General Information

ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Booking Direct with Silversea gives you peace of mind. Our local tour operators are fully insured and have been comprehensively vetted. In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Looking for a special program with your travelling companions? In a nod to our Italian heritage, let us reserve for you our Silver Shore "Privato" service - a private vehicle with driver and/or guide. Create your own itinerary or leave it to us. This service is available in most ports which you can reserve on MySilversea (my.silversea.com) or at the Shore Concierge desk onboard for a truly tailor-made arrangement. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore excursions must be purchased on or before the booking deadline for each port of call. Tours are available on a first-come, first-served basis; some tours are very popular with guests often ending up being wait-listed: in order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com from 120 - 7 days prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate on excursions are subject to space availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. Please note that certain shore excursions may have different reservation deadlines and may incur cancellation fees if cancelled after the deadline. Unless otherwise indicated in the tour description for a particular shore excursion a 100% cancellation fee will be charged for shore excursions cancelled within 48 hours of the scheduled start time. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge desk within the cancellation deadline period.

ONLINE ADVANCE RESERVATION OF SHORE EXCURSIONS

For those of you that are not aware, at Silversea you can pre-reserve your excursions at leisure prior to your journey on the internet, log on to MySilversea (my.silversea.com) up to 7 days prior to your sailing date. If you have pre-reserved your excursions on line, your tickets will be delivered to your suite upon embarkation and all charges will be billed to your shipboard account.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

Once on board, you may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a consolidated tour booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the tours in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Tour tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

Prices are generally quoted per person, per tour, with the exception of Silver Shore Privato or group-designated excursions. Prices are subject to change without notice. Please visit MySilversea (my.silversea.com) for the most up-to-date information. Discounts for children under 12 years of age are available on some, but not all tours. Prices for children, if available, will be adjusted onboard. Please meet with the Shore Concierge team prior to your excursion to discuss the availability of children's pricing.

ON-TIME TOUR DEPARTURES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, tour departures generally will not be announced unless there is an unforeseen change. Departure times from the ship are published in the ships daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicle. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least ten minutes prior to the tour departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pier-side to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore.

Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and tour departures as local conditions dictate. Please note that pier departure times are also listed in MySilversea (my.silversea.com)

In many ports of call there may be a local hospitality representative on board to provide additional information, for two hours after the ship's arrival. In some ports, local information may be found in the tourist information centre ashore.

PORT TALKS

Throughout your cruise we'll be offering Port & Shore Excursion information given by our Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant prior to arrival in each port of call. Our aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and many of your questions about our ports of call will be answered in these briefings, giving you more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port. The information is presented in the theater or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicle. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. To ensure the safety of our younger guests, children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service, if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment, to accommodate a child. Kuching - Malaysia

KCH-A / HIGHLIGHTS OF KUCHING

DIFFICULTY

Discover the scenic beauty and historic landmarks of the capital of Sarawak during this half-day sightseeing excursion through Kuching.

Scenic Tour of Kuching, Chinese Temple, Chinese Museum

Depart the pier for an approximately 45-minute orientation of Kuching. Along the way, drive by the Cat Monument and facing the Sarawak River for a photo stop. Next, visit the colourful Chinese Temple and visit the fascinating Chinese Museum which houses the origins of migration from China to Kuching. Following your visit, pass by the Independence Town Field en route to the world-renowned Sarawak Museum.

Sarawak Museum

Visit the Art museum which is part of the Sarawak Museum. Built in 1892, the museum was originally the Curator's house. Learn more of life in Borneo as you view the exhibits on the traditions of the people here including carvings, weapons and costumes. The Museum also includes a section on archaeological discoveries and exhibits which traces the history of Sarawak from the Colonial era to the present day.

Next, re-board your coach and proceed to the waterfront esplanade for splendid vistas of the historic Fort Margherita and Legislature Building before returning to the ship.

