Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore Excursions are available on a first-come, first served basis. Guests should note that some shore excursions are very popular with guests and often ending up being waitlisted. In order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate in excursions are subject to availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge Desk within the cancellation deadline. For our selected Shore Excursions Tickets returned after the cancellation deadline will be charged 100% cancellation fee to the guest's onboard account. Cancellation deadlines for the majority of our shore excursions is 48hrs prior to the port of call. Please note that certain shore excursions might have a different cancellation deadline; all cancellation deadlines are stated in the please note section of the shore excursion, booking form and shore excursion tickets.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

You may also reserve and purchase your shore excursions. You will find a shore excursion booking form in your suite and at the Shore Concierge desk. Select the shore excursions in which you wish to participate, then leave the completed and signed form at the Shore Concierge desk prior to the booking deadline indicated. Shore Excursion tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

SHORE EXCURSION DEPARTURE TIMES

As a courtesy to fellow guests, shore excursion departures generally will not be announced unless there is an unforeseen change. Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least 10-minutes prior to the shore excursion departure time. The Shore Concierge team will be pierside to direct you to the appropriate transportation. When the ship is at anchor, guests must allow additional time to tender ashore. Silversea Cruises reserves the right to adjust itineraries and shore excursion departures as local conditions dictate. Please note that approximate pier departure times are also listed in MySilversea (my.silversea.com).

SHORE EXCURSION SUITABILITY

Silversea offers a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. However, certain excursions are more appropriate for physically fit and active guests. All excursions offered are clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. We also offer a good variety of Accessible Shore Excursion worldwide (according to the ports availability and local structure) that are designed for guests unable to negotiate motor coach steps or for full time wheelchair/scooter users. The vehicle used on this type of shore excursion is adapted with an access ramp (or lift where available) to accommodate a limited number of mobility devices. In order to use the ramp and/or lift, guests are required to be seated on a wheelchair or scooter. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain to select excursions that meet your physical capability. We therefore encourage guests to review the excursion description carefully including the PLEASE NOTE section which includes useful information. Silversea also offers Destination Experience

Briefings onboard. If you have any questions or concerns regarding shore excursion suitability, please contact the Shore Concierge (shoreconcierge@silversea.com) prior to your cruise or visit the Shore Concierge desk for more detailed information once onboard.

DESTINATION EXPERIENCE BRIEFINGS

Throughout the voyage the Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant will offer port and shore excursion information prior to arrival in each port of call. Their aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and answer as many of your questions as possible. The information is presented in the theatre or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system, and will allow more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicles. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. Children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment. Such harnesses' and secure

seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately, guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY CHARGES

Please note that photography at some museums, sites and monuments and/or the use of video cameras may not be allowed or may incur a charge. These charges are not included in the tour price and are at guests' own expense. Further details will be in the detailed shore excursion description and please note section. MKZ-A / Melaka's Historic Highlights

Difficulty



Price: \$109 - Duration: 4.00 hr(s)

Experience the highlights of Melaka during this half-day river cruise and sightseeing excursion.

Melaka River Cruise

After tendering from the ship to the local jetty, embark a boat for a scenic cruise on the Melaka River. Along the way, pass through the downtown area, where you can see old warehouses, shop houses, bridges and traditional Malay villages.

The Stadthuys and Christ Church

Next, a short walk from the jetty brings you to the Stadthuys and Christ Church for a brief photo stop. The Stadthuys is the most imposing relic of Dutch rule in Melaka. It features salmon red walls, heavy wooden doors and wrought-iron hinges. Once the official residence of the Dutch governors and their officers, it now houses the Historical Museum. The adjacent Christ Church is a Dutch Reformed church constructed in 1753.

Porta de Santiago, Sultanate Palace

Next, proceed on-foot to the Porta de Santiago, or 'A Famosa'. Although the original fortress dates from 1511, a small gatehouse is the only remaining part of the fortress still standing. After a photo stop at the Sultanate Palace, a replica of a 15th century palace in Melaka that currently serves a cultural museum, take a trishaw ride to Chen Hoon Teng Temple.

