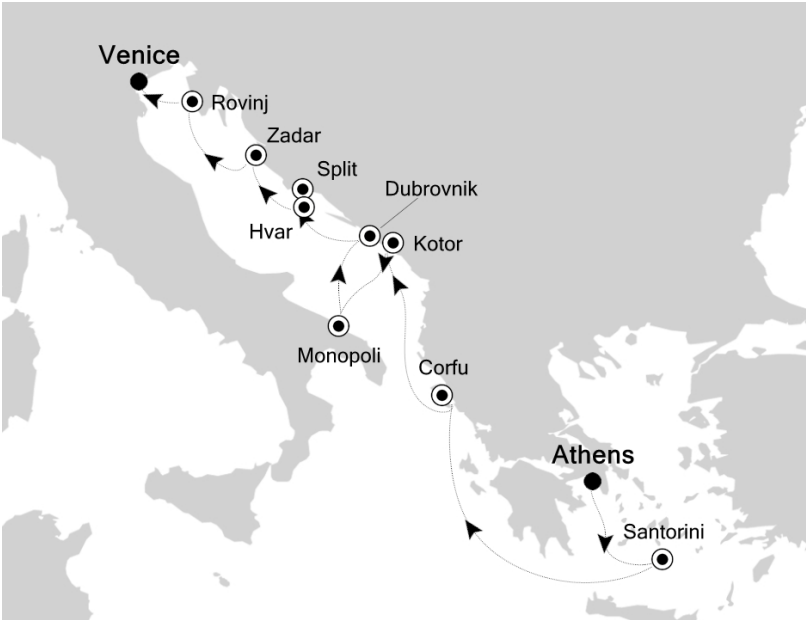

General Information

ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Booking Direct with Silversea gives you peace of mind. Our local tour operators are fully insured and have been comprehensively vetted. In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore Excursions are available on a first-come, first served basis. Guests should note that some shore excursions are very popular with guests and often ending up being waitlisted. In order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate in excursions are subject to availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge Desk within the cancellation deadline. For our selected Shore Excursions Tickets returned after the cancellation deadline will be charged 100% cancellation fee to the guest's onboard account. Cancellation deadlines for the majority of our shore excursions is 48hrs prior to the port of call. Please note that certain shore excursions might have a different cancellation deadline; all cancellation deadlines are stated in the please note section of the shore excursion, booking form and shore excursion tickets.

Should the first choice subsequently be confirmed as guests will be notified about the status of the waitlisted tour and have the option to make a final choice on MySilversea. More excursions are available for purchase at full price. Silversea strongly advises booking shore excursions to avoid disappointment. The deadline for booking Shore Excursions on MySilversea is 2 days prior departure date. Silversea reserves the right to cancel any excursions including free shore excursions. No credit or other compensation will be given if free shore excursions are unavailable, cancelled or not utilized. All shore excursions including those offered on a complimentary basis are operated by independent operators over whom Silversea has no control. All advertised fares, savings, offers, programs and itineraries are correct at time of printing, are subject to availability and may change at any time. Other restrictions may apply.

ONLINE ADVANCE RESERVATION OF SHORE EXCURSIONS

Silversea operates an online reservation option, allowing guests to reserve their shore excursions at leisure prior to their cruise. In order to access this, please log on to MySilversea (my.silversea.com) up to 48 hours prior to your sail date. If you have reserved your shore excursion online, you will receive further information upon embarkation onboard.

SHORE EXCURSION DEPARTURES TIMES

Departure times are published in the ship's daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicles and on shore excursion tickets. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore. Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and shore excursion departures as local conditions dictate.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

You may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a shore excursion booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the shore excursions in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Shore Excursion tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

Prices are generally quoted per person, per tour, with the exception of Silver Shore Privato or group-designated excursions. Prices are subject to change without notice. Discounts for children under 12 years of age are available on some, but not all tours. Prices for children, if available, will be adjusted onboard. SHORE EXCURSION DEPARTURE TIMES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, shore excursion departures generally will not be announced unless there is an unforeseen change. Departure times from the ship are published in the ships daily newspaper, the Silversea Chronicles and on shore excursion tickets. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least 10-minutes prior to the shore excursion departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pierside to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore. Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and shore excursion departures as local conditions dictate. Please note that approximate pier departure times are also listed in MySilversea (my.silversea.com).

SHORE EXCURSION SUITABILITY

Silversea offers a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. However, certain excursions are more appropriate for physically fit and active guests. All excursions offered are clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. We also offer a good variety of Accesible Shore Excursion worldwide (according to the ports availability and local structure) that are designed for guests unable to negotiate motor coach steps or for full time wheelchair/scooter users. The vehicle used on this type of shore excursion is adapted with an access ramp (or lift where available) to accommodate a limited number of mobility devices. In order to use the ramp and/or lift, guests are required to be seated on a wheelchair or scooter. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain to select excursions that meet your physical capability. We therefore encourage guests to review the excursion description carefully including the PLEASE NOTE section which includes useful information. Silversea also offers Destination Experience

Briefings onboard. If you have any questions or concerns regarding shore excursion suitability, please contact the Shore Concierge (shoreconcierge@silversea.com) prior to your cruise or visit the Shore Concierge desk for more detailed information once onboard.

ONBOARD SHORE CONCIERGE TEAM

Whether you wish to participate in an organised shore excursion or tailor-made shore excursion, Silversea's experienced Shore Concierge team are happy to assist you to plan the best shore-side experiences with knowledgeable suggestions, personalized planning for sightseeing, water sports, golf and more. The Shore Concierge team is available onboard on sea days from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Office opening hours in port may vary whilst staff is shore-side assisting those on excursions. Please refer to the Silversea Chronicles for daily office opening hours. Once onboard, those considering a bespoke excursion should contact the Shore Concierge team at their earliest possible convenience, as time may be a factor in reaching local contacts. Please be aware that once arrangements are confirmed they are non-refundable.

DESTINATION EXPERIENCE BRIEFINGS

Throughout the voyage the Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant will offer port and shore excursion information prior to arrival in each port of call. Their aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and answer as many of your questions as possible. The information is presented in the theatre or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system, and will allow more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicles. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. Children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment. Such harnesses' and secure

seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately, guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY CHARGES

Please note that photography at some museums, sites and monuments and/or the use of video cameras may not be allowed or may incur a charge. These charges are not included in the tour price and are at guests' own expense. Further details will be in the detailed shore excursion description and please note section. Please ensure to review these in detail prior to departing on your shore excursion.

SHOPPING STOPS

While our organised excursions are not generally geared to the serious shopper, some shore excursions allow for short shopping stops as indicated in the shore excursion description. In the interest of all participants, guests should adhere to the allotted time and return to the tour vehicle promptly as advised by the tour guide or ship's escort. Please Note: The selection of shops is generally left to the discretion of the tour operator. Silversea does require that establishments be reputable, of general interest to our guests and offer quality goods. However, all purchases are the responsibility of the individual.

JTR-C / Discover Oia On Your Own

Difficulty

Explore the most charming village of Santorini during a memorable sightseeing and shopping excursion on this picturesque island.

Panoramic Drive, Village of Oia

After tendering ashore at Athinios Port, depart for approximately 40-minute scenic drive to the northern tip of the island to Oia. This quaint little village was once the home of wealthy seafarers of the past, and features beautiful old cliff-side mansions and houses.

Free Time

Upon arrival, take a brief guided walking tour through the narrow cobbled streets of Oia. Following your walking tour, enjoy free time for additional independent exploration. See many tiny shops offering a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewelry. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

Following your visit to Oia, re-board the coach for your transfer back to the Athinios Port where your tender boat will await to take you back to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking, at times on cobblestone surfaces with many steps to negotiate. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilize a wheelchair. Light-weight, comfortable clothing with closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Only Euro currency is accepted. Please be advised that Oia is the most visited place on the island and is usually very crowded. Please note that at the conclusion of the tour you will have an option to remain in the town of Fira for self-exploration. Guests will have to make their own way to the tender boats from Fira using a cable car. Cable car ticket costs 6.00 Euros one way. Long lines for the cable cars may be encountered during the busy summer season.

