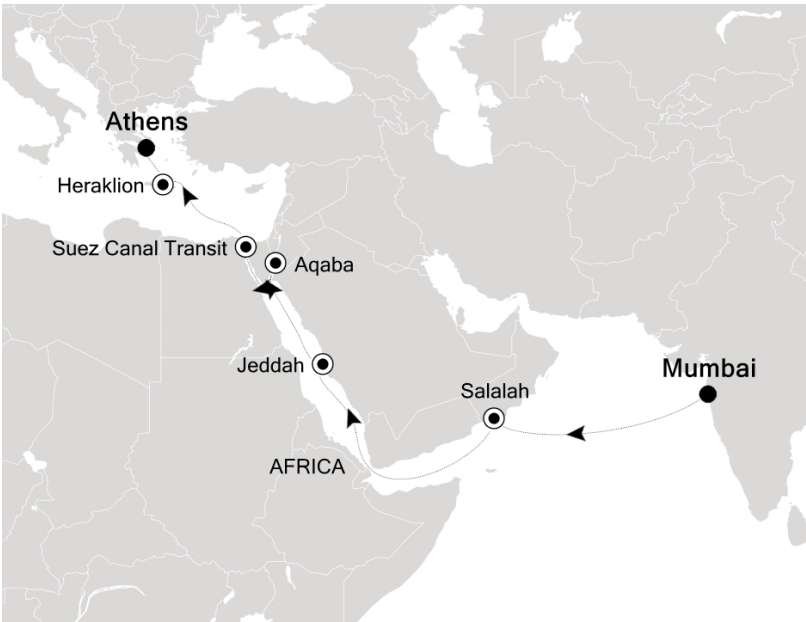

ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Booking Direct with Silversea gives you peace of mind. Our local tour operators are fully insured and have been comprehensively vetted. In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore Excursions are available on a first-come, first served basis. Guests should note that some shore excursions are very popular with guests and often ending up being waitlisted. In order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate in excursions are subject to availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge Desk within the cancellation deadline. For our selected Shore Excursions Tickets returned after the cancellation deadline will be charged 100% cancellation fee to the guest's onboard account. Cancellation deadlines for the majority of our shore excursions is 48hrs prior to the port of call. Please note that certain shore excursions might have a different cancellation deadline; all cancellation deadlines are stated in the please note section of the shore excursion, booking form and shore excursion tickets.

In case guests' first choice in a single port is waitlisted, Silversea recommends guests choose an alternative option, which will be considered confirmed. Should the first choice subsequently be confirmed as guests will be notified about the status of the waitlisted tour and have the option to make a final choice on MySilversea. More excursions are available for purchase at full price. Silversea strongly advises booking shore excursions to avoid disappointment. The deadline for booking Shore Excursions on MySilversea is 2 days prior departure date. Silversea reserves the right to cancel any excursions including free shore excursions. No credit or other compensation will be given if free shore excursions are unavailable, cancelled or not utilized. All shore excursions including those offered on a complimentary basis are operated by independent operators over whom Silversea has no control. All advertised fares, savings, offers, programs and itineraries are correct at time of printing, are subject to availability and may change at any time. Other restrictions may apply.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

You may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a shore excursion booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the shore excursions in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Shore Excursion tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

Prices are generally quoted per person, per tour, with the exception of Silver Shore Privato or group-designated excursions. Prices are subject to change without notice. SHORE EXCURSION DEPARTURE TIMES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, shore excursion departures generally will not be announced unless there is an unforeseen change. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least 10-minutes prior to the shore excursion departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pierside to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore. Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and shore excursion departures as local conditions dictate. Please note that approximate pier departure times are also listed in MySilversea (my.silversea.com).

SHORE EXCURSION SUITABILITY

Silversea offers a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. However, certain excursions are more appropriate for physically fit and active guests. All excursions offered are clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. We also offer a good variety of Accesible Shore Excursion worldwide (according to the ports availability and local structure) that are designed for guests unable to negotiate motor coach steps or for full time wheelchair/scooter users. The vehicle used on this type of shore excursion is adapted with an access ramp (or lift where available) to accommodate a limited number of mobility devices. In order to use the ramp and/or lift, guests are required to be seated on a wheelchair or scooter. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain to select excursions that meet your physical capability. We therefore encourage guests to review the excursion description carefully including the PLEASE NOTE section which includes useful information. Silversea also offers Destination Experience

Briefings onboard. If you have any questions or concerns regarding shore excursion suitability, please contact the Shore Concierge (shoreconcierge@silversea.com) prior to your cruise or visit the Shore Concierge desk for more detailed information once onboard.