Cheng Hoon Teng Temple

Make a brief stop at the Cheng Hoon Teng Temple, built in 1646. It is the oldest functioning Chinese temple in Malaysia. Note the ornately decorated mythological figures, carvings and lacquer work inside the temple. Your tour concludes with a brief coach transfer back to the tender pier.

Please note: This tour involves a total moderate amount of walking for approximately 710 yards (about 650 metres), at times over flat and sloping surfaces, with few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach, and a few steps to negotiate to embark/disembark the riverboat and tender. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. One person per trishaw. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Shoes must be removed at the Sultanate Palace prior to entering; you may wish to bring socks.

MKZ-C / Discover Melaka's Culture & Heritage

Difficulty

Explore the culture and heritage of Melaka during this picturesque, half-day sightseeing excursion.

Straits Mosque, The Stadthuys & Christ Church

After tendering from the ship to the local jetty, board a coach for the approximately 30-minute drive to Melaka for an overview. Upon arrival, your first stop (external) is Melaka Straits Mosque that built on stilts over the water and facing the famous Malacca Strait, it looks like a floating structure if the water level is high. This mosque showcase the excellence and glorious modern Islamic architecture. Next stop is at the Stadthuys, the most imposing relic of Dutch rule in Melaka. It features salmon red walls, heavy wooden doors and wrought-iron hinges. Once the official residence of the Dutch governors and their officers, it now houses the Historical Museum. From here, a brief stop is made at the adjacent Christ Church, a Dutch Reformed church constructed in 1753.

Ethnographical Museum & Porta de Santiago

Next, continue on to the Ethnographical Museum. Built in 1982, this museum of history and ethnography is a great place to learn the history of Malacca. During your tour, see artifacts and historical drawings dating from Portuguese, Dutch, British and Japanese occupation to the period of Malaysian independence. Leaving the museum climb St Paul Hill to visit St Paul Church where, St Francis Xavier was temporarily buried before his body was transferred to Goa, India. As you descend, a photo stop is made at the Porta de Santiago, or 'A Famosa'. Although the original fortress dates from 1511, a small gatehouse is the only remaining part of the fortress still standing.

Baba-Nyonya Heritage Museum & Jonker Street

Re-board your coach and proceed to the Baba-Nyonya Heritage Museum. Named after Chinese descendants who adopted the Malay culture and customs, the museum reflects the artefacts, furniture and trappings of a wealthy Peranakan family in the early-20th century. Items of interest to be seen during your guided visit include expensive brandy, silver cutlery and bone china dinner services.

Your final stop is at Jonker Street, a testament to the rich Baba-Nyonya heritage of Malacca. The buildings are immaculately constructed, and adorned with elaborate carvings on their pillars and walls. The street is also famous for its antique shops. Upon arrival, 30 minutes is made available for independent exploration before re-boarding your coach and commencing for the short drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate to extensive amount of walking for approximately 0.62 mile (about 1 kilometer), at times over flat, hilly and sloping surfaces of approximately 280 wide steps from Ethnographical Museum to Porta de Santiago thru St Paul Hill, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the sites visited. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilize a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. No videotaping or cameras are permitted inside the Baba-Nyonya Heritage Museum. The tour sequence may vary.

HKT-A / Phuket Island Overview

Difficulty



Price: \$69 - Duration: 4.00 hr(s)

Explore the splendid natural beauty, landmarks and history of Phuket during a half-day sightseeing tour of this colorful island.

Chalong Temple

Depart the pier for approximately 30 -minute drive. Visit Chalong Temple, Phuket's largest and most sacred Buddhist temple.

Inside, see its renowned shrine, which has long been revered for its moulded bronze images of three respected monks.

Next, your drive continues to the west coast, Pass by the Karon Beach and Patong Beach. A brief stop is made for a photo opportunity and refreshments at a local restaurant with sea view.

Afterwards, a refreshment is made in a local restaurant with sea view.

Phuket Town Orientation

Learn about the island and its colorful history from your guide as you pass by villages, century-old Sino-European mansions and the Tin Dredger monument.

