

General Information

ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Booking Direct with Silversea gives you peace of mind. Our local tour operators are fully insured and have been comprehensively vetted. In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Looking for a special program with your travelling companions? In a nod to our Italian heritage, let us reserve for you our Silver Shore "Privato" service - a private vehicle with driver and/or guide. Create your own itinerary or leave it to us. This service is available in most ports which you can reserve on MySilversea (my.silversea.com) or at the Shore Concierge desk onboard for a truly tailor-made arrangement. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore excursions must be purchased on or before the booking deadline for each port of call. Tours are available on a first-come, first-served basis; some tours are very popular with guests often ending up being wait-listed: in order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com from 120 days until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate on excursions are subject to space availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. Please note that certain shore excursions may have different reservation deadlines and may incur cancellation fees if cancelled after the deadline. Unless otherwise indicated in the tour description for a particular shore excursion a 100% cancellation fee will be charged for shore excursions cancelled within 48 hours of the scheduled start time. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge desk within the cancellation deadline period.

ONLINE ADVANCE RESERVATION OF SHORE EXCURSIONS

For those of you that are not aware, at Silversea you can pre-reserve your excursions at leisure prior to your journey on the internet, log on to MySilversea (my.silversea.com) until 48 hours prior to sailing. If you have pre-reserved your excursions on line, your tickets will be delivered to your suite upon embarkation and all charges will be billed to your shipboard account.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

Once on board, you may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a consolidated tour booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the tours in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Tour tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

SHORE EXCURSION PRICING

Prices are generally quoted per person, per tour, with the exception of Silver Shore Privato or group-designated excursions. Prices are subject to change without notice. Please visit MySilversea (my.silversea.com) for the most up-to-date information. Discounts for children under 12 years of age are available on some, but not all tours. Prices for children, if available, will be adjusted onboard. Please meet with the Shore Concierge team prior to your excursion to discuss the availability of children's pricing.

ON-TIME TOUR DEPARTURES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, tour departures generally will not be announced unless there is an unforeseen change. Departure times from the ship are published in the ships daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicle. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least ten minutes prior to the tour departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pier-side to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore.

Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and tour departures as local conditions dictate. Please note that pier departure times are also listed in MySilversea (my.silversea.com)

TOUR SUITABILITY

At Silversea we offer a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. Some excursions are decidedly only for the physically fit and active guest. Each excursion offered is clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. ONBOARD SHORE CONCIERGE TEAM

Whether you wish to participate in an organised shore excursion or bespoke tailor-made tour, Silversea's experienced Shore Concierge team are happy to assist you in ensuring your shore- side experiences are nothing less than a memory that lasts forever.

The Shore Concierge team is available onboard on sea days from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Office opening hours in port may vary whilst staff is shore-side assisting you on tour. Please refer to the Silversea Chronicle for daily office opening hours. When contemplating a tailor-made program onboard, please contact the Shore Concierge team as early as possible at the beginning of your cruise, as time may be a factor in reaching local contacts. Please be aware that once arrangements have been confirmed, 100% cancellation fee will be applied. Unfortunately, we are unable to change or cancel airline tickets, car rental, hotel or any other reservations you made previously with your travel agent or on your own. In many ports of call there may be a local hospitality representative on board to provide additional information, for two hours after the ship's arrival. In some ports, local information may be found in the tourist information centre ashore.

PORT TALKS

Throughout your cruise we'll be offering Port & Shore Excursion information given by our Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant prior to arrival in each port of call. Our aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and many of your questions about our ports of call will be answered in these briefings, giving you more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port. The information is presented in the theater or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicle. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. To ensure the safety of our younger guests, children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service, if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment, to accommodate a child. Such harnesses' and secure seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

GRATUITIES

Gratuities for local guides and drivers are not included in the excursion price. It is customary to tip tour guides and drivers. Such gratuities if extended, should be done so on a voluntary, individual basis.

MOBILE TELEPHONES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, kindly refrain from using mobile telephones while on tour so as not to interfere with the guide's explanation. Most tours make frequent stops, allowing time for guests to use their mobile telephones. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.