KCH-B / SARAWAK CULTURAL VILLAGE

Explore the architecture, traditions, music, and dance of Sarawak's multi-ethnic population during this scenic, half-day visit to the Sarawak Cultural Village.

Sarawak Cultural Village

Depart the pier for the approximately 45-minutes drive to the foothills of Mount Santubong, and a visit the 17-acre (6.9-hectare) Sarawak Cultural Village. Situated next to a manmade lake, the village was created by the Sarawak Development Corporation to promote and preserve Sarawak's cultural heritage. The site offers a unique opportunity to experience the diverse culture and architecture of the 'Land of the Hornbills'. The village provides a good representation of Sarawak's major ethnic groups, including the Bidayuh, Ibans, Orang Ulu, Malanau, and Penans. Browse around the village and observe the inhabitants of the various houses displaying their pua-weaving and bamboo-carving skills in making traditional handicrafts. In addition, view traditional cooking methods, and how the Penans make blowpipes and other hunting instruments.

Cultural Show

After touring the various houses, proceed to the small theatre for a 40-minute cultural show displaying the various traditional dances of Sarawak. Videos and still photos may be taken during the show. Following the performance, the coach returns you to the pier.

KCH-C / LONGHOUSE & SEMENGGOH NATURE CENTRE

Explore the unique culture, traditions and rainforest of Borneo during this memorable excursion to a Bidayuh longhouse and the Semenggoh Nature Centre.

Bidayuh Longhouse

Depart the pier for an approximately 90 minutes' drive to Anah Rais Longhouse, home to over 100 former head-hunters from the Bidayuh ethnic group, also known as the 'Land Dayaks'. The longhouse has unique architectural and cultural features in which bamboo bridges connect one housing complex to another, thereby sharing a common veranda. While exploring the longhouse, observe the Bidayuh go about their daily chores and lifestyle.

Semenggoh Nature Centre

Afterwards, reboard your coach for a 45 minutes' drive to the Semenggoh Nature Centre. Semenggoh became Sarawak's first forest reserve when in 1920, Rajah Vyner Brooke gazetted 1,980 acres of jungle to conserve and relocate wildlife. Upon arrival at the entrance of the centre, switch to a shuttle van for the ride to the headquarters. Capture a feel of the rainforest as you trek 200 meters into the forest reserve. If you are lucky, wildlife notably the Orang Utans (although not guaranteed) may come to the feeding platform where the forest rangers supplements food to the animals.

Following your visit, commence the approximately 75-minute drive back to the pier.

Muara - Brunei Darussalam

MUR-A / THE SULTANATE OF BRUNEI AND ROYAL REGALIA

DIFFICULTY



Price:\$79; Duration:4.00 hrs



Departing Muara port, travel through some of Brunei's developing residential and commercial areas to the centre of Bandar Seri Begawan. During this orientation drive, the guide highlights some of the most important sites and areas, such as the Lapau (state ceremonial hall), the Dewan Majlis (legislative assembly building), the Sir Omar Ali Saifuddin Mosque, and the Foreign Ministry.

Jame Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque

Subject to availability, visit the Jame Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque, the largest and most magnificent house of worship in Brunei. It was built to commemorate the 25th anniversary of His Majesty's reign. The mosque's gold topped domes rise gracefully above the landscaped gardens and fountains.

Stop for photos and a look at Istana Nurul Iman, the world's largest residential palace, designed by a prominent Finnish architect.

Kampong Ayer, Water Village

Next, enjoy a boat ride around this enormous water village, which was once the centre of a trading empire. Your cruise passes under walkways, between houses, schools, and civic building. Visit a boatman's house for a treat of local cakes and tea, a traditional form of welcome. Kampong Ayer was described by European travellers in the 16th century as the 'Venice of the East'.

Royal Regalia Centre

Finally, not to be missed, visit the Royal Regalia Centre. It was opened in 1992 to commemorate the Silver Jubilee of His Majesty's ascension to the throne. The centre houses a collection of royal regalia including the royal chariot, gold and silver ceremonial armoury, the crown used during the coronation, and a replica of the throne His Majesty uses for state occasions.