Whether you wish to participate in an organised shore excursion or tailor-made shore excursion, Silversea's experienced Shore Concierge team are happy to assist you to plan the best shore-side experiences with knowledgeable suggestions, personalized planning for sightseeing, water sports, golf and more. The Shore Concierge team is available onboard on sea days from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Office opening hours in port may vary whilst staff is shore-side assisting those on excursions. Please refer to the Silversea Chronicles for daily office opening hours. Once onboard, those considering a bespoke excursion should contact the Shore Concierge team at their earliest possible convenience, as time may be a factor in reaching local contacts. Please be aware that once arrangements are confirmed they are non-refundable.

DESTINATION EXPERIENCE BRIEFINGS

Throughout the voyage the Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant will offer port and shore excursion information prior to arrival in each port of call. Their aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and answer as many of your questions as possible. The information is presented in the theatre or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system, and will allow more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicles. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. Children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment. Such harnesses' and secure

seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately, guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY CHARGES

Please note that photography at some museums, sites and monuments and/or the use of video cameras may not be allowed or may incur a charge. These charges are not included in the tour price and are at guests' own expense. Further details will be in the detailed shore excursion description and please note section. Please ensure to review these in detail prior to departing on your shore excursion.

SHOPPING STOPS

While our organised excursions are not generally geared to the serious shopper, some shore excursions allow for short shopping stops as indicated in the shore excursion description. In the interest of all participants, guests should adhere to the allotted time and return to the tour vehicle promptly as advised by the tour guide or ship's escort. Please Note: The selection of shops is generally left to the discretion of the tour operator. Silversea does require that establishments be reputable, of general interest to our guests and offer quality goods. However, all purchases are the responsibility of the individual.

Salalah - Oman

SLL-D / Serene Salalah

Difficulty

Discover Salalah and the surrounding area with its contrast between the lush green vegetation of the Garden city and the barren yet majestic landscape of the desert. En route to the Salalah museum you may be so lucky to even see a camel roaming the roadside.

Al Balid

The ancient city known as Dhufa grew in this area between the 12th and 16th centuries. Today, the ruins of this magnificent city can be seen at the Al Balid archaeological site in the Haffa district of Salalah. Dhufa was once surrounded by water and a massive wall complete with gates and turrets. There is evidence of a grand mosque, palaces, houses and tombs that indicate the historical standing of the area. There was a thriving export of frankincense and Arab horses to India and the Far East from Al Balid. A visit is made to Museum of the Land of Frankincense which is located inside of the Al Balid site.

Grand Mosque

Enjoy a photo stop of the beautiful Grand Mosque with its exquisite art work and stained tiles.

Al Husn Palace

Next, drive through the grounds of the magnificent Al Husn Palace where photos can only be taken from the coach. The Palace is the personal residence of His Majesty, The Sultan of Oman.

Al Husn Souq

Lastly, stop at the Al Husn Souq and stroll among the vendors. The colourful stalls are heaped with mounds of frankincense, myrrh, incense, bottles of fragrant perfume oils and a large variety of fascinating artefacts.

Your tour concludes with a short ride back to the pier to embark the ship.

Please Note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 656 yards (600 meters) over rough, uneven ground at the archaeological site that may be on rough, uneven ground and approximately 5-10 steps throughout. This tour is not recommended for guests who utilize a wheelchair. Guests with limited mobility may require the assistance of their travel partner. Women visiting the Mosque must be fully covered and are required to cover their heads with a scarf. Shorts, sleeveless tops, beachwear are not allowed at Job's tomb. Vehicles and guides are the best available in the city. Air conditioning cannot be guaranteed. The order of sites may vary. Souvenir shops accept cash in US Dollars or local currency. Credit cards are mostly not accepted. Do not take photographs of individuals without their permission. Women in particular, do not like being photographed. It is forbidden to take pictures of military facilities, borders and airports. Keep an eye out for 'No Photography' signs. The Grand Mosque is closed on Fridays in the afternoons and during Ramadan, therefore only outside visits would be made instead.

