ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Booking Direct with Silversea gives you peace of mind. Our local tour operators are fully insured and have been comprehensively vetted. In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Looking for a special program with your travelling companions? In a nod to our Italian heritage, let us reserve for you our Silver Shore "Privato" service - a private vehicle with driver and/or guide. Create your own itinerary or leave it to us. This service is available in most ports which you can reserve on MySilversea (my.silversea.com) or at the Shore Concierge desk onboard for a truly tailor-made arrangement. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore excursions must be purchased on or before the booking deadline for each port of call. Tours are available on a first-come, first-served basis; some tours are very popular with guests often ending up being wait-listed: in order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com from 120 days until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate on excursions are subject to space availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. Please note that certain shore excursions may have different reservation deadlines and may incur cancellation fees if cancelled after the deadline. Unless otherwise indicated in the tour description for a particular shore excursion a 100% cancellation fee will be charged for shore excursions cancelled within 48 hours of the scheduled start time. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge desk within the cancellation deadline period.

ONLINE ADVANCE RESERVATION OF SHORE EXCURSIONS

For those of you that are not aware, at Silversea you can pre-reserve your excursions at leisure prior to your journey on the internet, log on to MySilversea (my.silversea.com) until 48 hours prior to sailing. If you have pre-reserved your excursions on line, your tickets will be delivered to your suite upon embarkation and all charges will be billed to your shipboard account.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

Once on board, you may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a consolidated tour booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the tours in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Tour tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

Departure times from the ship are published in the ships daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicle. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least ten minutes prior to the tour departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pier-side to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore.

BDA-A / CLASSIC GLASS-BOTTOM SIGHTSEEING CRUISE

Experience the undersea splendour of Bermuda's barrier reef during this picturesque sightseeing excursion via glass-bottom boat. Depart the pier aboard a luxury, custom-built and air-conditioned glass-bottom boat. Along the way, explore the fascinating barrier coral reef surrounding this unique island, and view the coral formations and colourful fish that abound in the crystal-clear, azure-blue waters. Your captain highlights various points of interest and informative facts while cruising over the barrier reef.

Next, view the wreck of the *Vixen*, an 18th-century ship that is now home to a variety of marine life, and observe a fish-feeding frenzy. During the ride back to the ship, your captain passes by a turtle-feeding area; if you are lucky, you may see one or more of them surface. This scenic, family-friendly excursion concludes at the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a minimal amount of activity; however, guests must be able to walk one ship length to embark/disembark the sightseeing vessel. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility, but is not wheelchair-accessible. Discover the pristine natural beauty, Old World traditions and historic landmarks of Bermuda during this half-day, excursion through the island. Botanical Gardens

Depart the pier for the scenic drive through the Botanical Gardens. Originally opened in 1898 the Bermuda Botanical Gardens feature 36 acres of trees, flowers and shrubs. John Lennon visited the gardens in 1980 and named his subsequent album *Double Fantasy* after a flower he spotted here.

Scenic Island Drive

Next, learn more about the flora, fauna and history of the island during a scenic, approximately 1.5-hour sightseeing drive that also explores some of the oldest and most renowned landmarks in Bermuda. Sights to be seen include the early-17th-century Heydon Trust Chapel, Horseshoe Beach, the picturesque vistas and ramparts at Fort Scaur and Somerset Bridge, the world's smallest drawbridge.

Gibbs Hill Lighthouse

Constructed in 1844 the Gibbs Hill Lighthouse is the oldest cast iron lighthouse in the world. The hill on which the lighthouse stands is 245 feet high while the lighthouse itself measures 117 feet. A 1,000 watt bulb sits inside a lens revolving in a trough of 1,200 pounds of mercury. The light beam it emits can be seen by ships 40 miles away and from a distance of 120 miles by a plane flying at 10,000 feet.

Coco Reef Hotel

Our stop for tea will be at the Coco Reef Hotel, with spectacular views of the famed South Shore. You can relax and enjoy an Island Style English cream tea in the accompanied by an assortment of tea sandwiches, English scones, clotted cream and jam and of course a pot of tea!