JTR-D / Akrotiri Excavations

Difficulty



Price: \$89 - Duration: 4.00 hr(s)

In prehistoric times, the people who inhabited what today is known as Santorini, called the island Strongoli (round). These people enjoyed a high standard of living; they built two-story houses, tilled the earth and were skilled artists, recognizing the beauty of colour. Discover the excavation site of famed Akrotiri during this half-day tour.

Akrotiri Excavations

Depart the ship by a local tender to Athinios, where you join the waiting motor-coach. Enjoy your scenic drive to the southern end of the island and the archaeological site of Akrotiri. A volcanic eruption circa 1,600 BC destroyed all life on the island, and the island itself sank beneath the waves. The excavations here, led by Professor Spyros Marinos, began in 1967 and document the existence of life on Strongoli, legendary Atlantis; although no written records have ever surfaced to support this. It is an amazing city with houses, streets, squares and workshops, all of which had been covered under a thick blanket of pumice for

over 3,500 years. You are able to walk around this ancient city among well-preserved buildings, which will give you an insight into the ancient civilization of Santorini, the center of a civilization akin to the Minoans of Crete.

Akrotiri Village

After the tour of the excavations discover the nearby village and explore one of the 5 fortified settlements on the island in medieval times. At the end of tour, return through the beautiful countryside back to the port of Athinios where your tender will await to take you to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves moderate walking and is not suitable for guests in wheelchairs or with limited mobility. Guests should wear seasonal clothing, flat walking shoes and sun protection. Please note that at the conclusion of the tour you will have an option to remain in the town of Fira for self-exploration. Only Euro currency is accepted. Guests will have to make their own way to the tender boats from Fira using a cable car. Cable car ticket costs 6.00 Euros one way. Long lines for the cable cars may be encountered during the busy summer season. The tour requires a minimum amount of participants to operate.

JTR-E / Profitis Ilias, Oia & Ouzo

Experience the village life and spectacular scenery of Santorini during this half-day island tour.

Profitas Elias

Disembark the ship onto your awaiting tender boat and set sail for Athinios Port. Upon arrival, board a coach and take in panoramic views of Santorini and the caldera as you drive past typical Greek houses, an ancient Venetian fortress and several Byzantine churches en route to the Profitas Elias. A brief stop here, the highest point of the island, offers a spectacular panorama of the caldera below. Re-board your coach for the drive to Oia.

Village of Oia

Nestled in a fertile countryside, the village of Oia is among the most picturesque towns of the Cyclades Islands. This dramatic little village, built on a steep slope of the caldera, has many of its dwellings nestled in niches hewn into the volcanic rock. Once the home of wealthy seafarers of the past; still evident are their two story mansions painted in a spectrum of pastel colors. As you traverse its narrow cobbled streets you will come across many tiny shops which offer a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewelry. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

Canava Distillery & Ouzo Tasting

Departing Oia, your next stop is at Canava distillery & museum. Here, guests can enjoy a visit of the distillery, with its antique distilling equipment, and a stroll through the museum. Within the newly-restored home, guests can see its recreated workplaces and rooms reflective of the people in Santorini's recent past. Every room is replicated using original items tirelessly collected over the years. Afterward, enjoy a taste of the spirits produced in Santorini's first distillery. Guests wishing to purchase some products can do so (please note that credit cards are not accepted).

At the end of tour, return through the beautiful countryside back to the port of Athinios where your tender will await to take you to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate to extensive amount of walking and is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended. Only Euro currency is accepted. Please be advised that Oia is the most visited place on the island and is usually very crowded. Guests must be at least 18 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. Please note that at the conclusion of the tour you will have an option to remain in the town of Fira for self-exploration. Guests will have to make their own way to the tender boats from Fira using a cable car. Cable car ticket costs 6.00 Euros one way. Long lines for the cable cars may be encountered during the busy summer season. Tour sequence and duration may vary based on possible crowds.

JTR-F / Santorini Sights & Swim

Difficulty

Indulge your senses with the beauty and flavors of Santorini during this scenic and memorable sightseeing excursion.

Mt. Profitis Ilias

Disembark the ship onto your awaiting tender boat and set sail for Athinios Port. Upon arrival, board a coach and take in panoramic views of Santorini and the caldera as you ascend the colorful rocky sides of the caldera wall. Upon reaching the top, drive through the village of Pyrgos and up to Mt. Profitis Ilias. At 883 feet (269 metres), it is the highest peak in Santorini, and home of the early-18th-century monastery of the same name.

Village of Oia & Free Time

After taking in the spectacular views of the island, guests will re-board the coach for the drive to Oia, located on the northern end of the island. En route, see the different layers of lava the volcano has produced during in every phase of its activity. Upon arrival, take a brief guided walking tour through the narrow cobbled streets of Oia. Following your walking tour, enjoy free time for additional independent exploration. See many tiny shops offering a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewelry. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

Local Winery & Wine Tasting, Perivolos Beach

Next, re-board your coach and continue to a local winery for a wine tasting accompanied by barley rusks and local cheeses. Afterwards, proceed towards the volcanic, black-pebbled beach of Perivolos. Here, you will have a chance to enjoy approximately two hours at your leisure: lounge on a sunbed, stroll the long stretch of black sand, swim in the azure Aegean, or have a traditional Greek lunch on your own at one of the seaside taverns.

At the end of tour, return through the beautiful countryside back to the port of Athinios where your tender will await to take you to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate to extensive amount of walking over uneven, cobbled and narrow pathways and is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Wear light-weight, comfortable clothing with closed-toe walking shoes and bring protection from the sun. Guests wishing to swim should wear a swimsuit under a cover-up, and bring a towel from the ship. Beach umbrellas and sunbeds are not included and are available for rent on first-come, first-serve basis. Swimming is at guest's own risk. Beach amenities include refreshment/snack bars. Only Euro currency is accepted. Please be advised that Oia is the most visited place on the island and is usually very crowded. Guests must be at least 18 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. Please note that at the conclusion of the tour you will have an option to remain in the town of Fira for self-exploration. Guests will have to make their own way to the tender boats from Fira using a cable car. Cable car ticket costs 6.00 Euros one way. Long lines for the cable cars may be encountered during the busy summer season. The operation of this programme is weather dependent.

JTR-I / Best of Santorini

Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour through the narrow cobbled streets of Oia. Following your walking tour, enjoy free time for additional independent exploration. See many tiny shops offering a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewelry. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

At the end of tour, return through the beautiful countryside back to the port of Athinios where your tender will await to take you to the ship.

JTR-K / Traditional Caique Cruise & Hot Springs Swimming

This excursion is a truly Grecian adventure, with the opportunity to sail on a traditional kaiki boat and take swim in a volcanic hot spring at Palea Kameni.

Traditional Kaiki Boat, Sailing the Caldera, Panoramic Views

Travel aboard a traditional Greek sailboat called a kaiki (or caique), a charming wooden boat and traditional fishing vessel that has a long, pointed bow and is often painted in bright colors. Sail to Palea Kameni, a home of hot springs known for their healing properties. Here, you will have a chance to spend some time swimming and relaxing in this magical place.

At the conclusion of your excursion, take the relaxation with you and enjoy approximately half an hour sail back to the Old Port of Fira.

Please note: This tour involves a minimal amount of walking, with a few steps to negotiate to embark/disembark the ship's tender and kaiki. This tour is not suitable for guests prone to seasickness and guests who utilize a wheelchair. Guests with breathing problems should take this into consideration before booking the tour, as the smell of sulphur and the heat can be strong at the volcano. Guests are advised to wear swim attire, lightweight, comfortable clothing, bring sun protection and a towel from the ship. Please note that your swimsuit could change color due to the sulphur water. Operation of this tour is subject to weather conditions.