This tour concludes with the drive back to the port of Muara.

MUR-B / WINDOW TO BRUNEI

DIFFICULTY

Discover the spectacular landmarks of Brunei during this leisurely, half-day sightseeing excursion through the capital city of Bandar Seri Begawan.

Bandar Seri Begawan and Royal Regalia Museum

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive to Bandar Seri Begawan. Formerly known as Brunei Town, it is the capital and largest city of the Sultanate of Brunei, and located along the glistening Brunei River. Pass by the Royal Wharf and Water Village en route to the Royal Regalia Museum. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the museum, which features the Royal Crown Jewels, Royal Chariot, scepters, coronation crowns, ceremonial weapons, royal family memorabilia, and a replica of the Throne Room.

Jame'asr Hassanal Bolkiah Mosque and Royal Palace

Leaving the museum, photo stops are made at Damuan Park and the Jame'asr Hassanal Bolkiah Mosque. The largest mosque in Brunei, it is a superb example of contemporary Islamic architecture and was built to commemorate the 25th anniversary of the Sultan's reign. Next, a photo stop is made at the Royal Palace, the official residence of the Sultan. At 2.2-million square feet (204,386 square metres) it is largest residential palace in the world. Marvel at the breath-taking residence of the Sultan's family, the Royal Family's lush Polo Grounds and luxurious Empire Hotel and Country Club, where the Sultan hosts his guests.

Diamond Arch and Empire Hotel and Country Club

Continue on for a photo stop at the Diamond Arch, a diamond ring-shaped sculpture which stands as the gateway to Jerudong Amusement Park, before commencing the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 109 yards (about 100 metres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the Royal Regalia Museum. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility, but is not wheelchair-accessible. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended; revealing clothing and shorts are not permitted on this tour. The tour sequence may vary.

MUR-C / MANGROVE RIVER SAFARI AND THE PROBOSCIS MONKEYS

DIFFICULTY

This tour is designed for those who wish to understand the habitat and ecology of Brunei's exclusive creature, the Proboscis Monkey, which has excited the curiosity of visitors since colonial times. The pendulous pink noses and potbellies of the adult males reminded locals of some Europeans, and this gave them their local name of Monyet Belanda, or 'Dutch Monkey'. Local populations have been rapidly decreasing but through education and proper exposure, residents hope to prevent them from becoming an endangered species. If lucky, you may encounter one of these rare beauties.

Bandar Seri Begawan, Mangrove Safari

A 45-minute coach ride brings you to Bandar Seri Begawan where you board a water taxi. Discover several of the country's secret beauty spots along the Brunei River during an hour's journey through picturesque secluded coves and calm inlets.

Some of the wildlife that may be seen within the lush surrounding includes White-bellied Sea Eagles, Great White Egrets and King Fishers. You may encounter a salt-water crocodile or Monitor lizard. This area is home to indigenous mammals such as otters, flying foxes, and long tail macaques. Mangrove snakes may be observed on overhanging branches in their natural environment. Parts of this beautiful area have remained completely undeveloped and would be recognised even today by its earliest inhabitants.

Kampong Ayer, Water Village

En route back to the city centre, enjoy morning tea at a private home in the world's largest water village, Kampong Ayer. Even four centuries ago, the size and complexity of Kampong Ayer greatly impressed the Magellan expedition, which received a stately welcome upon entering Brunei Bay in 1521. Although most of the houses on stilts are now furnished with every modern amenity, the outsides remain traditionally colourful and lively.

A coach transfer then returns you to the pier.

MUR-D / TEMBURONG EXPERIENCE

Enjoy a Cultural experience of the Temburong District, Located on the East side of the Country. Separated by Malaysia (Sarawak), the journey begins with a bus-ride to Bandar Seri Begawan then an exciting ride on the local speed boats to the Temburong District. Rainforest Lodge, Cooking Demonstration and Canoe-Ride

Enjoy Afternoon Tea Hosted by the Long House Residence and get an opportunity to mingle with the local residence as they go about their daily lives. Next return to Bangar in time to catch the speed boat back to Bandar Seri Begawan, enjoy the drive in the afternoon and back to the port.