From here, your tour continues on through the most scenic part on the island, which overlooks the spectacular barrier reef, azure blue waters and famed pink sand beaches. Your tour concludes back at the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a minimal amount of walking, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the Lighthouse. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing and sun protection are recommended. tranquil island hideaways only accessible by boat and classic Bermuda landmarks that include the Gibbs Hill Lighthouse, the oldest cast-iron lighthouse in the Western Hemisphere.

Millionaire's Row

Next, venture along the shoreline to view charming Colonial homes painted in pastel colours and steeped in history. In addition, see an exclusive neighbourhood known as 'Millionaire's Row'. Over the years, celebrity residents here have included Michael Douglas and Catherine Zeta-Jones, James Martin, Pioneer of Texas Instruments, playwright Eugene O'Neal, illustrator William Denslow, acclaimed for his work on the Wizard of Oz, and the house that John Lennon stayed in to write his last album, Double Fantasy. Your tour concludes back at the pier.

This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility, but is not wheelchair-accessible. Hamilton City, Somerset Village and Drawbridge, and Gibbs Hill Lighthouse

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute orientation drive through the city of Hamilton and Somerset Village. Pass over the Somerset Drawbridge, the smallest drawbridge in the world, then continue on for a photo stop at the iconic Gibbs Hill Lighthouse, which towers nearly 120 feet (about 36 metres) above sea level and offers breath-taking panoramic views in all directions.

Southern Coast, Pink-Sand Beaches and Royal Naval Dockyard

Next, re-board your mini bus and drive along the southern coast. Along the way, take in splendid views of the pink-sand beaches, azure blue waters and imposing barrier reef that encircles the island. Your last stop is at the Royal Naval Dockyard, where some free time is made available for shopping and exploration at your leisure. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a minimal amount of walking, at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the mini bus and a flight of stairs at the Gibbs Hill Lighthouse. Explore the picturesque east end of Bermuda during this memorable, half-day excursion to Colonial St. George's, an UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Hamilton, Botanical Gardens, Governor's Mansion, Green Turtles, John Smith's Beach

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute orientation drive through the city of Hamilton, then along the island's panoramic northeastern coastline via South Shore Road. Pass by the Botanical Gardens, Governor's Mansion and Bermuda's Green Turtles in Flats Village. After a photo stop at John Smith's Beach, proceed to the historic town of St. George's, an UNESCO World Heritage Site.

St. George's, Town Square, First House of Assembly, Stocks, St. Peter's Church

Upon arrival, step back in time to the island's early days. Stroll about the cobblestone streets and stop in the heart of the Town Square for a visit to the island's First House of Assembly, or have pictures taken in the Stocks. Across the main street is the oldest active Anglican Church in the Western Hemisphere, St. Peter's Church, which remains in its original state to this day.

Fort St. Catherine, Swords, Pistols, Island Views, St. David's Island and Lighthouse, Atlantic Ocean

Next, take a guided walking tour inside Fort St. Catherine. Built in 1840, the fort became an iconic guardian of the island's east end during World War II. Pass by swords and pistols on display, and take in stunning island views from high atop this grand fortress. Leaving Fort. St. Catherine, visit the adjacent St. David's Island. Discover the charm of this unique and enchanting community, formerly an US Air Force base. An exterior photo stop is made at St. David's Lighthouse, which was significant to marine traffic in the 18th century and offers exquisite views over the Atlantic Ocean. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately one-hour drive back to the pier via North Shore Road.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking, at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the sites visited. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Walking in St. George's is at the discretion of each guest. Lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Space on this tour is extremely limited; we suggest you book well in advance to avoid disappointment.

Designed in 2002 by renowned golf course architect Algie M. Pulley, Jr., this course is a magnificently contoured showcase of Bermuda's natural beauty. Upon arrival, begin your 18-hole round of golf.