JTR-L / Santorini Kayaking Adventure

KTR-A / Highlights of Montenegro

Njeguši & Local Snack

During your visit to Njeguši, taste some of the locally-produced specialties, including smoked ham and cheese, and brandy and wine.

Cetinje, National Museum

Next, re-board the coach and proceed to Cetinje, the former capital of Montenegro. Now part of Lovcen National Park, the town was formerly the seat of the Bishop of Montenegro, who ruled the country from Cetinje. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the National Museum. The museum once served as the palace of King Nikola Petrovic I, who ruled from 1860-1918.

Lunch

Leaving the museum, proceed for lunch at a local restaurant specializing in the national dishes of Montenegro. After lunch, re-board your coach and continue your scenic drive through the mountains on route to Kotor.

Cathedral of St. Triphun

Upon arrival in Kotor, take a guided walking tour through the Medieval Old Town. Along the way, an external visit is made to the magnificent Cathedral of St. Triphun. One of the oldest and most beautiful examples of Roman architecture, the cathedral was constructed in 1166 on the remains of a 9th-century temple. The town is surrounded by 15th-century fortifications that include a Medieval rampart system with city gates, defensive walls, and towers. Inside the walls, the town is a combination of narrow streets, tiny squares, and monuments honouring the diverse Mediterranean cultures that marked its development. A guided walking tour within the ramparts brings you to the City Museum.

Budva City Museum

The City Museum of Budva is located in the heart of the Old Town. Although the history of Budva dates back hundreds of years, it has only had a museum for the past two decades. The museum traces the evolution of Budva through displays of various artefacts with Hellenic marks, vases, jewellery, decorations, tools, and silver, along with artefacts made of glass and clay featuring unusual shapes and designs. The museum offers a unique insight into the Illyrians, Greeks, Romans, Byzantines, Slavs, and other Budvan rulers through the years.

Refreshment & Free Time

Following your museum visit, refreshments and a snack will be served at a local restaurant before some free time is made available to browse the shops or explore the area. Re-board the coach for the approximately 30-minute return drive to Kotor. Upon arrival, you may opt to return directly to the pier or remain in the Old Town for shopping or further exploration and return to the pier at your leisure.

MPI-D / Alberobello & Apulian Delicacies

Alberobello, the capital of the original conical dwellings known as Trulli, is considered to be among the most famous attractions in Apulia! Its old districts with their cluster-like settlements of Trulli (about 1400) date back to the 17th century and lie along the sides of two hills separated by the village main street: should you have the opportunity of a panoramic view over the town centre, you would see its Trulli roofs look like funny conical hats curiously placed on a fairytale characters' heads! Walk with your tour guide and you will learn about Alberobello's original history. Take a stroll through the village's narrow winding streets while enjoying your free time shopping or tasting a good Italian "gelato".

From the pier only about a 30-minute drive will take you to Alberobello. During the drive enjoy the views of green olive groves, golden wheat fields, and blue skies depict the colors of the countryside.

Upon arrival, you will follow a walking tour admiring the enchanting Trulli with their whitewashed walls and grey pointed roofs, which are the unmistakable symbol of Alberobello, listed among the UNESCO sites in 1996. Enjoy the characteristic districts of Monti and Aia Piccola to learn about the ancient architecture of these unique houses with your tour guide and you will hear that the number of Trulli-houses rapidly increased during the 17th century as the Counts of Conversano obliged farmers to build temporary houses to avoid tax burdens for themselves. Strange symbols and cute pinnacles on Trulli cone roofs are the main pictures you will see while shopping or reaching the top of Rione Monti hill to visit the Church of Saint Anthony built in the shape of a Trullo in 1926, and you can actually figure out now how a family could live in such small houses. At the end of the guided walk, some free time will be given for your own exploration and/or shopping.

Alberobello is renowned also for its countryside dotted with Trulli shaped Farmhouses and very old olive trees...it is worth a visit especially if you wish to experience local specialties.

From Alberobello, a short drive will take you to a picturesque Masseria (Farmhouse) is waiting for you: the location and setting are perfect to taste specialties such as Apulian focaccia (bread) along with some typical local wine.

At the conclusion of the farm visit, reboard the coach for the scenic drive back to the port.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount (total distance about 3km) of walking with about 50 steps at the sites. In Alberobello the bus parking area is about a 15minute walk away from the village. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Proper attire is required to enter the cathedral; shorts and bare shoulders are not permitted. On Sunday mornings, church holidays, and during weddings, tour groups are not allowed inside churches during services; guests may have a chance to visit the church independently. Guests must be at least 18 years old to participate in tastings of alcoholic beverages. Shops are closed on Thursday mornings in Alberobello; regular shops are open from 0900 AM to 0100 PM and from 0430 PM to 0830 PM; souvenir shops can be open all day through. Restrooms are located at the Farmhouse, at the bus parking in Alberobello, as well as in its town centre. Due to the popularity of sights visited, some crowding may be anticipated. MPI-E / Matera And Unesco Sassi District With Lunch

Matera is located in one of the political regions in the South of Italy called Basilicata. It is renowned for its landscape since the old town centre lies along the sides of a deep ravine split into two by a very small hill known as Civita, where the Medieval town has been built. The result is that the whole city looks like a butterfly, whose "body" corresponds with the Civita and the two wings with the two winding "branches" of the ravine where the very old Sassi Districts have been built. Sassi can easily be translated as Stones into English, curiously referring to the origin of the settlements you're going to visit, partly built and partly carved out of the soft ravine limestone: houses and grottoes, or churches and grottoes at the same time, where life in the past was really hard and the economy was based upon the pasture, because agriculture was quite impossible in a stone context! Many times you will be told that Sassi had to be considered as one of Southern Italy's examples of poverty, but they have been transformed into the most important cultural heritage nowadays, so you will easily understand the reason why such a strange settlement has been listed among the UNESCO sites.

You will travel approximately 2 hours South West inland to reach the magnificent Matera, admiring the rich vegetation of Apulian countryside as well as its highest hills covered with wheat, the main ingredient to produce traditional yellowish-colored bread known as Pane di Altamura (Altamura's bread, after the name of a town close to Matera which is renowned for its DOP semolino bread).

Upon arrival in Matera your tour guide will lead you through narrow lanes and staircases, to explore the timeless picturesque UNESCO Sassi Districts: you will hear stories about "vicinati" (neighbourhoods in English), a real lifestyle with people living in humid one-room-house-caves arranged around little yards, labyrinths of winding streets, rock churches and cantinas, sharing everything they had with families living nearby. Visit one of the typically furnished cave-houses and learn about how some of the locals lived in these caves as recently as 1960s!

Your - typical in this region - set-menu lunch will be served in one of its most famous restaurants and taste local specialties along with local Aglianico wine.

After lunch about 60-minutes free time will be given for own exploration and at an appointed place and time re-board your coach for the approximately 2hours journey back to Monopoli.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount (total distance about 2km) of walking on cobblestones streets and uneven surfaces, and about 100 steps total. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilize a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and sun protection are recommended. Proper attire is required to enter the cathedral; shorts, and bare shoulders are not permitted. Experience the scenic beauty and Old-World charm of Bari, during a memorable half-day walking tour of this historic city.

Depart the pier and after an approximately 45-minute drive towards the Swabian Castle, Swabian Castle

Originally built by Frederick II upon earlier Norman fortifications, the Swabian Castle's present appearance is the result of modifications carried out by the Aragonese family in the 1500s, when the castle became the residence of Isabel of Aragon.