SLL-E / Salalah on Your Own Exploration

Experience the town of Salalah at your leisure during this 2 hour, self-guided excursion to the capital of Dhofar Province which is located in the southern region of the Sultanate of Oman. The Dhofar region has been known for centuries for the production of frankincense. Together with a traditional burner, made of plain clay or decorated in attractive colours, it makes for a nice souvenir.

Al Husn Souq

Guests will be dropped off at the Al Husn Souq to stroll on their own among the vendors. The colourful stalls are heaped with mounds of frankincense, myrrh, incense, bottles of fragrant perfume oils and a large variety of fascinating artefacts.

On arrival your guide will advise of the central meet point for the return drive to the pier to re-join the ship.

Please Note: This tour requires a minimal amount of activity and walking is at the discretion of the guest. Please dress conservatively when going ashore. Beach wear is not considered appropriate attire. Women should not wear anything revealing, including miniskirts, shorts, sleeveless or low-cut tops. Men should always wear a shirt in public. Please do not photograph people without their permission, especially women, who will be greatly offended. You may not take pictures of government buildings, embassies or anything military in nature, including airports. Most shops and souqs are closed between 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. The local currency is the Omani rial. Many businesses and venues are closed on Fridays.

SLL-I / Amazing Salalah

Discover the amazing sites of Salalah City and its surrounds during this picturesque, half-day sightseeing excursion.

Salalah City, Lush Vegetation, Desert Landscape, Sultan Qaboos Mosque Salalah

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 30-minute drive through Salalah City and its surrounds to see the contrast between the lush vegetation of the 'Garden City' and the barren, bleak landscape of the desert. The first stop on your sightseeing tour of Salalah is at the huge Sultan Qaboos Mosque Salalah (Salalah Grand Mosque). Upon arrival, take a guided tour inside this beautiful house of worship.

Guided Visit, Marble, Artwork, Tiles, Swarovski Crystal Chandelier, New Salalah Souk, Shopping

Built between 1995-2001, the Salalah Grand Mosque is the largest mosque in Oman and can accommodate up to 20,000 worshippers. The entire interior is panelled with off-white and dark grey marble, and features exquisite artwork and stained tiles. An approximately 20-ton (about 18-tonne) hand-woven carpet with 115 million individual knots covers the floors. The ceilings are inspired by those of Omani forts, and a Swarovski crystal chandelier with gold-plated metalwork hangs down approximately 46 feet (about 14 metres). Afterward, re-board your coach and head to the New Salalah Souk, where a shopping stop is made to browse the many stalls selling spices, tropical fruit, handicrafts, clothing, and souvenirs.

Coconut and Banana Plantation, Coconut Tree-Climbing, Coconut Tasting, Camels

Next, re-board your coach and continue to your final stop, a visit to a coconut and banana plantation. En route, look for the occasional camel roaming the countryside. Upon arrival at the plantation, proceed for a demonstration of coconut tree-climbing and an opportunity to sample the fresh coconut. At the conclusion of your tour, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.6 miles (about one kilometre), at times over uneven, natural, and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and access the shoppes at the New Salalah Souk, and five steps at the Salalah Grand Mosque. Walking at the New Salalah Souk is at the discretion of each guest. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised

to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection, insect repellent, bottled water, and US Dollars, local currency, or credit cards for purchases from the ship; few shops accept credit cards. Because of the differences in temperature between the air-conditioned vehicles and outside, we recommend that you bring along a light cotton jumper (sweater or light jacket). Proper attire is required to enter the mosque; women must wear modest clothing that covers the entire body and bring a scarf that covers the head and hair. Arms and legs must be covered to the wrists and ankles. Men must wear modest clothing befitting the sanctity of the Salalah Grand Mosque. Tattoos must be completely covered before entering the Salalah Grand Mosque. Shorts, transparent, or see-through clothing, shorts and skirts, sleeveless shirts, clothing with profanity, tight clothing, swimwear, and beachwear are not permitted inside the Salalah Grand Mosque. Food, drinks, and smoking are strictly prohibited inside the Salalah Grand Mosque. Slip-on shoes are recommended, as guests are required to remove their shoes before entering the Salalah Grand Mosque; we suggest bringing along a pair of thick socks, because the pavement may be hot. Guests must be at least four years old to participate on this tour; minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over 18 years old to participate on this tour. Do not take photographs of local individuals without their permission. Women do not like being photographed. Observe 'No Photography' signs. The Salalah Grand Mosque is closed on Fridays, National Holidays, and VIP visits. The New Salalah Souk is closed on Friday mornings; the site will be visited from the outside only. Be advised that wildlife, while common, is not guaranteed. The tour sequence may vary. During the Ramadan time the Grand Mosque will be closed and guests will visit it only from the outside.

SLL-L / The Frankincense Trail

Discover Salalah by driving into the Salalah city and surrounding area to see the contrast between the lush vegetation of the Garden city and the barren, bleak landscape of the desert. Leaving the Port, the tour begins with a visit to the Salalah grand Mosque. You may even see a camel, roaming the roadside.

Al Kouf Salalah Souq

Stop at the New Salalah Souq and stroll among the vendors. The colorful stalls are heaped with mounds of frankincense, myrrh, incense, bottles of fragrant perfume oils and a large variety of fascinating artefacts.

Al Dahriz village & Lagoon

Khawr Al Dahriz is located at the eastern entrance of Salalah city in the Governate of Dhofar. It rises 3 meters above sea level, and is surrounded by a group of dense vegetation, making it a good location for the breeding of many types of birds. Spacious and convenient location for trips and away from hustle and bustle of the city. Its waters intermingle with Salalah basin waters, especially the wells located on the coastal strip. This lagoon is important to biodiversity as it is heavily frequented by migratory birds.

Mughsail Beach

Take a short walk and admire the 2-mile (3 kilometres) stretch of unspoilt, white sandy beach with steep cliffs at both ends. If your arrival coincides with the high tides, you may be able to witness the spectacular 'Blow Holes' shoot jets of water into the air before returning back to Salalah Port.

Major points of interest seen on this excursion may include:

Al Kouf Salalah Souq, Al Dahriz village & lagoon, Mughsail Beach.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 900 yards (822 meters) over rough, uneven ground at the archaeological site and with 35 steps at Mughsail Beach. It is not recommended for guests utilizing a wheelchair or those with limited mobility. Air conditioning cannot be guaranteed. We suggest you wear sturdy walking shoes. Shorts, beachwear, and sleeveless shirts are not permitted. The order of sites seen or visited may vary. It is forbidden to take pictures of military facilities, borders and airports; observe the "NO PHOTOGRAPHY" signs. Sighting of the now rare frankincense trees cannot be guaranteed. Souvenir shops accept cash in US Dollars or local currency. Credit cards are mostly not accepted.

SELECTED EXCURSION

SLL-F / Salalah Beach Getaway with Lunch

Relax and unwind amidst a full-day of Omani sunshine, sightseeing and shopping during this picturesque beach excursion with lunch.

Salalah, Al Husk Souq, Shopping, Salalah Rotana Hotel, Rotana Restaurant, Lunch

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 30-minute drive to the Al Husk Souq, where some free time is made available to browse the stalls for frankincense, myrrh, incense oils, spices, and more. Following your visit, re-board your coach and head to the Salalah Rotana Hotel. Upon arrival, proceed for a buffet lunch at the hotel's Rotana restaurant.

Free Time, Hotel Swimming Pool and Beach, Salalah Grand Mosque

After lunch, some free time is made available to relax by the Salalah Rotana Hotel's swimming pool and beach. Next, re-board your coach and drive to the Salalah Grand Mosque for an exterior photo stop. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a minimal amount of walking for approximately 547 yards (about 500 metres), at times over uneven and sandy surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get in/out of the coach and 15 steps at the Al Husn Souq. Walking at the Al Kouf Souq and Salalah Rotana Hotel are at the discretion of each guest. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear a swimsuit under a cover-up with beach shoes, and bring sun protection, a towel and change of clothing from the ship. The tour sequence may vary. For calls falling within the months of Ramadan, lunch will be served at the restaurant however the curtains will remain closed.