JTR-C / DISCOVER OIA ON YOUR OWN

Explore the most charming village of Santorini during a memorable sightseeing and shopping excursion on this picturesque island. Panoramic Drive, Village of Oia

After tendering ashore at Athinios Port, depart for approximately 40-minute scenic drive to the northern tip of the island to Oia. This quaint little village was once the home of wealthy seafarers of the past, and features beautiful old cliff-side mansions and houses.

Free Time

Upon arrival, take a brief guided walking tour through the narrow cobbled streets of Oia. Following your walking tour, enjoy free time for additional independent exploration. See many tiny shops offering a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewelry. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

Following your visit to Oia, re-board the coach for your transfer back to the Athinios Port where your tender boat will await to take you back to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking, at times on cobblestone surfaces with many steps to negotiate. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Light-weight, comfortable clothing with closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Please note that at the conclusion of the tour you will have an option to remain in the town of Fira for self-exploration. Guests will have to make their own way to the tender boats from Fira using a cable car. Cable car ticket costs 6.00 Euros one way. Long lines for the cable cars may be encountered during the busy summer season.

JTR-E / PROFITIS ILIAS, OIA & OUZO

Experience the village life and spectacular scenery of Santorini during this half-day island tour.

Drive past typical Greek houses, an ancient Venetian fortress and several Byzantine churches en route to the Profitas Elias. A brief stop here, the highest point of the island, offers a spectacular panorama of the caldera below. Re-board your coach for the drive to Oia.

Village of Oia

Nestled in a fertile countryside, the village of Oia is among the most picturesque towns of the Cyclades Islands. This dramatic little village, built on a steep slope of the caldera, has many of its dwellings nestled in niches hewn into the volcanic rock. Once the home of wealthy seafarers of the past; still evident are their two story mansions painted in a spectrum of pastel colors. As you traverse its narrow cobbled streets you will come across many tiny shops which offer a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewelry. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

Brief Walking Tour & Free Time

Following your short walking tour, some free time is made available for you to take a leisurely stroll along the narrow, winding streets, and admire the beautiful old houses and charming, tiny shops.

Canava Distillery & Ouzo Tasting

Departing Oia, your next stop is at Canava distillery & museum. Here, guests can enjoy a visit of the distillery, with its antique distilling equipment, and a stroll through the museum. Within the newly-restored home, guests can see its recreated workplaces and rooms reflective of the people in Santorini's recent past. Every room is replicated using original items tirelessly collected over the years. Afterward, enjoy a taste of the spirits produced in Santorini's first distillery. Guests wishing to purchase some products can do so (please note that credit cards are not accepted).

Please note: This tour involves a moderate to extensive amount of walking and is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended. Tour sequence and duration may vary based on possible crowds. Guests must be at least 18 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. Please note that at the conclusion of the tour you will have an option to remain in the town of Fira for self-exploration. Guests will have to make their own way to the tender boats from Fira using a cable car. Cable car ticket costs 6.00 Euros one way. Long lines for the cable cars may be encountered during the busy summer season.

JTR-L / SANTORINI KAYAKING ADVENTURE

Experience the beauty of Santorini's breath-taking coast on this kayaking excursion that should not be missed. Paddle for two hours along the spectacular Caldera, stopping at a remote and lovely beach as you enjoy refreshments and rest, looking out at the exquisite turquoise waters before you.

Drive to Akrotiri Bay, Safety Briefing, Kayaking

After a short tender ride, board your van for approximately 30-minute transfer to the Akrotiri Bay. After a safety briefing, start your kayaking adventure. This region's stunningly clear, bright blue waters are known for their dramatic rock outcroppings that rise up from seemingly out of nowhere. Glide amidst this striking beauty in an oceangoing kayak.

Christos Beach, Snorkelling, Swimming, Snack

Take a break from all of the paddling with a visit to a sheltered, black-sand beach called Christos nestled below craggy cliffs with the caldera village Megalochori just above. Explore a little chapel, or snorkel in the pristine waters before enjoying refreshing local snack at your own private beach.