Bari

Upon arrival in Bari's city centre, commence your walking tour of the Old Town to explore the historic sites and gain an insight into the local lifestyle. Along the way, an external visit is made to the Cathedral of Saint Sabino. Dedicated to Saint Sabino, this Apulian-Romanesque style cathedral was built in the second half of the 12th century.

Next, your walking tour proceeds through Strada del Carmine before arriving at the Basilica of Saint Nicholas.

Basilica of Saint Nicholas

The symbol of Bari, the basilica houses the mortal remains of Saint Nicholas. According to a local legend, 62 sailors went to Myra, Turkey in 1087, stole the saint's remains and brought them to Bari. Consecrated in 1197, the church is one of the masterpieces of the Apulian-Romanesque style, and features an imposing limestone façade flanked by two large bell towers. The interior hosts two unique examples of Medieval sculpture: a ciborium with figured capitals, and the bishop's throne, known as 'Elia's Chair'. The basilica is a place of pilgrimage, particularly for believers from Eastern Europe. The impressive, ornately-decorated crypt is adorned with rich colours. Leaving the basilica, proceed for the short walk to Via Venezia, Piazza Mercantile and Piazza Ferrarese.

Following your walking tour, some free time is made available to further explore the Old Town's narrow cobbled streets and squares, impressive façades of Medieval buildings and ancient walls. You may also sip a cappuccino at a local café and watch the locals going about their daily routine.

At the conclusion of your visit, re-board the coach for the approximately 45-minute return drive to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount (total distance about 2km) of walking on cobblestones streets and uneven surfaces. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilize a wheelchair. Tour groups are not permitted inside the church during services on Sundays, church holidays and during weddings. Guests may have the chance to visit churches independently, quietly, and reverently. Small shops close during lunch break from 1.30pm to 4.30pm. The tour sequence may vary.

MPI-H / Polignano & Mr Volare's White Cliff

Panoramic clifftop terraces

After a 30-minute drive from the pier to Polignano, you will follow your licensed guide from the bus drop-off point to the terraces. These are the tops of the hundreds of cathedral-like marine caves eroded into the cliff by the sea, now paved and transformed into amazing terraces affording breathtaking views of the crystal-clear sea water, nearby coastal villages and the caves themselves.

Polignano Town Centre

Follow your tour guide through Polignano's characteristic town centre with its typical Mediterranean atmosphere and narrow winding streets. All around is a riot of colourful flowers and greenery created in both public and private spaces thanks to the mild climate and the local folk's creativity. You will wander along narrow lanes carved out of the old defensive walls and continue to catch glimpses of Polignano's astounding grottoes.

Mr Volare statue

A short stroll takes you to a small square nearby with a bronze statue of Domenico Modugno welcoming visitors with open arms.

Follow your tour guide and explore Polignano's characteristic town centre, with its winding little streets covered with flowers, a typical Mediterranean atmosphere. Here people are used to decorate their homes both inside and outside, just because climate is so mild that locals are allowed to transform a public open space into family's or neighborhood's garden.

You then have approximately 45 minutes free to explore further or try a delicious "gelato" before rejoining the coach for the drive back to the ship through ancient Apulian olive groves with some last glimpses of the crystal clear waters and with Mr Volare's white cliffs still lingering in your mind.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for 1.30-1.50 miles along partly cobbled and uneven streets, some inclines and approximately 25-30 steps, in addition to entering and leaving the coach. Upon arrival, receive your safety and riding instructions and orientation, then don your safety helmet and begin your unforgettable ATV adventure.

Countryside, Fields, Local Villages, Srđi Hill, Old Town, Dubrovnik Riviera & Adriatic Sea Views

Led by your guide, escape from the crowded streets to explore the pristine countryside and fields, traditional local villages, and other incredibly beautiful and geographically diverse areas of Dubrovnik not typically seen by visitors here. The highlight of the exciting, off-road portion of this excursion is a ride to the top of Srđi Hill. Upon arrival, a stop is made for spectacular panoramic views and photo opportunities overlooking Dubrovnik, the Old Town, Dubrovnik Riviera, and crystal-clear waters of the Adriatic Sea.

Bosanka Village, Refreshment Stop

Leaving Srđi Hill, your ATV adventure continues on to the old village of Bosanka, where a stop is made for a refreshing beverage and local snack. Leaving Bosanka Village, re-board your ATV for the picturesque, approximately one-hour return-ride to the ATV base at Celopeci Village. Upon arrival, re-board your bus and commence the short drive back to the coach parking area, then return to the pier on-foot.

Some of the other buildings to be viewed from the outside are the Sponza Palace, noted for its column courtyard with elaborate stone carvings, the Rector's Palace, Maritime Museum, Church of Saint Blaise, and Onofriou's Fountain. Following your walking tour, you may opt to return to the pier with your guide or remain in town for further exploration and shopping.

After a tour, complete the farm-to-table experience by enjoying these handmade ingredients blended into a painstakingly-produced, multi-course dining experience. This is a unique opportunity to escape from the city and enter the home of true locals that cook the traditional foods of their ancestors with a modern flair. Your gracious hosts and a renowned local Chef will introduce and present local specialties that will be prepared just for you! The food they serve is mainly home-grown and very traditional to the region. During the meal, you will indulge yourself in one of the most famous meals of Konavle area: veal and potatoes baked under the Peka, which is an iron bell covered in hot coals, a cooking method dating back to ancient times. The estate's family-grown wines will also be paired with the evening's offerings as the meal progresses.

A transfer of approximately 30 minutes will conclude the evening and return back to the ship.

Dominican Monastery and Cathedral

Along the way, a visit is made to the Dominican Monastery and Cathedral. Inside, discover the finest collection of Renaissance paintings in Dubrovnik. Among the many works by local and Italian masters is a painting by Tizian. The cathedral is built on the remains of the original, 12th-century church that was destroyed by a disastrous earthquake in 1667. Today, its treasury contains one of the finest collections of gold and silver artefacts in Europe. Following your walking tour, some free time is made available for you to explore the Old Town at your leisure before re-boarding the coach for the drive to Konavle Valley.

Konavle Village

Upon arrival, proceed for a visit to a family winery. The owners will greet at your arrival, then give a presentation about their wines, show you the production process and invite you to participate in a tasting of their vintages. Following the tasting, re-board your coach and proceed to a rural farming area tucked in the mountains of the Konavle Valley and visit to the typical country home. Over the years Cavtat has been a favourite destination for sailors and yacht enthusiasts. In fact, Edward VIII and Wallace Simpson came here during their honeymoon. Discover her charms with a short introduction followed by some free time.

Cavtat

From Dubrovnik, depart by coach for Cavtat, located 45 minutes south along the coast. Upon arrival your accompanying guide offers insight to the area followed by free time (approximately 2 hours) to explore on your own and soak up the delightful resort atmosphere. Enjoy a pleasant walk along the beautiful seafront promenade or sip coffee in one of many cafés. Surrounding sites worth a visit include the Baroque church of St. Nikola, the Bogišić's scientific collection, the Vlaho Bukovac Art Gallery, or the Racic Mausoleum, designed by the famous Croatian sculptor Ivan Meštrovic. Cavtat also has several nice beaches nearby if you prefer a day in the sun along the shores of the Adriatic.

Coastal Cruise

At the appointed time, rejoin your guide to begin the return to Dubrovnik by coastal voyage. The scenic cruise by private vessel offers a panoramic view of the southern Croatian coastline en route. Upon arrival in Dubrovnik, you may opt to return & directly to the ship or if you prefer, you may remain in the city and return on your own later in the day.

Please note: This tour involves an easy to moderate amount of walking, with uneven surfaces and uphill walks which are not recommended for guests with limited mobility or guests who utilise a wheelchair. Fort Lovrjenac

Your half-day adventure on Adriatic sea starts beneath Fort Lovrjenac, famous from its cameos in movies and television programmes due to its well-preserved medieval architecture. You will be transported back to Dubrovnik's golden age when its imposing city walls intimidated potential foes, protecting this prosperous city for centuries.