Your tour concludes with a 20-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a minimal amount of walking (in total approx 200 meters which is 218 yards), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 5 steps entering in the Temple. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility and those who utilize a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing and sun protection are recommended. Proper attire is required to enter the Chalong Temple; shorts and bare shoulders are not permitted. Shoes must be removed before entering the Chalong Temple; you may wish to bring socks. Tour itinerary may be altered to avoid congestion.

HKT-B / Phuket Highlights

Difficulty



Price: \$69 - Duration: 4.25 hr(s)

Discover the picturesque and historic landmarks of Phuket during this half-day sightseeing tour of the island.

Promthep Cape

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 50-minute drive to Promthep Cape, the Southernmost point of Phuket that has picturesque views of the Andaman Sea, admire the viewpoint, a lighthouse and the statue of 4-faces god surrounded with wooden and ceramic elephants.

Chalong Temple

Visit Chalong Temple, Phuket's largest and most sacred Buddhist temple. Inside, see its renowned shrine, which has long been revered for its moulded bronze images of three respected monks. Your tour continues with a sightseeing drive through Phuket Town.

Phuket's Old Town

Visit Kio Tian Keng Shrine, located at Saphan Hin Park close to the seashore near Phuket town, has artistic images of various deities. After the visit stroll along the colorful buildings on Talang Road, a local refreshment will be offered to you.

Following your visit, commence the drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately 875 yards, (about 800 metres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach, and 78 steps at the Big Buddha Image. This tour is not suitable for guests with

limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Modest attire is required to enter the temple; shorts and bare shoulders are not permitted, and shoes must be removed before entering. Bring a pair of socks for comfort. Local currency or credit card required for any purchases. Tour itinerary may be altered to avoid congestion.

HKT-E / Cook Thai Style at Blue Elephant

Difficulty



Price: \$199 - Duration: 5.50 hr(s)



The philosophy behind Thai cuisine is that it is the medicine for health and longevity. Thai dishes are designed to balance all of the body elements and feed them on all levels with satisfying tastes and aromas that are visually appealing, with colorful textures. Herbs and spices are the main ingredients in Thai cuisine. This class is recommended as a great introduction to the art and science to enhance an easy understanding to Thai Cuisine.

Blue Elephant Restaurant

Depart from ship via van for an approximately half hour scenic journey to the Blue Elephant Restaurant in Phuket Town. A welcome drink is served to refresh you before going to the fresh market. After a visit to the fresh market, you will be back to the Blue Elephant for a Thai Cooking Class which will consist of 4 different dishes, they are a starter, a soup, a main dish and an accompany dish. Phuket, Boat Cruise, Phang Nga Bay, Sea Cave Canoeing at Ko Panak Tunnels

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately one-hour drive to a local jetty and your awaiting motorboat. Upon arrival in Phang Nga Bay, receive your safety and tour instructions, then embark an inflatable sea canoe for your approximately 30-minute exploration of the sea caves tunnels and lagoons at Ko Panak, which is famous for its many limestone caves. PEN-A / Penang Round Island

Penang, Reclining Buddha Temple and Statue

Depart the pier for the short drive to the amazing Wat Chayamangkalaram (Reclining Buddha Temple), the oldest Malaysian Siamese temple in the state. The temple features one of the world's longest Reclining Buddha statues, as well as several coloured statues of Yaksha and other mythical creatures. Measuring approximately 36 feet (about 33 metres) from end-to-end, the statue also serves as a columbarium. Several smaller statues of the Buddha in various poses, as well as the Devas, can be seen throughout the temple, particularly adorning the main prayer hall.

Batik Factory, Entopia by Penang Butterfly Farm

Your tour continues on to the northern tip of the island for a guided tour of an authentic Batik factory. Observe the traditional technique of printing cloth with wax and dye. Malaysian batik is batik textile art, especially on the east coast of Malaysia. Whilst the most popular motifs are leaves and flowers, Malaysian batik is also famous for its geometrical designs, such as spirals. From here, head to the nearby Entopia by Penang Butterfly Farm. One of the largest butterfly gardens in Malaysia, it houses approximately 15,000 free-flying butterflies comprising up to 60 different species. The garden here features more than 200 species of plants, with waterfalls, ponds, caves, and other features.