Please note: This tour involves extensive activity and participants must be in good physical condition and able to swim in water too deep to stand. Guests should wear a swimsuit under a cover-up, water shoes, plenty of sun protection and bring a towel from the ship. Kayaks used on this tour are 2 person kayaks and contain a waterproof compartment for storing your belongings. Snorkel equipment is provided. Minimum age to participate is 14 and a maximum weight of 209 pounds (95 kilograms) applies to all participants. Guest must sign a waiver to participate. Operation of this tour is subject to weather conditions. Space on this tour is extremely limited; we suggest you book well in advance to avoid disappointment. Please note that at the conclusion of the tour you will have an option to remain in the town of Fira for self-exploration. Guests will have to make their own way to the tender boats from Fira using a cable car. Cable car ticket costs 6.00 Euros one way. Long lines for the cable cars may be encountered during the busy summer season.

JTR-F / SANTORINI SIGHTS & SWIM

DIFFICULTY

Indulge your senses with the beauty and flavours of Santorini during this scenic and memorable sightseeing excursion.

Mt. Profitis Ilias

Disembark the ship onto your awaiting tender boat and set sail for Athinios Port. Upon arrival, board a coach and take in panoramic views of Santorini and the caldera as you ascend the colourful rocky sides of the caldera wall. Upon reaching the top, drive through the village of Pyrgos and up to Mt. Profitis Ilias. At 883 feet (269 metres), it is the highest peak in Santorini, and home of the early-18th-century monastery of the same name.

Village of Oia & Free Time

After taking in the spectacular views of the island, guests will re-board the coach for the drive to Oia, located on the northern end of the island. En route, see the different layers of lava the volcano has produced during in every phase of its activity. Upon arrival, take a brief guided walking tour through the narrow cobbled streets of Oia. Following your walking tour, enjoy free time for additional independent exploration. See many tiny shops offering a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewelry. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

Local Winery & Wine Tasting, Perivolos Beach

Next, re-board your coach and continue to a local winery for a wine tasting accompanied by barley rusks and local cheeses. Afterwards, proceed towards the volcanic, black-pebbled beach of Perivolos. Here, you will have a chance to enjoy approximately two hours at your leisure: lounge on a sunbed, stroll the long stretch of black sand, swim in the azure Aegean, or have a traditional Greek lunch on your own at one of the seaside taverns.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate to extensive amount of walking over uneven, cobbled and narrow pathways and is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Wear light-weight, comfortable clothing with closed-toe walking shoes and bring protection from the sun. Guests wishing to swim should wear a swimsuit under a cover-up, and bring a towel from the ship. Beach umbrellas and sunbeds are not included and are available for rent on first-come, first-serve basis. Swimming is at guest's own risk. Beach amenities include refreshment/snack bars. Only Euro currency is accepted. The operation of this programme is weather dependent. Guests must be at least 18 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. Please note that at the conclusion of the tour you will have an option to remain in the town of Fira for self-exploration. Guests will have to make their own way to the tender boats from Fira using a cable car. Cable car ticket costs 6.00 Euros one way. Long lines for the cable cars may be encountered during the busy summer season.

JTR-I / BEST OF SANTORINI

Experience the island of Santorini and its best sites during this full-day picturesque sightseeing excursion.

Akrotiri Excavations

Depart the ship by a local tender to Athinios, where you join the waiting motor-coach. Enjoy your scenic drive to the southern end of the island and the archaeological site of Akrotiri. A volcanic eruption circa 1,600 BCE destroyed all life on the island, and the island itself sank beneath the waves. The excavations here, led by Professor Spyros Marintos, began in 1967 and document the existence of life on Strongyle, legendary Atlantis; although no written records have ever surfaced to support this. It is an amazing city with houses, streets, squares and workshops, all of which had been covered under a thick blanket of pumice for over 3,500 years. You are able to walk around this ancient city among well-preserved buildings, which will give you an insight into the ancient civilisation of Santorini, the center of a civilisation akin to the Minoans of Crete.