St. Michael's Church

One of the four structures remaining after World War II, the church is famous for its stained-glass windows. Designed by a well-known Australian artisan, Philip Handel, the windows were funded by the relatives of prisoners of war.

Agnes Keith's House

Capture a glimpse of the past as you visit Agnes Keith's house, a typical colonial house built in the early 20th century. Agnes Keith was an American author married to the former Conservator of Forest, who popularised the old seafarer's name of Sabah in her book *Land Below the Wind*.

English Tea House

Enjoy a cup of tea in the English Tea House with a choice of the familiar English scones or try a local hors d'oeuvre. Time permitting, walk to the observation pavilion if you wish, to see the views of the city before returning back to the ship.

Travel to two sanctuaries renowned for the protection and preservation of two of Borneo's most famous residents, the Orang utan and the Proboscis monkey, on this half-day nature exploration.

Depart the pier and begin the 45-minute drive to the Sepilok Orang utan sanctuary.

Sepilok Orang Utan Sanctuary

Established in 1964 to aid orphaned baby Orang Utan, this rehabilitation centre resides in the Kabili-Sepilok Forest, an enormous area of virgin rainforest. Found only in Borneo and Sumatra, the Orang Utans' survival is constantly threatened by forest fires, felling of trees, poaching, and illegal hunting. Here, the Orang Utan (in Malay 'man of the forest') are rehabilitated and returned to the wild, if possible. Witness Orang Utans, the 'Wild men of Borneo' emerging from the jungle to be fed.

Labuk Bay Sanctuary

In the centre of the mangrove forests of Semawang is the Labuk Bay Proboscis Monkey Sanctuary, where you can see Borneo's indigenous proboscis monkeys.

This privately-owned sanctuary located within an oil palm estate gives you the chance to observe these animals up close and personal during their late morning feeding time. Endemic to the island, the Proboscis monkey is famous for its big pendulous nose and distinctive pot belly. As sources of their food dwindle due to diminishing habitats, the sanctuary has made efforts to supplement the monkey's diet with fruit and water daily to ensure the conservation of these animals. Watch the monkeys from a viewing platform. Silver Leaf monkeys may also be seen feasting on green beans.

Your tour concludes with the 1.5 hour return drive to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking for a total distance of approximately a half of a mile (850 metres), including a 15-minute hike on a wooden walkway with steps and inclines; the walkways can become slippery if wet. Flat, non-slip soled walking shoes are suggested. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive to the Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre, the largest orangutan rehabilitation sanctuary in the world. The Bornean orangutan (*Pongo pygmaeus*) is a species of orangutan native to the island of Borneo. Together with the Sumatran orangutan, it belongs to the only genus of great apes native to Asia. The Bornean orangutan shares up to 96.4% of the human genetic makeup, and is gentle, shy and curious by nature. Upon arrival, take a short, guided walk through the lowland dipterocarp forest to the observation platform. Here, watch the orangutans emerge from the forest to be fed by the rangers.

Sun Bear Conservation Centre

Next, proceed to the Sun Bear Conservation Centre. The sun bear, also known as the 'honey bear', is a bear found primarily in the tropical rainforests in Southeast Asia, Northeast India, Bangladesh and Southern China. The sun bear is the smallest member in the only eight known bear species in the world. In Sabah, Sun Bears are a totally protected species, with the same status as the Bornean orangutans and Sumatran rhinoceros. During your guided tour, view the sun bears from an observation platform whilst learning about their habits and habitat. Following your visit and a refreshment stop, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.8 miles (about 1.3 kilometres), at times over slippery surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 80 steps at the Sun Bear observation platform. Iwahig Penal Colony and Crocodile Farm

The Iwahig Penal Colony is a unique prison without bars established by the Americans in 1904. The inmates tend vast tract of land rather than remaining imprisoned inside cells. The more enterprising inmates earn a living by making handicrafts, which you can browse at the Souvenir Shop during your visit. Your last stop is at the Crocodile Farm. Fort Santiago

Depart the pier for the brief drive along Roxas Boulevard, a six-mile-long (10-kilometre-long) promenade that was reclaimed from Manila Bay. From here, proceed to the heart of the old walled Spanish city of Intramuros, where the history of Manila as a capital city began.