Lokrum Island

After approximately 45-minutes of paddling, arrive at Lokrum Island where free time for swimming or Island exploration will be provided. Lokrum Island is beautifully situated in front of the Old Town of Dubrovnik. Legend has it that Richard the Lion Heart was cast ashore here, after surviving a shipwreck in 1192, while returning from the Crusades. Learn that later, in the 12th century, Benedictine monks built a monastery on the island, which they had occupied for over 600 years. See the remains of a historic monastery, large parts of which were converted into a residence for the Maximilian, Emperor of Mexico, who has owned the island since the 19th century. Just before departing Lokrum Island, enjoy snacks and refreshments under the surrounding trees. Continue your kayaking toward Ploce area, Old Town Harbor and City Walls before reaching Pile beach.

City Walls

Upon your return from Lokrum Island, discover why an easy kayak paddle beneath the old city walls is a unique opportunity to get acquainted with Dubrovnik from the seaside.

Upon completion of the kayak adventure, return on foot to the tender pier.

Please note: This tour involves extensive activity and participants must be in good physical condition and able to swim in water too deep to stand. There a total walking distance of approximately 800 m/0.5 miles of walking required for this excursion. Guests should wear a swimsuit under a cover-up, water shoes, plenty of sun protection and bring a towel from the ship. The kayaks each contain a waterproof compartment for storing your belongings. Due to the nature of the tour, guests should use extra precautions to prevent water damage to cameras or video equipment. Embrace the natural beauty and traditions of Croatia during this scenic, half-day excursion to the lush Konavle Valley.

Dubrovnik, Ljuta, Konavle Valley, Stamp Mills, Old Water Mill, Stone Mill Demonstration

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive through small, picturesque villages en route to the Konavle Valley, and a visit to Ljuta. Upon arrival, proceed for a visit to the Old Water Mill, Mlinica Dvori, which is still in use today. Experience a look into traditional Croatian life during this tour, and demonstration of an historic, water-powered stone mill. The mill system was extremely important for the economy of Konavle and the Dubrovnik Republic as a whole. The river and its upper streams are now protected as public parklands, with its mills preserved as historical and cultural monuments to the traditional way of life dating back to the 15th century. Following your tour, refreshments of orange juice, homemade liqueur and dried figs are served.

Gruda Village, Antonia Ruskovic Atelier, Traditional Silk Production, Interactive Silk Demonstration

Next, re-board your coach and continue on towards Gruda Village, where Antonia Ruskovic has kept up the tradition of handcrafted silk production. Silk is one of the oldest textile fibres known to mankind, and, during the Roman Empire, it was sold for its weight in gold. Here in the Konavle Valley, near Dubrovnik, women continue this process not for profit, but for the sake of tradition. During your guided tour, learn about an explanation of the whole process, from cocoon-boiling to thread-reeling, dyeing, plying, weaving, and embroidering. Following your tour, you are invited to partake in this tradition by producing a thread of silk yourself, then served refreshments of tea, homemade liqueur, soft drinks and homemade chocolate cake.

Old Town Walking Tour

After re-boarding your coach, drive back toward Dubrovnik. A stop is made along the way for a guided walking tour of the Old Town. At the conclusion of your visit, you may opt to re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier, or remain in the Old Town for further exploration and return to the ship on your own.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking, at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 15 steps at the sites visited. The famed sea-explorer and marine biologist, *Jacque Cousteau* once called the Dubrovnik Riviera one of the cleanest and best preserved bodies of water on the planet. Board a speedboat at the harbour and begin your own exploration of these crystal waters. Leaving the harbour, cruise along Lokrum Island and the city walls, which provide a very impressive view from the sea. A stop may be made for photos as you continue your cruise along the Lapad Peninsula, passing close by the charming Grebeni Lighthouse towards Kolocep Island. As you cruise along the coast of Kolocep, a stop will be made at the Modra Spilja Cave (Blue Grotto) for snorkelling and swimming for approximately 30 minutes.

Re-boarding your speedboat and continue on to the island of Lopud to enjoy some beach time on the white sands. You may sunbathe, swim, snorkel, beach comb or take a tube ride on the beautiful bay of Sunj Beach.

After approximately 70-minutes of fun in the sun, enjoy a light lunch and drinks.

Following the lunch, re-board your speedboat for the return cruise to Dubrovnik.

Please note: Tour involves minimal walking, however guests who enter the water must be in good physical condition and able to swim in water too deep to stand. Guests must be able to jump into the sea and swim/walk to the beach where the restaurant is located. We suggest wearing a swimsuit under a cover-up, rubber-soled shoes and sun protection. On this tour, you will be taken through all the parts of the Old City where some of the most memorable scenes from the ongoing cultural phenomenon were filmed.

Old Town of Dubrovnik, Pile Gate, Lovrijenac Fort, City Walls

The sights seen will include The Pile Gate where King Joffrey faced a citizens' riot and the Lovrijenac fort, where the unsuccessful attack on King's Landing, known as the Battle of Blackwater, took place. All of the filming locations and commentary from your local guide will be accompanied by large, A4-sized photos that show the screen-shot from the appropriate episode and what took place. Of course, the people of Dubrovnik are also fiercely proud of their own fascinating history which your guide will also inform you about, alongside the Game of Thrones commentary.

Tour will conclude at the Stardun (main city street) and will have opportunity to explore the town on your own or take the tender boat back to the ship.

SPL-B / Picturesque Town of Trogir

Experience the Old World splendour of one of the most beautiful Croatian towns during this memorable visit to historic Trogir. Depart the pier for the scenic, approximate 45-minute drive northwest along the Split Riviera en route to Trogir. People have lived here in early settlements near the coast and around castles built during the 15th and 16th centuries.

Trogir

Situated on a small island, Trogir is squeezed between the mainland and the larger island of Ciovo, and is accessible via a bridge. Upon arrival, leave your coach and walk across the bridge. Trogir, a veritable open-air museum, was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997. Walk through history and view the longest and largest piazza of all the Croatian islands. A thick-walled fortress overlooks the harbour and reaches down to the water where you begin your walk into the old town and to a Franciscan Monastery.

After tendering ashore, depart the pier area and begin your scenic walking tour of Hvar.

Walking Tour

Cars are banned from Hvar Town so its streets and people converge onto an expansive piazza, the largest in all of Dalmatia. The piazza connects the older part of town to the newer southern side, which was developed from the 15th century onwards. During your guided walking tour, proceed along the promenade and up to the 16th-century Renaissance Cathedral. Your walking tour continues on to the dock, where sailboats and fishing boats bob and sway in the evening breeze. From here, walk back up to the square en route to the Cathedral of St. Stephen, which is adorned with a treasury and graceful, 17th-century bell

tower; one of three bell towers rising above the tiled rooftops. Next, a visit is made to the very heart of the port to see the large Arsenal, which features a striking arched portal and houses Europe's first community theatre, established in 1612.

Franciscan Monastery

Your final stop is at the 15th-century Franciscan Monastery. Upon arrival, visit the impressive Renaissance Cloister, the old refectory housing a collection of lace, manuscripts and books, and the church, which is home to a remarkable collection of paintings. Your tour of the monastery concludes in the garden, where a local group of singers serenade you a cappella. Refreshing drinks are served prior to the beginning of the concert.

Following your walking tour, ample time is available to explore the town at your leisure before tendering back to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking (approximately 0.5 km/0.3 miles) occasionally over cobblestone surfaces and periods of standing with over 25 stairs to negotiate. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. We recommend wearing comfortable clothing, walking shoes and sun protection. Sea Kayaking

After tendering ashore, walk with your guide to the kayak launching point. Following a safety and training session, receive your paddle and lifejacket then embark your two-person kayak. The kayaks used during your tour are lightweight and easy to navigate, making them ideally-suited for most fitness levels. Together with your guide, take to the azure waters of the Adriatic and explore Hvar's southern coastline en route to Mekicevica Bay, which features a nice beach and bar. Upon arrival, a stop is made for swimming and snorkelling equipment is provided.