Exotic Fruit and Spice Stall, Kampung Village, Malay Houses on Stilts

Next, a visit is made to a stall selling exotic fruits and spices. Upon arrival, see and learn about the different varieties of locally-grown fruits and spices. Your final stop is at Kampung, a charming village and fine example of traditional Malay life, where houses are built on stilts. After a photo stop here, re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

Khoo Kongsi Ancestral House

Depart the pier for the short drive to the Khoo Clan Ancestral House. En route, travel along Jalan Mesjid Kapitan Keling, the 'Road of Harmony', and pass by such places of worship as the Anglican St. George's Church, Chinese Goddess of Mercy

Temple, Hindu Sri Mariamman Temple and Kapitan Keling Mosque. At the end of the road is the impressive Khoo Clan Ancestral House. A building of great historical and cultural value. During your visit, marvel at the porcelain rooftop tiles and intricate carvings that adorn the walls and pillars.

Pinang Peranakan Mansion (Baba Nyonya Museum)

Next, re-board your coach and drive to the Pinang Peranakan Mansion, home of the 'Baba Nyonya Museum'. This late-19th-century mansion is a typical representation of the Straits' eclectic style of architecture, and reflects the rich cultural heritage of the Babas and Nyonyas.

Tropical Spice Garden and Batik Factory

Continue on to the seaside district of Telok Bahang for a visit to the Tropical Spice Garden. The garden showcases a living collection of over 500 species of local and introduced flora, with particular emphasis on tropical herbs and spices. Surrounded by the lush greenery, learn about various spices and their functional and medicinal uses. From here, a short drive brings you to a local Batik Factory, where you can observe the traditional art of creating beautiful fabric designs using wax and dyes.

Lunch and Wat Chayamangkalaram

Following your visit, proceed to beautiful Batu Ferringhi Beach for a buffet at the *Parkroyal* Resort. After lunch, your last stop is at Wat Chayamangkalaram. This temple is home to the enormous Reclining Buddha, which rests serenely above a floating veil of incense and is one of the largest of its kind in the world. Note the sculptures resembling mythical creatures guarding the entrance. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Penang, George Town, Beautifully Restored Buildings, Chew Jetty

Depart the pier for a scenic and fun-filled trishaw and walking tour of George Town. This historic, UNESCO World Heritage Site and trading port is home to a wonderfully unique blend of racial, cultural, and religious influences introduced by Arab, Chinese, Indian, and British colonial settlers. George Town is also renowned for its many lovely, 19th-century churches, temples, mosques, homes, and beautifully restored buildings from the British colonial era. Your first stop is at the Chew Jetty, one of the 19th-century Chinese clan jetties built by immigrant workers. A wooden settlement perched on stilts over the water allows you to walk over the narrow wooden platform and immerse yourself in the trading history of the island.

Local Churches, Temples and Mosques, Khoo Clan Ancestral House

Next, re-board your trishaw and drive along Jalan Masjid Kapitan Keling, popularly referred to as the 'road of harmony', to view various places of worship. Included are the Anglican St. George's Church, Chinese Goddess of Mercy Temple, Hindu Sri Mahamariamman Temple, and the Kapitan Keling Mosque. At the end of the road, visit the impressive Khoo Clan Ancestral House, a building of great historical and cultural Importance. Porcelain tiles cover the rooftops, whilst intricate carvings decorate the walls and pillars.

Fort Cornwallis, Eastern & Oriental Hotel, Morning Tea

Leaving the Khoo Clan Ancestral House, re-board your trishaw and continue on to Fort Cornwallis, the site where Capt. Francis Light first landed facing the Esplanade. Your final stop is at the Eastern & Oriental Hotel for morning tea. Built in 1885, this

elegant hotel once played host to famous guests like Noel Coward, William Somerset Maugham, and Rudyard Kipling. Following your visit, commence the short walk back to the pier.

Penang Hill

Penang Hill is among the oldest Colonial hill stations established by the British during their time in Malaysia in the late-18th century. Upon arrival at the foot of Penang Hill, board the funicular train for the ride to the top of the hill. Here, take in spectacular panoramic vistas over Georgetown City from the Viewing Deck which allows 360-degree stunning views.