Venetsanos Winery & Wine Tasting, Panoramic Views, Local Tavern & Lunch

After your visit, continue to Venetsanos Winery where you will sample the famous Santorini wines and admire panoramic views of the Caldera of Santorini. Continue to a local tavern where your lunch awaits and taste Greek delicacies.

Village of Oia & Free Time

Depart for the scenic drive to the northern tip of the island, and a visit to Oia. This quaint little village was once the home of wealthy seafarers of the past, and features beautiful old cliff-side mansions and houses. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour through the narrow cobbled streets of Oia. Following your walking tour, enjoy free time for additional independent exploration. See many tiny shops offering a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewellery. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

At the end of tour, return through the beautiful countryside back to the port of Athinios where your tender will await to take you to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate to extensive amount of walking over uneven, cobbled and narrow pathways and is thus not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Guests should wear seasonal clothing, flat walking shoes and sun protection. Guests must be at least 18 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. Please note that at the conclusion of the tour you will have an option to remain in the town of Fira for self-exploration. Guests will have to make their own way to the tender boats from Fira using a cable car. Cable car ticket costs 6.00 Euros one way. Long lines for the cable cars may be encountered during the busy summer season.

JTR-K / TRADITIONAL CAIQUE, VOLCANO HIKE & HOT SPRINGS

DIFFICULTY



Price:\$89; Duration:3.25 hrs



This excursion is a truly Grecian adventure, with the opportunity to sail on a traditional kaiki boat to an active volcano, Nea Kameni, on the Aegean Sea, and take swim in a volcanic hot spring at Palea Kameni.

Traditional Kaiki Boat, Sailing the Caldera, Nea Kameni Volcano Hike, Panoramic Views

Travel aboard a traditional Greek sailboat called a kaiki (or caïque), a charming wooden boat and traditional fishing vessel that has a long, pointed bow and is often painted in bright colors. Sail first to Nea Kameni, a small volcanic island within the Santorini caldera. Hike to the edge of the active volcano crater past unique, almost alien lava formations. Both Nea Kameni and its neighbour, Palea Kameni, were formed over the past two thousand years by repeated eruptions. Your reward will be an awe-inspiring panorama of the island and sea.

Palea Kameni Hot Springs, Swimming

Afterwards, continue to sail to Palea Kameni, a home of hot springs known for their healing properties. Here, you will have a chance to spend approximately half an hour swimming and relaxing in this magical place. At the conclusion of your excursion, take the relaxation with you and enjoy approximately half an hour sail back to the Old Port of Fira.

Scenic Drive to Myrtos Beach

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive through the verdant countryside filled with vineyards, ever-present olive trees and thick cypress glades. En route, a photo stop is made at a cliff-side viewpoint for splendid views of Myrtos, the most stunning beach on the island. Your drive then continues for approximately 40-minutes along the mountain roads leading to Fiskardo.

Fiskardo

Located in the northeast corner of the island, the delightful village of Fiskardo is the most typical Cephalonian village. Pastel-coloured houses surround the waterfront, which is lined with coffee shops, 'tavernas' and souvenir shops. The natural safe harbour is a centre for the jet set and their yachts; just opposite lies the mythical island of Ithaca. After some free time in Fiskardo at your leisure, re-board the coach and proceed to Melissani Lake.

Melissani Lake

Subterranean channels feed this underground lake with water running to the opposite side of the island. Partly exposed to the elements, the cave is accessible via a manmade tunnel leading to the shore of the open part of the lake. Argostoli

Melissani Lake

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive through the verdant countryside, then pass by Mt. Ainos and through picturesque villages en route to Melissani Lake. Upon arrival, take a brief walk down a tunnel and to the shore of the underground lake. From here, board a small wooden boat for a ride along the deep turguoise waters of the lake and the surrounding caves. Amazing stalactites sprout from the walls, and natural light penetrates and reflects on the lake in a myriad of colour.