At the conclusion of your visit to Mekicevica Bay, embark your kayak for the ride back to the kayak launching point in Hvar. Afterward, return to the pier on-foot and tender back to the ship.

Your tour will conclude with a sail back to the pier area in Hvar.

Beach & Swimming

Take a cruise to one of the most beautiful and attractive bays of Vis island. After swimming experience, re-board your speedboat ride to Komiza.

Komiza Guided Walk, Free Time & Lunch

Continue with a cruise to Vis Island and explore picturesque village of Komiza, a quaint, small town on the western coast. The town is situated in a deep bay of the same name. Established in 16th century, this village still depends largely on fishing and agriculture as it did hundreds of years ago. Its fishermen not only ruled with their boats over the Adriatic Sea, but they also traded with the neighbouring coast, creating fishermen's centres on the Pacific coasts of both Americas.

Upon arrival take a guided tour of the streets and squares of this charming fisherman village. Afterward, some free time is made available to explore the town at your leisure. Following your free time, enjoy lunch in the village before cruising to your next location.

Bisevo Island with Blue Cave

Bisevo Island leaves everyone breathless, with its memorable combination of natural phenomena, sandy bays and friendly islanders. The Island of Bisevo is situated 5 nautical miles from the town of Komiza (on Vis island), and is best known for its rare natural phenomenon, the Blue Cave. The interior of the cave and the sea within it are illuminated with an indescribable silver-

blue light. The rays of sun passing into the cave through a small crack in its ceiling are reflected in the sea, creating incredible light effects.

Arrive on Bisevo at Mezoporat Bay and board a small wooden boat which takes you into the cave. The cave entrance is quite small, requiring that you crouch in the center of the boat while the skipper manages the boat into the cave. After visiting Blue Cave, rejoin your speedboat for scenic ride back to Hvar.

Please note: This tour involves extensive amount of activity. This tour is recommended for active guests who are in good physical condition, and able to swim and snorkel in water over their heads. Guests must be able to embark/disembark the boat and swim for at least 0.3 miles (approximately 500 meters). Walking on the beaches is at the discretion of each guest. Hvar, Island Villages, Stari Grad Plain

After tendering ashore and a brief short walk to the parking lot, depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 30-minute drive to the Stari Grad Plain, also known as 'Hora'. En route, pass by the charming villages of Hvar Island. The Stari Grad Plain, an UNESCO World Heritage Site, is the most fertile and largest cultivated field on all of the Mediterranean islands, and little has changed here since the ancient Greeks arrived almost 2,400 years ago. The land was fertile and produced much food for the settlers, who brought vines and olive trees with them from the Greek island of Paros.

Lavender Museum & Distillery, Hora Estate and Garden Tour, Brunch

Upon arrival, proceed to the heart of Hora for a guided tour of the Hora Estate, one of few buildings in the plain. During your guided tour of this lovely property, see Lavender Museum & Distillery, feel the lavender, and enjoy a traditional brunch at the Hora estate.

Jelsa, Hidden Beaches, Adriatic Sea, Refreshments, Free Time

En route, discover special hidden beaches away from the crowds, take in stunning views of the Adriatic Sea, and marvel at the natural beauty of Hvar Island. Upon arrival at Jelsa, another stop is made for refreshments and some free time at your leisure. Afterward, begin the final leg of your guided bicycle adventure with a ride back to Stari Grad. Upon arrival, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Hvar is known as the 'Lavender Island'. Lavender has been used in a medicinal capacity for over 2,500 years, as its perfume and essential oil have various health benefits. Its therapeutic powers are utilised to help alleviate insomnia, nervous tension, anxiety issues, migraines, headaches, depression, and emotional stress, and treat hair loss and insect bites. The lavender harvest on Hvar occurs during the peak months of June and July, and the scent and sights here are exquisite.

Adriatic Sea, Island & Mainland Views, Refreshments, Dalmatian Specialities, Vineyards, Fig Trees

In addition to the magnificent colour and tantalising scent, you will enjoy stunning views of the Adriatic Sea, surrounding islands and mainland. You will also have the chance to enjoy the refreshments served with traditional Dalmatian specialities. Afterward, re-board your coach and head to Vrboska Village. En route, a brief photo stop is made to marvel at the beautiful panorama of the sea and the surrounding islands, vineyards, fig trees, lavender bushes, and other endemic flora.

Vrboska Village, Church of St. Mary of Mercy, Church of St. Lawrence

Vrboska, the smallest town on Hvar Island, was built in the Renaissance and Gothic styles. Due to its small, curvy streets and a little bridge connecting the town with a small island located in the middle of the bay, Vrboska is often referred to as 'Little Venice'. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour of the village. Along the way, visit 16th-century Church of St. Mary of Mercy, a beautiful church built as a defence fortress from the Turks, and Church of St. Lawrence, which contains pictures of Titian. Following your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier, passing through many small villages en route.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.6 miles (about one kilometre), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and approximately 20 steps at the sites visited. Historical records date this natural port and fishing centre from the 14th century. Whilst Jelsa counts itself among the newer of Hvar Island's settlements, there are signs of human habitation here dating from ancient times. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour of Jelsa, which has today become a popular little tourist town.

Dubokovic Winery & Vineyard

Afterward, head to the modern, yet traditional, Dubokovic Winery. Owner Ivo Dubokovic, an artist who rose from being one of the original 'garage' winemakers to national prominence as one of Croatia's leading small producers with prime Hvar vineyard positions. Ivo is renowned for his Plavac Mali reds, which carry an almost cult status. Ivo's most-prized wine carries the name of the Mediterranean monk seal, Medvid, that used to reside in an underwater cave beneath the location of the vineyard. He's also among the first to experiment with different winemaking styles, including orange wines.

Wine Cellar, Wine & Olive Oil Tastings, Winery Store, Shopping

Upon arrival at the Dubokovic Winery, proceed for a memorable experience at its atmospheric, 80-year-old hidden cellar, located beneath a Hvar stone family house. During your visit, enjoy a delicious tasting of six wines and four olive oils whilst Ivo imparts his knowledge of winemaking and passion for the tradition. At the conclusion of your tour and an opportunity to browse the selection of wines for sale at the Dubokovic Winery's store, re-board your bus for the approximately 30-minute drive back to the bus station. Upon arrival, commence the short walk back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a modern amount of walking for approximately 0.93 miles (about 1.5 kilometres), at times over uneven, gravel, cobblestone, and natural surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the bus and at the Dubokovic Winery. Radojkovic Olive Mill, 'Garden of Eden', Olive Trees, Plants, Flowers, Olive Oil Tastings

Mr. Radojkovic comes from a long line of olive growers, but, after having lived and worked in Zagreb for several decades, he returned to his native island of Hvar and the olive cultivation was sparked. His family's tradition continues to this day, with 450 olive trees under cultivation. Upon arrival, meet the owners and take a guided tour of the olive mill. Along the way, learn about its history of olive oil production here, then take a stroll through the exquisite 'Garden of Eden' and marvel at your beautiful surrounds. Afterward, proceed for tasting of five extra virgin olive oils paired with cheese, bread, anchovies, and ice cream.

Lush Vegetation, Adriatic Sea, Kod Kucera Farm, Brac Island, Makarska Riviera, Goats, Donkeys

Next, re-board your coach and continue driving through the lush vegetation overlooking the beautiful Adriatic Sea en route to the Kod Kucera Family Farm. Meet the Owners, Guided Farm Tour, Goats, Donkeys, Farm Tools, Tastings

Along the way, the Kuzmicic family share their proud tradition of hospitality. See and learn about their goats, donkeys, food products, and old farm tools, and share the family's love of their farm, its animals, village of Zastrazišće, and island of Hvar. Afterward, proceed for refreshments and a tasting of local specialties during a delicious lunch.