SLL-G / Dhofar 'Grand Canyon' Tour

Experience the lifestyles, legacy and landmarks of Oman along the road less-travelled during this panoramic, full-day jeep excursion.

Salalah, Taqa, Old Town, Samhuran, Queen of Sheba Palace Ruins

Depart the pier via Jeep for the scenic, approximately one-hour drive east to the Old Town of Taqa. Upon arrival, take a sightseeing drive through the Old Town, then head to Samhuran (Khor Rohri). Here, an exterior photo stop is made at the ancient ruins of the palace of the legendary Queen of Sheba, believed to have been the centre of shipping for frankincense.

Wadi Darbat, Wadi Bed Stroll, Animals, Lakes, Greenery

Parts of Wadi Rum resemble a lunar landscape, aptly called the 'Valley of the Moon'. Here, the legend of Lawrence of Arabia was born. A rock formation known as The Seven Pillars of Wisdom was immortalized in the book and film about the legendary figure.

This Wadi Rum adventure concludes back at a Bedouin tent in the desert. Enjoy a cup of coffee or tea before heading back to Aqaba and the ship by coach.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of activity and it is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. The desert drive is mostly over rugged and bumpy terrain and is not suitable for those with neck or back problems and/ or pregnant women. Petra

Depart the port in comfortable coaches and travel north along the Desert Highway. The last stretch is on country road through several small villages. Upon arrival at Petra, begin your visit on foot. The long, narrow gorge with steeply rising sides all but obliterates the sun. For those who wish, the entrance to the siq may be reached on horseback - at your own risk. (There is no charge for this service but the horseman will expect a gratuity.)

Khazneh (Treasury)

As you exit the gorge, it suddenly opens into a natural square dominated by Petra's most famous monument, the Treasury. Its intricately carved façade presents a magnificent sight in the dazzling sun. If you have seen the movie Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade, you will no doubt recognize the façade. Follow the guide farther into the site and discover other impressive structures carved out of the rose-colored stone. They include temples, royal tombs and an amphitheater that could seat 3,000 spectators. The Petra basin boasts over 800 individual monuments; to explore it all would take several days.

Your visit of approximately three hours concludes with the walk back via the same way. Optionally, a limited number of club carts at the site, the charge per person is 35\$ per person, and should be paid on the spot. Be aware that you may have to wait in line. Each buggy carries five persons; the ride can be quite bumpy.

Afterwards, re-join the coach for the 2.5-hour drive back to Aqaba.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking through the half-mile-long (800 metres) defile and within Petra; in total over 3 hours and 5 to 6 miles, much of it on uneven ground. Step back in time to experience the spectacular ancient city of Petra during this captivating, full-day sightseeing excursion with lunch.

Aqaba, Desert Highway, Small Villages, Ancient City of Petra

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 2.5-hour drive to Petra via the Desert Highway and country roads through several small villages, with a brief comfort/shopping stop en route. The ancient city of Petra spans approximately 38.6 square miles (about 100 square kilometres) and was built between 800 B.C.-100 A.D. by Nabataean Arabs. Petra was a fortress, carved out of the jagged rocks in a valley that was virtually inaccessible and forbidden to visitors. It is so securely concealed by the craggy, encircling mountains that it was once 'lost' for 1,000 years. From Petra, the Nabataeans commanded the trade from Arabia and the East. In the 1st and 2nd centuries, after the Romans invaded, the city reached the peak of its fame.

Siq, Natural Canyon, Remains of Water Channels, Carvings & Images of Nabataean Gods

Upon arrival at Petra, join your archaeologist/guide for an approximately half-mile (about 0.8-kilometre) walk through the Siq, a long, narrow gorge with steeply rising sides that all but obliterate the sun. The Siq served as a defence, and part of an incredible water system for Petra. This stunning natural canyon winds through the towering rock towards the city. Whilst walking through the Siq, see remains of water channels, carvings, and representations of Nabataean gods. The narrow passage is an adventure, for the towering walls create an artificial gloom until you exit the Siq, and suddenly merge into the blinding light and see the natural square dominated by Petra's most famous monument, the Khazneh (Treasury).