Your first stop is at Fort Santiago, which overlooks the Pasig River. It is the country's foremost cultural relic, and the site of key moments in Philippine history. Following your visit, walk to the local handicraft store just outside the fort to browse for souvenirs.

San Agustin Church & Museum

Next, re-board your coach and proceed to the San Agustin Church and Monastery, also located within the walls of Intramuros. The church dates from the 16th century, and is the country's oldest structure. Its extensive collection of religious artefacts makes the San Agustin Church and Monastery the country's largest ecclesiastical museum.

Rizal Park and Manila Hotel

Your tour continues with a brief visit to Rizal Park. The park is the former site of a native community, Bagumbayan, which stood beyond the Spanish walls of Intramuros.

Following a photo stop at the park's Rizal Monument, commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier, with a welcome drink at the Manila Hotel en route.

MNL-B / MODERN MANILA

Explore the history of Manila during a memorable, half-day excursion to this modern metropolis.

Ayala Museum

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive to the Ayala Museum. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the museum, whose core historical collections include 60 handcrafted dioramas that chronicle the rich tapestry of the Philippine's evolution. The museum also features a one-of-a-kind boat gallery, showcasing miniatures of some of the watercraft that have contributed to the development of Philippine maritime trade and its Colonial economy. Archaeological and ethnographic objects from the country's northern and southern communities complement the historical collection. The Fine Arts collection features important works by three painters considered pioneers in Philippine art; *Juan Luna*, *Fernando Amorsolo*, and *Fernando Zobel*.

American Cemetery and Memorial

Next, re-board your coach and proceed to the 152-acre (62-hectare) American Cemetery and Memorial, perhaps the largest and most beautiful Armed Forces resting place outside the continental United States. With a total of 17,206 graves, it is home to the largest number of graves of any cemetery for U.S. personnel killed during World War II, and holds war dead from the Philippines and other Allied nations. The marble headstones are aligned in eleven plots forming a circular pattern, and set amidst a wide variety of tropical trees and shrubbery. Following your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately one-hour drive back to the pier.

MNL-C / PAGSANJAN RAPIDS AND FALLS

Embrace the picturesque beauty of Manila in a unique and exciting new way during this memorable, full-day excursion to the Pagsanjan River.

Pagsanjan River

Depart the pier for the approximately three-hour drive southeast of Manila to the town of Pagsanjan, with a comfort stop made en route. Located in the scenic native countryside, Pagsanjan is the home of the famous Pagsanjan River and Falls.

Scenic Canoe Ride

Upon arrival at the *Pagsanjan River View Resort*, proceed to the canoe launching area. Receive your safety instructions, then embark in a canoe manned by able-bodied boatmen for a ride upstream to the falls. Along the way, skim by rocks and boulders amidst steep gorges and lush vegetation.

Pagsanjan Falls

Upon reaching the falls, some free time is made available for you to relax and take in your idyllic surroundings. During your visit, you can take an optional bamboo raft-ride through the pounding curtain of water, which falls from a height of 70 feet (21 metres) above the gorge.

'Shooting the Rapids' & Lunch

Your ride back is a more thrilling experience. 'Shoot the rapids' while going downstream, with your boatmen skilfully manoeuvring the canoe between rocks and boulders until you reach calm waters. At the conclusion of your river excursion, change into dry clothing and proceed for lunch at the resort.

After lunch, commence the approximately three-hour drive back to the pier.