Afterward, re-board your coach for the drive to Hvar town. Upon arrival, a short walk brings you back to the pier.

ZAD-A / Historic Zadar on Foot

Discover the Medieval treasures of Zadar during this memorable guided stroll through the city's Old Town. Depart the pier on foot and commence your guided walking tour of Zadar. The city walls of Zadar attest to its long history of warding off would-be conquerors and rulers, including the Venetians and the Turks. Upon entering the heart of the Old Town, explore the highlights of this magnificent city.

Cathedral of St. Anastasia

Your first stop is a visit to the Cathedral of St. Anastasia, the finest example of Romanesque architecture in Zadar. The cathedral was built during the 12th and 13th centuries on the site of an early Christian basilica. It is dedicated to St. Anastasia, whose stone sarcophagus is located in the apse to the left of the high altar.

Church of St. Donatus

Further along, pass by the Church of St. Donatus, believed to have been built by Bishop Donatus on Roman foundations at the beginning of the 9th century. This is the most monumental church on the Eastern Adriatic, and features a round shape with three naves.

St. Mary Church

To the east of the Forum is the 16th-century St. Mary Church, which features a Romanesque bell-tower built at the beginning of the 12th century by the Hungarian-Croatian King Koloman. On the upper floor of the convent, there are public rooms containing a collection of goldsmiths' work, relics and other valuable artefacts. Following your guided walking tour, some free time is made available to explore the Old Town at your leisure before returning to the pier on foot.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking over cobbled and uneven surfaces, with 40 steps to reach the collection of goldsmiths' work inside the Church of St. Mary. Old Town of Zadar and Cathedral of St. Anastasia

Depart the pier for a scenic, approximately two-hour guided walking tour through the heart of Zadar's magnificent Old Town. Your first stop is at the Cathedral of St. Anastasia, which dates from 1324 and is the finest example of Romanesque architecture in Zadar. It is dedicated to St. Anastasia, whose stone sarcophagus is in the apse to the left of the high altar.

Churches of St. Donatus and St. Mary

Leaving the Cathedral of St. Anastasia, your stroll continues past the Church of St. Donatus, which is believed to have been built by Bishop Donatus on Roman foundations at the beginning of the 9th century. The most monumental church on the east side of the Adriatic, the Church of St. Donatus is circular in plan, with three naves. To the east of the Forum is the 16th-century Church of St. Mary, which features a Romanesque bell tower built at the beginning of the 12th century by the Hungarian-Croatian King Koloman. Visit the upper floor of the convent to explore rooms containing a collection of goldsmiths' works, relics and other valuable items.

Liqueur Tasting

Next, explore the 400-year-old legacy, uses, production, and bottling of maraschino and cherry brandies during a liqueur tasting accompanied by cake. At the conclusion of your tour, commence the short walk back to the pier.

Starigrad Paklenica

Depart the pier for the approximate 45-minute drive to Starigrad Paklenica, a picturesque town and harbour located on the southern part of Velebit Mountain. Upon arrival, proceed to Paklenica National Park.

Paklenica National Park

Declared a national park in 1949, Paklenica spans approximately 37 square miles (about 95 square kilometres), and is highlighted by a legendary peak, Anica Kuk, on its 1,312-foot (400-metre) face. Its summit offers spectacular vistas of the coast, sea, Paklenica and the peaks of Velebit Mountain. The park also features a pair of picturesque canyons, Mala (Small) and Velika (Large) Paklenica. Velika Paklenica Canyon is approximately 8.7 miles (about 14 kilometres) long and 1,640-2,625 feet (500-800 metres) wide. Its defining characteristic is the steep drop from Anica Luka, which measures approximately 2.5 miles (about four kilometres) from its base.

Canyon Hike

After receiving your tour and safety instructions, begin your guided hike through Paklenica's Karst River Canyon, located in the foreground of the magnificent Velika & Mala Paklenica canyons. The karst is an area of exceptional natural beauty and various geological formations. Cliffs, caves, holes and cracks abound, and the dissolution of soluble rock has created natural works of art known as 'skrape'.

Anica Luka

Your hike winds through the Paklenica Karst River Canyon and uphill towards Anica Luka, with a few stops en route. Upon arrival at Anica Luka, a stop is made for refreshments, snacks and splendid panoramic views of your surroundings (weather dependent). Afterward, commence the 1.5-hour return walk back to the valley, then board your awaiting bus at the park entrance. Your expedition tour concludes with a 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Nin Salt Works, Museum

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 30-minute drive to the Nin Salt Works. Here, salt is not produced by man, nor machine; it is produced by the sun, sea and wind. The salt from Nin is ecological, therapeutic and biodynamic. The surrounds include diverse wildlife, plenty of beaches and healing mud. During your visit, stop by the Salt Museum. Here, view black-and-white photos from the past, old tools for work, and wagons utilised to carry the salt from the salt pans to the salt depository. In addition, you can play an interactive video game, and view a model of the unique nature reserve and documentary film.

Royal Vineyards Tour and Tasting

Next, re-board your coach and ascend the picturesque hills, home to the Royal Vineyards. The vineyards were erected in extreme conditions, on the rocky soil. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour. Along the way, learn how the quality grapes from the stone vineyards and excellent tasting wines are the results of a special microclimate, its position by the sea and direct sun exposure. Following your guided tour, proceed for a tasting of wines produced at the Royal Vineyards.

Old Town of Zadar, Historic and Cultural Monuments and Churches

Leaving the Royal Vineyards, re-board your coach and drive to Zadar. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour of Zadar's Old Town. Along the way, discover a host of historical and cultural monuments, including the Cathedral of St. Anastasia. Built in 1324, the Cathedral is the finest example of Romanesque architecture in Zadar and largest church in all of Dalmatia. Continue past the Church of St. Donatus, thought to have been built at the beginning of the 9th century, and the 16th-century St. Mary Church with its Romanesque bell tower, built at the beginning of the 12th century. Following your tour, some free time is made available to explore the Old Town at your leisure.

Novigrad Town and Sea, Churches, Fortica Fortress, Novigrad Homeland Museum, Free Time

During your visit inside the farmhouse, enjoy a tasting of delicious, homemade Dalmatian specialities prepared and served by the Odzakovic family, and learn about the traditional way of life in the heart of Ravni Kotari. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Enjoy your day island hopping and sailing across the crystal clear waters of the Adriatic Sea. Departing from Zadar, take a scenic approximately one hour sail through Zadar channel, Mali Zdrelec passage toward Sabusa beach.

Sailing, Sabusa Beach, Swimming & Free Time

The first stop is made at Sabusa beach where you can spend your time swimming, sunbathing or snorkeling. Afterward, sail to Kukljica, a small village on the island of Ugljan. Kukljica is situated near the Strait of Zdrelec and is considered the door to Telascica Nature Park and Kornati National Park. The old portion of the village, with its original examples of folk architecture, is divided from the tourist peninsula of "Zelena punta" by a large cove with a small port that is always teeming with fishing boats and wooden sail boats. Enjoy some free time in Kukljica village before boarding your sailboat for your next stop.

Sailing, Lunch, Osjak Island & Swimming

Lunch is served on board the sailing boat as the excursion heads to the island of Osjak. This island has a surface of just half a square kilometer and is the smallest permanently inhabited island on the Adriatic. It has a protected landscape where olives, pinewoods and cypresses give shade to the rocky beaches. The old fishing port with a church from the 5th century is one of the most colorful places in the whole Adriatic. Relax and swim for approximately 30-minutes before your next jaunt to Preko village.