Ayer Itam and Kek Lok Si Temple

After riding the funicular train back down the hill, proceed to the village of Ayer Itam for a guided walking tour of the Kek Lok Si Temple. Terraced against the hillside, the temple features a tortoise pond, Hall of Wisdom, the seven-tiered Pagoda and image of the Goddess of Mercy, Kuan Yin. Listen as the guide explains the Taoist and Buddhist worshipping rituals practised by the Chinese community. Following your visit, re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking, a total of approximately 500 yards (457 metres), with 5 steps to board the train up Penang Hill. Batu Ferringhi Beach and Teluk Bahang

Tropical Spice Garden

This idyllic, eight-acre (3.23-hectare) paradise showcases a living collection of over 500 species of local and introduced flora, with an emphasis on tropical herbs and spices. Surrounded by the lush greenery, embark on a guided walking through the garden. Along the way, learn about the various spices, and their functional and medicinal uses.

Cooking Demonstration and Tasting

Next, proceed for a cooking demonstration on the preparation of a popular Malaysian dish. Using a traditional grinding stone, techniques in grinding the dried spices are displayed, and secrets on how to draw out the flavour and aroma of the spices shared. Following the cooking lesson, you are invited to sample piping hot dishes straight from the pan. Afterward, some free time is made available to browse for souvenirs in the Gift Shop before re-boarding your coach and commencing the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Discover the natural beauty of Malaysia from the top of Penang Hill as you travel on the Penang Hill Railway before trekking through the jungle and relishing 360-degree panoramas from the Treetop Walk viewing platform. Hop in a funicular train car for a scenic less than 10-minute journey to the top of Flagstaff Hill, 830 meters above sea level. Constructed in 1923, this popular resort rail line leads you past flower farms and colonial bungalows. Alongside your guide, head out on foot along a one-mile nature trail through The Habitat, where you'll trudge across dipterocarp forest amidst oak-laurels and tree ferns. The area's rich biodiversity encompasses more than 100 species of birds, endangered endemic plants including the Penang slipper orchid, and a multitude of fauna the likes of flying lemurs, Dusky Leaf monkeys and the Giant Black Squirrel. As you make your way along the Treetop Walk, you'll stand atop the highest viewing platform in Penang to take in panoramic views of the city and Andaman Sea below. This space was once used as military parade grounds by the East India Company and was explored by famed botanist Charles Curtis, first superintendent of Penang Botanic Gardens.

Please Note: This tour requires a moderate to extensive amount of walking/hiking 1 mile (1.5 Kilometre). It is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and those who utilise a wheelchair. With an epic and legendary history, Penang Island is one of Malaysia's most unique destinations. A world heritage site, a port and confluence of some of the oldest families in the country, Penang is a natural choice for visitors to have a sneak peek into being Malaysian. Explore the treats of yesteryear with the humble "Penang Street Food" found only in the Penang backstage. The hawkers and street stalls offer endless food options that deliciously blend international spices, flavors, and textures. Aside from this, it is also famous for its surrounding brilliant architecture, cultural heritage sites, historical parks, stunning beaches, as well as art galleries and museums.

Penang Street Food Experience

Indulge your taste buds and eat like a local on this 4-hour street food tour in Penang. Explore the back lanes of Penang off the beaten track, where you'll make a few stops to taste delightful foods, snacks, drinks, and desserts. Along the way, listen to your

foodie guide describe the street-food phenomenon in Penang. Infused with a variety of spices, Malaysian food showcases Malay, Chinese, and Indian flavors.

Malay, Chinese, and Indian Flavors

Try Penang "Loh Bak", ranging from pork rolls marinated in five spice powder, crispy prawn fritters that are overwhelmingly studded with prawns, soft blocks of bean curd, fish balls, and even batter-coated sweet potatoes and yam. The condiments of chili sauce and the trickier to master sticky braised or 'lor' gravy with ribbons of egg whites are concocted well, enhancing the flavors of the fried snacks.

When it's time for a little snack, sink your teeth into a sweet Indian pancake called an "Apom", deliciously crispy on the outside and fluffy on the inside. After the little snack, you will continue your walk to a small alley where you will find the Cendol, a perfect refreshment on a hot day which is (shaved ice mixed with coconut milk, gula Melaka, and kidney beans).