Sami

Next, re-board your coach and proceed for a visit to the town of Sami. The island's biggest port, Sami was made famous in recent years as the setting for the motion picture, Captain Corelli's Mandolin. Upon arrival, some free time is made available to explore the resort, purchase refreshments, and browse the shops and seafront.

Drogarati Cave

During the return drive to Argostoli, a stop is made for a visit to one of the most awe-inspiring caves on the island. Lying approximately 197 feet (about 60 metres) below the surface, Drogarati Cave is more than two million years old. A spiral staircase leads to this remarkable natural phenomenon. The concealed lighting arouses the senses, and highlights the hidden depths of the cave. Following your visit, re-board your coach for the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking, with approximately 200 total stairs/steps to negotiate at the Drogarati Caves and Melissani Lake. This tour is not suitable for guests suffering from claustrophobia, guests with breathing difficulties, guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. The cave is over 200 feet (about 61 feet) underground, and its interior temperature is 64.4 degrees Fahrenheit (18 degrees Celsius). The cave floor can be steep and slippery due to moisture. Monastery of St. Andrew

Next, visit the Monastery of St. Andrew. During the 1953 earthquake, the whitewash covering the inside of the church was loosened and revealed frescoes dating from the 13th and 17th centuries; they are now considered to be the island's greatest artistic treasures. High on a hill opposite the monastery is the Venetian fortress of St. George, which was built on the site of an ancient citadel and features commanding views of the surrounding plain.

Robola Winery, Wine Tasting & Local Snack

Your tour concludes with a visit to the Robola Winery. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour of the winery and learn about the production methods of the famous and rare Robola wine, which is made from a local species of white grape that comes in red, white and sweet Muscat. Following your walking tour, you are invited to sample five kinds of wine before re-boarding your coach for the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Agios Gerasimos Monastery

Meet your tour guide and board your accessible van at the pier. Start your journey with a short approximately 30-minute scenic drive to the beautiful Agios Gerasimos Monastery. Located on the plateau of Omalon east of Argostoli, this Monastery site is the center of religious practices on the island and also houses the bones of the island's patron saint Gerassimos. It is said that he came to Cephalonia in 1560 and lived in a cave south of Argostoli before founding the monastery where he lived and then died in 1579. After his death, a beautiful little church was built over his grave. A much larger Byzantine style church has since been established right next to it. This church is considered a part of the Monastery site and it offers an incredible, richly decorated interior where you can experience ceiling murals depicting the scenes from the Old Testament, the birth and baptism of Jesus, the Last Supper and many more.

Robola Winery, Wine Tasting & Local Snack

Your tour continues to the charming Robola Winery located right by the Monastery. This small gem is located in an incredible country setting where local grapes are turned into Cehalonia's most popular wine. Here, you will enjoy a short, guided tour and learn about the wine production process and enjoy a delicious wine tasting experiences accompanied by delicious local cheese, tomatoes, cucumber and breadsticks. You will also have a chance to purchase some of your favorite wine and take it home with you.

Village of Assos & Free Time

After your visit to the Winery, you will be heading out on a picturesque drive to the village of Assos located on the west coast of the island. This charming little fishing village offers the perfect scene for memorable vacation photos. The village seems to be 'lost in time' and has an almost mystical atmosphere. Upon arrival, guide provides you with a quick orientation and then you will be given some free time to explore this charming village on your own. Experience Sicily's magnificent volcanic splendour and historic past during this memorable full-day visit to Mount Etna, and a sightseeing tour of Catania. Mt. Etna is Europe's most active volcano soaring to a height of 10,813 feet (3,296 metres).

Depart the pier for a brief sightseeing drive through Siracusa.

Siracusa

Partially-located on the mainland of Sicily's east coast and partially on an island connected to the mainland by three bridges, this powerful city-state was once the bulwark of Greek civilization. Along the way, pass by the Island of Ortygia, then continue on through the main streets of this historic town. Leaving Siracusa, re-board your coach for the drive to Catania.