Breath-Taking Views of Hamilton Harbour, Your Ship and the Great Sound

With 6,100 yards of strategically-placed bunkers, multi-tiered greens and slender fairways, Belmont Hills' world-class layout offers a challenging test for players of all handicaps. Breath-taking panoramic views of bustling Hamilton Harbour, your ship and the Great Sound provide an inspiring accompaniment to every shot. The 17th and 18th holes, in particular, are among the finest finishing holes in the game. At the conclusion of your memorable Belmont Hills golfing experience, re-board your coach and commence the short transfer back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking and standing, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. This golfing excursion includes private transfers between the pier and the course, and cart rental. The course is Par 72, and suggested for average-to-experienced golfers. The return journey is made through the new road, stopping at the famous António Borges Botanical Garden, where there is a remarkable collection of European and tropical trees growing in this romantic setting.

Pineapple Plantation

Continuing to the suburb of Abelheira, a final stop is made at Pineapple Plantation, where the complete process of cultivation and marketing of this fruit will be explained.

Following your visit, re-board your coach for the brief drive back to the pier and the ship in Ponta Delgada.

You will be promised scenic beauty and contact with one of the oldest villages in São Miguel where the old traditional way of living in the Azorean villages is still kept alive.

Sete Cidade

The entire region of Sete Cidades is dominated by the impressive Caldeira, with its almost 7.5 mile (12 km) diameter; this is the most spectacular volcanic view in the Azores. The Azores are actually some of the tallest mountains on the planet, measured from their base at the bottom of the

ocean to their peaks, which thrust high above the surface of the Atlantic. Because these once-uninhabited and remote islands were settled sporadically over a span of two centuries, their culture, dialect, cuisine and traditions vary considerably. King Charles I of Portugal contemplated this impressive panorama in 1901, discovering there lays two volcanic lakes, the Green and the Blue Lake, separated by a narrow bridge.

Crater Lakes

Together the Green and Blue lakes have an area of 482 hectares (2 miles), and they are 19 metres (62 feet) deep at their greatest depth. On the shores of the Blue Lake is the village of Sete Cidades, enigmatic as its own name (Seven Cities) and surrounded by the dark forest covered walls of the Caldeira. Have the opportunity to see the lakes not only from the highest point but also to admire up close.

Santiago Lake

On the way back to Ponta Delgada you will also have the opportunity to see Santiago Lake. The Santiago Lake is situated in the Devassa Mountain, nearby the amazing Sete Cidades Lake, on the wonderful São Miguel Island, on the Azores Archipelago. In a place of great natural beauty, the lake amazes for its surrounding of greenish mountain slopes filled with natural richness and different species of flora and fauna, proud of the lake waters in dark green tones.

The Santiago Lagoon occupies a volcanic crater, quite visible in the Lagoa do Canário viewpoint, this offers a panorama of great beauty, such as the pure image of the greenish Azores Archipelago.

Pineapple Plantation

One of the more unusual sightseeing destinations on São Miguel is the well-known Pineapple Plantation, located just outside of Ponta Delgada. You can see the greenhouses (the Azores are not warm enough to cultivate the fruit outdoors), and take a tour of the plantation and learn of the growing stages and cultivation.

Your private vehicle then returns you to the pier and your ship after your day of discovery.

Leaving the monastery, continue on to the Belém Tower, a prominent city landmark that dominates the bank of the Tagus River. From the motorcoach, admire the lavishly decorated tower from which Portuguese explorers were once given a rousing send-off.

Monument to the DiscoveriesYour last stop is at the nearby Monument to the Discoveries. This monumental sculpture was erected to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the death of Prince Henry, the mastermind navigator behind Portugal's voyages of exploration and subsequent fantastic wealth.

Leaving the Belém area, your tour coach will return to the port to disembark any participants who may be in transit to the next cruise before continuing on to the Silversea Hotel and finally to the Lisbon Airport.

Please note: This tour is available for guests with flights after 3:00 PM or those participating in a Silversea post-cruise hotel programme.