MNL-D / CORREGIDOR ISLAND

Step back in time as you visit Corregidor Island, the 'Rock', as it was known in World War II. This memorable tour also includes a dramatic Light and Sound show as well as a multitude of historical landmarks that serve as reminders of a world at war.

From the pier, a 30-minute transfer will take you to the terminal for your 1 hour and 30 mins ferry ride to Corregidor, 27 miles (43 kilometres) across the bay from Manila.

Corregidor Island

Upon arrival, begin a guided tour of the island in open-sided Tranvia buses. As the last bastion to fall to the invading Japanese in 1942, Corregidor acquired immense significance as a symbol of the determined resistance of its Filipino and American defenders. Today it is a national shrine. Divided geographically into Topside, Middleside, Bottomside, Malinta Tunnel and the Tail, it is at Topside that the most vivid realities of the war can be seen and felt. Desolate ruins of barracks and buildings stand as stark reminders of the ugliness of a world torn by war. Topside was the location of Fort Mills, the nerve centre of military life at Corregidor. Here stands the sombre Pacific War Memorial, commanding a view of the surrounding waters.

Malinta Tunnel

After a buffet lunch at the Island, visit the site of General MacArthur's headquarters. The Malinta Tunnel contains mile-long barracks, gun batteries, a ruined hospital and a small museum. Exhibits include photographs of Corregidor as it was before World War II. It was to this tunnel that the defenders retreated, defying the Japanese as long as possible. In the end, the lack of water, food, medicine and ammunition left them little choice but to surrender on May 6, 1942. A 30-minute multimedia presentation provides an impressive dramatization of the war's events.

Depart Corregidor in mid-afternoon for the trip back to Manila's ferry terminal, where the transfer coach is waiting to return you to the ship.

MNL-E / PANORAMIC MANILA

Manila City and Intramuros

Depart the pier for a scenic, approximately 30-minute orientation drive through Manila. Along the way, take in a panoramic view of the old walled city of Intramuros, built during the Spanish Colonial period, and Fort Santiago, which served as the headquarters of Spanish, American and Japanese colonizers until its destruction in 1945.

Manila Cathedral, Casa Manila and San Agustin Church

Next, pass by the Manila Cathedral, Casa Manila, a reconstructed 19th century landmark, and San Agustin Church. Constructed between 1587-1604, the San Agustin Church is the oldest surviving church in the Philippines, and the only building left intact when Intramuros was reduced to rubble during the liberation of Manila in 1945.

Coconut Palace, American Cemetery and Manila Hotel

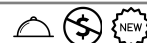
Your drive continues past the Coconut Palace, Cultural Centre of the Philippines, and Philippine Convention Centre en route to the Makati Financial District and American Cemetery and Memorial. Your tour concludes with a stop for refreshments at the Manila Hotel before commencing the short drive back to the pier.

MNL-H / A DAY IN TAGAYTAY

Manila, Las Pinas, San Jose Church, Bamboo Organ, Jeepney Factory Tour

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 40-minute drive to Las Pinas. Upon arrival, proceed for a visit to the San Jose Church to see the world-famous, 19th-century Bamboo Organ. Afterward, re-board your coach and proceed to the nearby Jeepney Factory for a glimpse at how the iconic mode of transportation, the 'Jeepney', is manufactured.

Countryside, Villages, Rice Fields, Orchards, Plantations, Tagaytay, Taal Volcano, Taal Vista Hotel

Next, re-board your coach for a leisurely, approximately 1.5-hour drive through the countryside to Tagaytay. En route, pass through coastal villages, rice fields, fruit orchards and coconut plantations before reaching the cool climate of Tagaytay, a popular summer retreat that beckons those living in Manila. Nestled in a secluded corner of Tagaytay Ridge, approximately 2,250 feet (about 686 metres) above sea level, is the Taal Vista Hotel. From here, take in spectacular panoramic views of your surrounds, including the Taal Volcano. The smallest volcano in the world, Taal is best described as a volcano within a lake, within a larger volcano.