Catania

Upon arrival at the Catania Centre, take a brief sightseeing drive past Via Etnea, Villa Bellini and Piazza Stesicoro. Next, proceed to Piazza Duomo for a short walking tour past the Cathedral, University and other scenic landmarks. Following your walking tour, some time is made available to explore the area before re-boarding your coach for the 45-60-minute drive to Mount Etna.

Mount Etna

Mount Etna is Europe's most active volcano. Its slopes soar to a height of 10,813 feet (3,296 metres) above sea level, and are covered with cones and craters. Upon arrival at the 6,398-foot (1,950-metre) Crateri Silverstri, you may opt to visit one of the bars or restaurants, or walk around the visitor area for magnificent panoramic vistas and photos over woods, orchards, vineyards and the Catania Gulf. The highlight of your visit is the sight of the awe-inspiring crater and lava streams, including those stemming from eruptions in 2001 and 2002.

Following your visit, proceed to the nearby *Parco dei Principi* restaurant for a typical Sicilian lunch with wine. After lunch, re-board your bus for the approximate 2-hour return drive to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves minimal walking of approximately .50 miles (800 metres) in Catania, and uneven ground at the Crateri Silvestri area, and is suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to bring a winter jacket with a windproof outer-layer, as the temperatures atop Mount Etna can be windy and cool, even during the summer months. Closed-toe shoes are recommended for guests who opt to walk around the Crateri Silvestri at their discretion. Caution is also advised when walking across lava and rocky ground, where crevices still exude fumes and heat. Guests who do not wish to walk here may relax in the bars and restaurants in front of the coach parking area.

QIC-C / CLASSICAL SIRACUSA

Sicily's ancient treasures and picturesque beauty are yours to discover during this memorable visit to Siracusa, and a walking tour through Ortygia's Old Town. Once one of ancient Greece's most important cities, today Syracuse (Siracusa in Italian) is a lively town on Sicily's southeast coast overflowing with amazing remnants from its long history.

Depart the pier for the scenic drive to Siracusa.

Siracusa Archaeological Site

Upon arrival, proceed to the archaeological site and commence your walking tour though this historic venue. Along the way, a visit is made at the Roman Amphitheatre of Augustus, used for contests between gladiators and wild beasts, followed by the Altar of Hieron, constructed in the 2nd century B.C. to celebrate the 'Eleutherian Feast'.

Next, see the Ear of Dionysius, an enormous grotto with an extraordinary echo, and the Greek Theatre. One of the largest theatres in the Hellenic World, the Greek Theatre was constructed in the 5th century B.C., and subsequently enlarged to its present size. Leaving Siracusa, reboard your coach for the brief drive to Ortygia.

Ortygia

Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour through the Old Town, whose narrow streets are lined by old, Baroque-style houses with charming balconies. A visit is made to the Baroque-style Cathedral, which was erected over the remains of the Doric Temple of Minerva. Inside the cathedral, see 12 undamaged Doric columns and a splendid painting of Antonello da Messina.

Next, proceed for a visit to the picturesque Arethusa Fountain, celebrated by Pindar and Virgilio as the mythical spring of the nymph Arethusa. From here, your walking tour continues past several 15th- and 16th-century nobility palaces, including Palazzo Impellizzeri, Palazzo Bonanno, and Palazzo Bufardeci. Additional sites to be seen include Piazza Pancali, the Church of San Francesco, Archimedes' Square with the Fountain of Diana, Via della Giudecca, Via della Maestranza, and Corso Matteotti, Ortygia's main and most elegant shopping area.

Following your walking tour, some free time is made available for you to browse the shops at your leisure before walking back to the pier.

Please note: The visit to the Siracusa archaeological site and Ortygia are entirely on-foot for approximately 2000m (1.25 miles), and includes paved and unpaved surfaces and uneven ground inside the archaeological site. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Comfortable clothing, walking shoes and sun protection is recommended. The tour sequence may vary.

QIC-G / RAGUSA AND MODICA

Embrace the splendid beauty, architecture and flavours of Sicily during this scenic, full-day excursion to Ragusa and Modica.