Treasury, Intricately-Carved Façade, Temples, Royal Tombs, Amphitheatre, Lunch

The Treasury is your first glimpse of the 'Rose Red City', and the most famous of Petra's 800 individual monuments. Its intricately-carved façade was featured in the movie, Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade, and represents a magnificent sight in the dazzling sun. From here, follow your guide further into the site and discover other impressive structures carved out of the rose-coloured stone. Stroll down the outer-Siq, passing the 'Street of the Facades' en route to the Greek Theatre, which was carved by the Nabataeans in the 2nd century B.C. and seated 3,000 people.

Royal Tombs, Main Street, Qasr Al Bint Temple, Local Restaurant, Lunch

Whilst approaching the main colonnaded street, pass by a series of fascinating tombs, including the Royal Tombs. Carved into the face of Jebel Khubtha, the Royal Tombs consist of the Urn Tomb, Corinthian Tomb, and three-storey Palace Tomb. Leading west is the main street of Petra, which once boasted numerous stately columns along its route. At the end of the street is the partially-restored Temple of Qasr Al Bint. The only freestanding structure in Petra, it is thought to have been the main place of worship in the city. Following your tour, proceed for a buffet-style lunch at a nearby local restaurant in upper-Petra. After lunch, re-board your coach and commence the approximately two-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately five miles-six miles (about eight kilometres-9.6 kilometres), at times over uneven, gravel, cobblestone, and slippery surfaces, inclines, and declines, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and optional buggy-ride, and ancient stairs at the sites visited. This tour is recommended for guests in good physical condition. Wadi Rum Desert, 4x4 Safari Ride and Sunset

A rock formation known as The Seven Pillars of Wisdom was immortalized in the book and film about the legendary figure.

Buffet Dinner in a Bedouin Tent

Watch the beautiful sunset before you drive to a Bedouin tent in the desert to enjoy a special buffet dinner with local Folklore Show. During dinner, you will be joined by a local Bedouin over a stargazing (no telescopes) who will also talk about the Bedouin way of living.

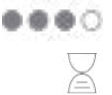

HER-H / Heraklion & Archeological Museum

Heraklion Archaeological Museum

It houses representative artefacts from all the periods of Cretan prehistory and history, covering a chronological span of over 5,500 years from the Neolithic period to Roman times. The singularly important Minoan collection contains unique examples of Minoan art, many of them true masterpieces. The Heraklion Museum is rightly considered as the best in the world for Minoan art, as it contains the most notable and complete collection of artefacts of the Minoan civilization of Crete. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the museum and learn about the rich legacy of this ancient civilisation.

Heraklion City Centre

Coming to Heraklion for the first time, the visitor nowadays may be somewhat surprised by the changes that are taking place in Crete's capital city; Heraklion is celebrating its rich history and moving onwards to a future full of potential. You will have the chance to learn about the history of Loggia, Morosini Fountain, Saint Titus Cathedral, Saint Marcus Basilica, the Venetian Fortress, Agora and the Market Street.

The tour concludes back at the pier.

Following your photo stop, walk to a nearby tavern to enjoy delicious Greek lunch and the hospitality that these warm people are known for before returning to the pier.

Minoan Palace of Phaistos

Depart the pier for approximately one-hour drive south of Heraklion for a visit to the Minoan Palace of Phaistos. Overlooking the Messara Plain, Phaistos is the second largest palace of Crete after Knossos and one of the most important archaeological sites on the island. It is a fascinating place to visit with beautiful views and lesser crowds. With its superb architectural composition and its almost perfect construction, it is considered to be the finest and most typical of all Minoan palaces.

Archaeological Site of Gortyn

Following your tour, continue with a brief transfer to the great ancient city of Gortyn. Gortyn was one of the oldest and strongest cities in Crete during the prehistoric and historic period and the first city of Crete to accept Christianity. Upon arrival, take a guided tour through the ruins of the ancient palace complex, which served as the administrative and religious centers for the whole region. The apostle Paul preached here and the city is known for its text of the law carved in stone, the oldest text found in Europe.

