered species. If lucky, you may encounter one of these rare beauties.

Bandar Seri Begawan

A 45-minute coach ride brings you to Bandar Seri Begawan where you board an exclusive water taxi. Discover several of the country's secret beauty spots along the Brunei River during an hour's journey through picturesque secluded coves and calm inlets.

Some of the wildlife that may be seen within the lush surrounding includes White-bellied Sea Eagles, Great White Egrets and King Fishers. You may encounter a salt-water crocodile or Monitor lizard. This area is home to indigenous mammals such as otters, flying foxes, and long tail macaques. Mangrove snakes may be observed on overhanging branches in their natural environment. Parts of this beautiful area have remained completely undeveloped and would be recognised even today by its earliest inhabitants.

En route back to the city centre, enjoy morning tea at a private home in the world's largest water village, Kampong Ayer. Even four centuries ago, the size and complexity of Kampong Ayer greatly impressed the Magellan expedition, which received a stately welcome upon entering Brunei Bay in 1521. Although most of the houses on stilts are now furnished with every modern amenity, the outsides remain traditionally colourful and lively.

A relaxing coach transfer then returns you to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount walking; guests must be able to manoeuvre in and out of the water taxis. Water taxis may not be covered. We recommend you bring protection from the sun (hat, glasses, and lotion) and insect repellent. Although Proboscis Monkeys and the other wildlife mentioned are generally seen, their cooperation cannot be guaranteed.

Temburong

Embark on this full day excursion; it is a short immersion into an amazing tradition and culture of the local people of Temburong. Travel by local water taxi from Bandar through a network of rivers and channels around the back of Brunei Bay. Passing by dense mangrove islands and possibly see some of the local wildlife, that maybe enjoying the early morning sunrays or looking for some tasty morsels of food. Arriving in Bangar (Temburong), make your way to the Rainforest Lodge where upon arrival some light refreshments will be served.

After enjoying the refreshments board the Longboats that are conveniently parked beside the Lodge where you will travel upriver for an un-spoilt view of the rainforest floor. Afterwards, make turn around and go back down river to the lodge where a local lunch will be served. Enjoy the view of the river and possibly spot some wildlife over lunch that may be roaming around the area.

Temburong Houses

After a local lunch you will enjoy a journey to a local Longhouse. Temburong Houses are the largest population of the Iban's, a tribe known in Borneo for their past head Hunting Activities. At the Longhouse be greeted by the residence and enjoy a cultural performance highlighting the Iban's culture and Traditional Dance. Enjoy Afternoon Tea Hosted by the Long House Residence and get an opportunity to mingle with the local residence as they go about their daily lives. Next return to Bangar in time to catch the speed boat back to Bandar Seri Begawan, enjoy a wonderful scenic drive in the afternoon and back to the port.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount walking; guests must be able to manoeuvre in and out of the long boats. Long boats may not be covered. Bandar Seri Begawan

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive to Bandar Seri Begawan. Formerly known as Brunei Town, it is the capital and largest city of the Sultanate of Brunei, and located along the glistening Brunei River. Upon arrival at the jetty, take a guided tour of the Water Village and its Kianggeh Wet Market, which is packed with endless stands offering local foods and crafts.

Brunei River Cruise and Local Home Visit

Next, embark a water taxi for a picturesque cruise along the Brunei River en route to the mangrove forests of Pulau Ranggu Island, home to the elusive proboscis monkeys. Along the way, explore Kampong Ayer, a series of colourful villages built on stilts over water that are connected by wooden walkways, and visit a local home for tea and cakes.

Lunch and Bandar City Tour

Bandar Seri Begawan and Tamu Kianggeh Open Market

During your visit, relax to the sounds of traditional music and take in a demonstration of making the traditional Malay cakes popular among villagers and Bruneians alike.

Arts & Handicrafts Centre, Kota Batu and Archaeological Site

Leaving the Water Village, re-board your coach and proceed to Arts and Handicraft Centre, a trade school established in an effort to keep traditional Bruneian handicraft-making alive. Learn about and observe demonstrations of how intricate designs are incorporated into textiles, silver smiting and weaving. Following your visit, re-board your coach and drive past Kota Batu, where the first Bruneian settlers landed and established the present-day kingdom. A brief stop is made in the ancient capital of Brunei for a look at the area's archaeological sites. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board the coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Sarawak Cultural Village

The village provides a good representation of Sarawak's major ethnic groups, including the Bidayuh, Ibans, Orang Ulu, Malanau, and Penans. Browse around the village and observe the inhabitants of the various houses displaying their pua-weaving and bamboo-carving skills in making traditional handicrafts. In addition, view traditional cooking methods, and how the Penans make blowpipes and other hunting instruments.

Cultural Show

After touring the various houses, proceed to the small theatre for a 40-minute cultural show displaying the various traditional dances of Sarawak. Videos and still photos may be taken during the show. Following the performance, the coach returns you to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately one mile (about 1.6 kilometres), at times over uneven and unpaved surfaces. Bidayuh Longhouse

Depart the pier for an approximately 90 minutes' drive to Anah Rais Longhouse, home to over 100 former head-hunters from the Bidayuh ethnic group, also known as the 'Land Dayaks'. The longhouse has unique architectural and cultural features in which bamboo bridges connect one housing complex to another, thereby sharing a common veranda. While exploring the longhouse, observe the Bidayuh go about their daily chores and lifestyle.

Semenggoh Nature Centre

Afterwards, reboard your coach for a 45 minutes' drive to the Semenggoh Nature Centre. Semenggoh became Sarawak's first forest reserve when in 1920, Rajah Vyner Brooke gazetted 1,980 acres of jungle to conserve and relocate wildlife. Upon arrival at the entrance of the centre, switch to a shuttle van for the ride to the headquarters. Capture a feel of the rainforest as you trek 200 meters into the forest reserve. If you are lucky, wildlife notably the Orang Utans (although not guaranteed) may come to the feeding platform where the forest rangers supplements food to the animals.

Following your visit, commence the approximately 75-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking, at times over uneven forest terrain, with approximately 75 steps to negotiate. Housed in the former Supreme Court, the UOB Southeast Asia Gallery presents the history of Southeast Asian art through artistic impulses shared across the region.