Ragusa Ibla, St. George's Church, Giardino Ibleo Garden and Church of St. James the Apostle

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 1.5-hour drive to Ragusa Ibla, the Old Town and an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Ragusa Ibla is the hub from which the city of Ragusa developed. It is located in the eastern part of the city, on a hill approximately 1,312 feet (about 400 metres) above sea level. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour of the Old Town. Along the way, see highlights that include St. George's Church with its impressive Baroque façade and bell tower, the 19th-century Giardino Ibleo Garden and 14th-century Church of St. James the Apostle, which was rebuilt in the 18th century. The impressive Cathedral was built between 1706 and 1760, and stands on a wide terrace on a loggia overlooking the central Piazza San Giovanni. Its 'campanile' (bell tower) makes the monumental façade strangely asymmetrical.

Free Time, Lunch, Modica Walking Tour, St. Peter's Church, and Dolceria

Following your guided walking tour, some free time is made available for shopping, browsing or visiting the Giardino Ibleo Garden. Afterward, meet your guide and re-board your coach and head to Modica, perched on the southern slopes of the Hiblean Mountains. The upper-town is perched on a wedge-shaped plateau, while the lower part that surrounds it is in the unusual shape of a 'Y'. After lunch at a local restaurant, take a guided walking tour in the Baroque part of the city, pass by St. Peter's Church and stop by a local 'dolceria' for a tasting of chocolate made from an ancient Maya recipe. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 1.5-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.24 miles (about two kilometres), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces and inclines, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the Cathedral. Walking in Ragusa is at the

discretion of each guest. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Discover the splendid beauty, history and architecture of the island of Siracusa during this picturesque, half-day excursion to the Baroque town of Noto.

Scenic Drive

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive through the countryside, and past villages and almond groves en route to Noto. A *UNESCO World Heritage Site*, Noto is the second-largest town in the province of Siracusa and the best example of Sicilian Baroque architecture on the island.

Noto

Originally settled in the 5th century B.C., Noto was destroyed by the Earthquake of 1693, and rebuilt on a grid plan according to the architectural theories of the 18th century. Handsome palaces, churches and other Baroque monuments line the streets, built from the local white limestone that has mellowed to a golden hue over time.

The town is built on terraces connected by monumental flights of steps. Its major buildings are located in three groups along the main street, Corso Vittorio Emanuele. The street widens in three places dominated by the expansive facades of Baroque-style churches.

Walking Tour

Upon arrival, your guided walking tour of Noto begins at the Public Gardens. Admire the busts of artists who contributed to the town's culture and style, then proceed for seeing four of the town's most impressive landmarks; the Church of St. Dominic, the Church of St. Charles, the Cathedral (including inside) and the Ducezio Palace. Afterward, some time is made available to explore Noto at your leisure before re-boarding the coach for the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 1,400m (.90 miles), with some steps to negotiate at the Cathedral. The visit to Noto is entirely on-foot. Erice

Palermo, City Centre, Piazza Verdi, Opera House

Marvel at the 'Symbolic Wheel' overlooking the Auditorium; it looks like a giant flower with eleven petals that, through a system of ropes, open up to let out the hot air and ventilate the room. Following your tour, some free time is made available to explore Palermo's city centre. Afterward, re-board your coach and head to the International Marionette Museum.

International Marionette Museum, Guided Tour, Puppet Show, Refreshments

This popular, traditional museum of Palermo was established in 1975 by Antonio Pasqualino, when he started its collection of puppets from Sicily and all over the world; after his death in 1995, the museum took his name. Located in the Kalsa Quarter in the former Hotel de France, this 957-square-yard (about 800-square-metre) museum features two floors of puppet displays. In 2017, the museum received the Icom Italia Award for *Museum of the Year*. Following your guided tour and a puppet show, enjoy some refreshments accompanied by local specialities. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 1.5-hour drive back to the pier.

The façade is in late Renaissance style; inside, the chapels are in rococo style with very rich marble decorations and eighteenth-century frescoes, which make it one of the richest churches in Palermo. The visit continues also inside the Monastery, where the cloistered nuns were leaving, exploring their private cells. Weather permitting, access upstairs on the terrace to enjoy a magnificent view of Palermo centre.