After you visit, re-board the coach for your return drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of slow walking and standing. Guests must be able to walk approximately 1 mile (1.5 kilometer) over various surfaces, including gravel, inclines, and some uneven paths with steps to negotiate. Palace of Knossos

Knossos was devastated again with the eruption of the volcano in Santorini around 1500-1450 B.C. Despite this blow, people continued to live here for another fifty years until a fire swept throughout the city circa 1400 B.C. Upon arrival, take a guided tour through the fantastic ruins of the ancient palace complex, which served as the administrative and religious centres for the whole region. Along the way, see the living quarters of the king, queen and members of the royal court, rooms for state occasions, the theatre area, store rooms, and potters' workshops.

Heraklion Archaeological Museum

Following your tour, re-board your coach and proceed to the Heraklion Archaeological museum to further discover the ancient civilization. It houses representative artefacts from all the periods of Cretan prehistory and history, covering a chronological span of over 5,500 years from the Neolithic period to Roman times. The singularly important Minoan collection contains unique examples of Minoan art, many of them true masterpieces. The Heraklion Museum is rightly considered as the best in the world for Minoan art, as it contains the most notable and complete collection of artefacts of the Minoan civilization of Crete. After approximately 60 minutes, the tour will conclude with a brief transfer back to the pier.

Aposelimi Dam, Ancient Ruins of Lyttos, Kastamonitsa Village, Raki & Olive Oil Tasting

Continuing our journey through paths and olive trees, we reach the ruins of the Roman aqueduct of Lyttos. Next, continue to the quaint village of Kastamonitsa where we join the locals for raki and olive oil tasting.

Off-Road Adventure, Minoan Path, Lassithi Plateau

From here the real off-road adventure begins by climbing high into the mountains and following the ancient Minoan path that leads us to a local shepherd where you have the chance to feed the goats and try some of the home-made cheese. From here we make our way to a magnificent view point where we can see the Minoan path and the first sighting of the Lassithi Plateau.

Zeus' Cave, Spectacular Views, Lunch

Head to Zeus' Cave (where mythology says that Zeus, the father of all the gods was born). When you reach the top of the cave this gives you the opportunity to take photographs as if with a helicopters view of the Lassithi Plateau. From here we cross the Plateau and stop for your delicious lunch.

Krassi Village, Old Plane Tree, Natural Spring, Vultures

Your drive continues on to the village of Krassi, which is famous for a 2,000-year-old plane tree and derives its water from a natural spring. Leaving Krassi Village, head back through the Selinari area. Here, you can see vultures, which are now an endangered species. At the conclusion of your unforgettable tour, commence the approximately 1.75-hour back to the pier.

Plaka Village, Boat Ride, Spinalonga Island, Light Greek Lunch

Depart the pier for approximately 90-minute scenic drive to the fishing village of Plaka, located in the stunning setting of the Mirabello bay, right opposite the island of Spinalonga. Stroll the village's main promenade, exploring the small town's cafés and shops. Next, board a traditional wooden boat for a short ride to the small island of Spinalonga. Spinalonga was first inhabited by the Christians. Later, the Venetians constructed an impressive fortress on the island. Aghios Nikolaos & Free Time

Your tour continues with a drive to the ancient harbour of Aghios Nikolaos. The lake, the town's jewel, is known for its many legends, according to one of which, Athena and Artemis are bathing in its waters. The lake becomes one with the sea through a narrow canal and is surrounded by red rock formations and lush vegetation. Stores sell unique traditional Cretan art artifacts, copies from the local archaeological museums, jewels, and impressive embroidery. Here, enjoy some free time before taking the return drive back to port.

They cultivate six unique indigenous and five first class international varieties using the latest organic techniques, and they believe they can inspire through a series of products with strong personality. The guiding tour at the winery and cellar will be combined with a wine tasting of five different wines and light snacks.

The tour concludes with a return drive back to the pier.

Corinth

When the magnitude of the task proved too large, a paved slipway was built to enable sailors to drag small ships across on rollers. This method was used until the 13th century, and the canal was finally completed in 1893. Following your photostop, enjoy a delicious Greek lunch before re-boarding your coach for the approximate 75-minute drive back to the pier.