Ugljan Island, Preko Village & Free Time

Set for a short sail to Ugljan Island and visit Preko Village. This village's old center consists of typical Dalmatian architecture and numerous patrician family summer houses. The best way to feel the Mediterranean atmosphere is by walking along the quay or sipping a favorite drink on one of the terraces with a view of the Zadar Channel. Here you will have time for swimming or strolling through the village.

Rejoin your sailing boat and continue back to Zadar.

Please note: This tour involves extensive activity due to the required activity level for sailing, including possible inclined, slick surfaces while sailing as well as 400 meters of walking. This tour is not suitable for guests with back and/or neck problems, limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Zadar, Tuk-Tuk-Ride, Coast of Duke Trpimir, Zadar Marina, Photo Stop, City Centre & Surrounds

Depart the pier for a guided tour of Zadar via tuk-tuk, a motorised, three-wheeled taxi. Begin with a ride along the Coast of Duke Trpimir and Zadar Marina towards a scenic viewpoint, where a brief stop is made to marvel at the spectacular panoramic view and learn about Zadar. After a photo stop here, your ride continues towards the city centre, through neighbourhoods, and over the city bridge en route to the Peninsula.

Peninsula, Sea Organ, Greeting to the Sun Monument

Upon reaching the Peninsula, a stop is made at the Sea Organ, a unique architectural, sound, and art object. This experimental musical instrument plays music by way of sea waves and tubes located beneath a set of large marble steps. In addition to the Sea Organ, see the nearby monument, *Greeting to the Sun*. It consists of 300 multi-layered glass plates placed on the same level as the stone-paved waterfront, and in a circle approximately 72 feet (about 22 metres) in diameter, with photovoltaic solar modules underneath. Lighting elements installed in a circle are turned on at night to produce a dazzling light show.

Roman Forum, Fosa Port, Land Gate, City Centre, Guided Stroll, Maraschino Liquor & Cake Tasting

Next, a stop is made to see the Roman Forum and learn about its origins. Afterward, head to the port of Fosa and Land Gate. Built in 1543, this decorated stone gate once served as the entrance to the city of Zadar. After a brief stop here, return to the city centre for a guided stroll through the Old Town of Zadar. Along the way, a stop is made for a maraschino liquor and cake tasting. At the conclusion of your tour, commence the short walk back to the pier.

Pass by the Cathedral of St. Anastasia. The finest example of Romanesque architecture in Zadar, the Cathedral was dedicated to St. Anastasia. Further along, see the Church of St. Donatus, believed to have been built by Bishop Donatus on Roman foundations at the beginning of the 9th century. This is the most monumental church on the Eastern Adriatic, and features a round shape with three naves. After passing by the Church of St. Donatus, a visit is made to the Museum of Ancient Glass, a unique cultural institution.

Museum of Ancient Glass, Ancient Glass Collections & Exhibits, Glass-Blowing Workshop

The museum is located inside the refurbished historical palace of the Cosmacendi family, which dates to the second-half of the 19th century. The palace's original architecture was enriched by an annex on the northern side due to the demands related to the museum concept of the permanent display, as well as performing everyday museum activities. It now serves as an archaeological museum specialising in ancient glass. Its displays present a unique collection of over 5,000 various glass objects dating to antiquity. In the glass-blowing demo workshop, replicas of ancient glass are made by using the free-blowing technique.

Free Time, Shopping, Boat-Ride, Zadar Archipelago, Ošljak Island, Swimming, Exploring, Lunch

After some free time in the Old Town for independent shopping and exploration, embark a speedboat for the short, yet scenic transfer to nearby Ošljak Island, one of many islands of the Zadar Archipelago. Upon arrival, some free time is made to for swimming and/or to explore Ošljak. The smallest populated island in the Adriatic, Ošljak is a serene oasis for nature enthusiasts just a short boat-ride away from Zadar. Despite its small size, this island is steeped in rich history waiting to be explored. Following your free time, proceed for a delicious lunch accompanied by local wines at the Lazaret restaurant. After lunch, embark your boat for the short return transfer to Zadar. Upon arrival, commence the short walk back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of activity and an extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.1 miles (about 1.7 kilometres), at times over uneven, cobblestone, slippery, and sandy surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to embark/disembark the speedboat, and in the Old Town and Ošljak Islands. Zadar, Scenic Drive, Adriatic Coast, Vrana Lake

ROV-A / Seaside Town of Porec & Wine Tasting

Rovinj, Porec, Old Town

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive to Porec, a cultural and historical jewel by international standards. Today's town plan dates from the Roman times, about 50 B.C. Following the common Roman town model, Porec has two main intersecting streets, Cardo and Decumanus, which remain the backbone of the Old Town to this day.

Euphrasian Basilica, Marafor, House of Two Saints, Istrian Parliament, Leoni and Zuccato Palaces

Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour through the Old Town. Along the way, see the Episcopal complex of the Euphrasian Basilica. Built in the 6th century, it is the most valuable monument in Porec, as well as an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Additional highlights include the Marafor, the oldest part of town with the remains of two Roman temples, House of Two Saints, Istrian Parliament Building, and the Leoni and Zuccato Palaces. Kruncici Village, Matosevic Winery, Wine Tasting with Local Specialities

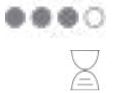

Rovinj, Pula

According to myth, Jason and Medea founded the town, 'Polai' (Source of Life). Later, the Romans changed it into a divine town for the 'pleasure of the rich'. Today, this town is known as Pula, Croatia.

Amphitheatre

Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour of this ancient town. Pula is best-known for its many surviving ancient Roman buildings, the most famous of which is its 1st-century Amphitheatre. Known locally as the 'Arena', it is the sixth-largest amphitheatre in the world. One of the best-preserved amphitheatres from antiquity, the 'Arena' is still in use today for summer film festivals.

Sergius Arch, Temple to the God Apollo, Roman City Gates & Walls, Byzantine Chapel

During your walking tour you will see well-preserved ancient Roman structures, including the Sergius Arch and temple of Augustus, built in honour of the 1st-century Roman emperor Caesar Augustus. Other sites to be seen include the Roman city gates and walls, and a Byzantine chapel. Following your walking tour, some free time is made available for independent exploration. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

FUS-I / Venetian Panorama (Tour & Airport Transfer)

Venice, Scenic Boat Cruise

After disembarking the ship, proceed to the Debarkation Lounge, collect your luggage and proceed through Customs. After exiting Customs, meet your local licensed Escort outside the sliding doors of the terminal exit, complete the luggage-storing procedure, then begin the walk to the Pier Pontoon and embark the tour boat.

Giudecca Canal, St. George's Island, Venice Lagoon and Canal, San Servolo, San Lazzaro, Lido

Your scenic sightseeing cruise glides along the broad Giudecca Canal to St. George's Island, then proceeds across the southern Venice Lagoon. Along the way, pass by the beautiful islands of San Servolo and San Lazzaro, famous for its ancient Armenian Monastery. Continue along a portion of the Lido, a long strip of land dividing the Venice Lagoon from the Adriatic Sea. From here, enter the canal separating two islands that are very important to the people of Venice; Le Vignole, a favourite place for leisurely Sunday picnics, and Sant'Erasmo, where fruits and vegetables are grown for local consumption.

Murano Island, Arsenale, St. Mark's Square, Church of San Pietro di Castello

Next, see the island of Murano, renowned for its glass manufacturing. Cruising back towards Venice, see the Arsenale, a vast, walled dockyard in eastern Venice, which was once the most efficient industrial complex in Europe during the Serenissima Republic. Your panoramic tour also passes by the ancient Church of San Pietro di Castello, the city's cathedral until the beginning of the 19th century and the exquisite St. Mark's Basin. Upon returning to port, disembark the boat and recollect your luggage from storage, then board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute transfer to Venice's Marco Polo Airport for your flight home.

At the conclusion of your lunch, re-board your motor coach and drive to Venice Marco Polo Airport for your flight back home.