Before returning to the coach, take the opportunity of tasting some special local sweets. Afterwards drive back to pier.

Capri

Amalfi, a rare place where photographs simply don't do the sights justice, enjoy the world famous coastal drive to Amalfi. Explore up close and personal on this walking tour through the seaside village of the Amalfi Coast. Amalfi Coastal Drive

Amalfi

Distinctive for its black-and-white facade and its mosaics, the building features bronze doors cast in Constantinople in 1066 and a bell tower dating to the 13th century. Head out from the Piazza del Duomo and explore the narrow alleyways lined with shops and boutiques and enjoy free time for own lunch.

Walking Tour

For those Guests interested, follow your guide and visit the monumental complex of the Cathedral of St. Andrew: the Bell Tower, the Cloister of Paradise, the Basilica of Crucifix, with its frescoed chapels and the museum with sacred treasure, The Crypt, built in 1206 to hold the sacred remains of St. Andrew Apostole, the Moorish style Cathedral, which features stunning the 11th century bronze door from Constantinople.

Continue on to the Amalfi Paper Museum, located in a 14th century medieval paper-mill and which hosts machineries and instruments used in the ancient paper-mills. The ancient technologies, restored and active, reconstruct the entire production cycle of the paper. Among the century-old tools in the museum it is possible to admire the ancient wooden mauls, operated by a hydraulic wheel; the press used to remove the water in excess from the paper; the continuous printing machine. The museum gives also the opportunity of assisting the handmade paper production and the functioning of the ancient water-mills, moved by the waters of the Canneto torrent.

Then, walk back to Piazza Duomo, dominated by the impressive façade of the St. Andrew Cathedral and have some free time for lunch on your own.

Your tour concludes when you return to Sorrento.

Please note that due to local regulations and restrictions, an alternate stop on the Amalfi Coast (Minori, Maiori or Vietri sul Mare) will be made should a parking space not be available in Amalfi.

Tuscania

Church of S. Luigi dei Francesi, Caravaggio Paintings, Piazza Navona, Fountain of the Four Rivers

Leaving the Pantheon, walk to the Church of S. Luigi dei Francesi, a church serving Rome's French community since 1589. This opulent church is home to a celebrated trio of Caravaggio paintings; the Vocazione di San Matteo (Calling of Saint Matthew), the Martirio di San Matteo (Martyrdom of Saint Matthew) and San Matteo e l'angelo (Saint Matthew and the Angel), known collectively as the 'St. Matthew Cycle'. Following your visit, head to Piazza Navona and walk through the square, said to be the most beautiful in Rome. Nice

The charming Château de Saint Martin has nearly always been managed, with one exception, by women. Discover the picturesque beauty and historic past of Nice during a tour of the Old City, and a visit to the medieval village of Eze. **Nice**

Depart the pier for the scenic drive along the Promenade des Anglais, a splendid, palm-lined boulevard stretching for three miles along the Baie des Anges. Pass by landmarks that include the legendary 'Negresco', an imposing hotel with a rococo façade, and the Russian Orthodox Cathedral. It was built with pink bricks, light grey marble and bright ceramics crowned by six onion-shaped domes that give the city an exotic touch.

Next, a visit is made to the Old City. Here, tall houses tightly-packed across narrow streets are often festooned with bright flowers or hanging laundry, and designed to provide shade and keep the streets cool during the long, hot summers. Upon arrival, take a leisurely stroll along the Cours Saleya, the elegant promenade of Old Nice, which is now lined with shops, restaurants and the famous flower market.

Eze

Leaving Nice by way of the Middle Corniche, take in superb scenic views of Nice during the drive to the medieval village of Eze, perched on a rocky promontory overlooking the coast. Upon arrival, walk up to and through the 14th-century double gateway. A sentry walk leads into the steep and narrow streets, passageways and stairways. At times, the streets run beneath the carefully-restored houses that now serve as smart boutiques or artist's studios.

Following your visit, re-board your coach for the drive to the Nice airport.