You will transfer to Little India for a snack, the famous Samosa, which are made out of dough cut into small pieces and stuffed with a savory spicy filling. Fillings might vary slightly but most vendors have the vegetarian version filled with essentially spicy curry paste, potatoes and onions.

While busy enjoying the delicious samosa inside the vehicle, you will get to taste "Tau Sar Piah" (brown-sugar biscuits). A rich filling of a blended mixture of green beans, sugar, a trace of salt with a hint of fried onions encased in a light fluffy skin pastry. The best part is you get to view how the confectionery is made and witness the Tau Sar Piah which is made without the use of any preservatives.

Saving the best for the last before heading back to Port, you will have a lunch which is a Malaysian like Nasi Lemak. Nasi Lemak is a fragrant rice dish cooked in coconut milk and pandan leaf, served with sambal fish, prawn and egg, wrapped with banana leaf.

Taste a plate of Char Koay Teow, basically flat rice noodles stir-fried with shrimp, bloody cockles, Chinese lap cheong (sausage), eggs, bean sprouts, and chives in a mix of soy sauce. Wash it all down with a local favorite, choosing from non-alcoholic options including lime juice with sour plum or nutmeg juice.

Discover the picturesque beauty and beautifully-restored heritage buildings of George Town on-foot during this scenic and informative, half-day sightseeing excursion.

Penang, George Town, Fort Cornwallis, City Hall, Town Hall

Depart the pier for a scenic walking tour of George Town. This historic UNESCO World Heritage Site and trading port is renowned for its many lovely, 19th-century churches, temples, mosques, homes, and beautifully restored buildings from the British colonial era. A photo stop is made at the late-18th-century Fort Cornwallis, the largest remaining fort of its kind in the nation. From here, walk across the field to visit City Hall, a National Monument, and the beautiful old Town Hall, a grand colonial building featured in the famous movie, 'Anna and the King'.

St. George's Church, Goddess of Mercy Temple, Sri Mahamariamman Temple

Your guided stroll continues on to St. George's Church. Named after England's patron saint, it is the oldest Anglican church in southeast Asia. Leaving St. George's Church, head to the Goddess of Mercy Temple. Built in 1801, this lovely, intricately-crafted house of worship is among the oldest Chinese temples in Penang. Leaving the temple, proceed on-foot to the nearby,

magnificent Sri Mahamariamman Temple. Built in 1833, this temple is highlighted by an impressive gopuram (tower), and its ornate interior houses a priceless statue of Lord Subramaniam, embellished with gold, silver, diamonds and emeralds.

Little India Street, Kapitan Keling Mosque, Khoo Kongsi Clan House

Next, walk to the nearby Little India Street, where exotic market stalls offer a wide array of Indian street foods, goods, sculptures, handicrafts, clothing, jewellery, and more. A walk across the street brings you to the regal, early-19th-century Kapitan Keling Mosque, one of Penang's most beautiful and historic mosques.

Your final stop is at the majestic Khoo Kongsi Clan House, one of the finest examples of a traditional Clan House found outside of Mainland China. At the conclusion of your walking tour, commence the short walk back to the pier on-foot

Penang, Cheong Fat Tze Mansion

Depart the pier for a scenic sightseeing drive through Penang. Your first stop is at the nearby Cheong Fatt Tze Mansion, a government gazette heritage building. The mansion's external decorations and indigo-blue outer walls make it a very distinctive building, and it is sometimes referred to as the 'Blue Mansion'. This late-18th-century mansion has 38 rooms, five granite-paved courtyards, seven staircases, and 220 vernacular timber louver windows. Features include Gothic-louvered windows, Chinese cut-and-paste porcelain work, Stoke-on-Trent floor tiles made of encaustic clay in geometric pieces shaped to fit to a perfect square, Glasgow cast iron works by MacFarlane's & Co., and Art Nouveau-stained glass windows.

Protestant Cemetery, Suffolk House

Next, re-board your coach and continue on to the Protestant Cemetery. Established in 1786 and restored after more than a century of neglect, this disused Christian Cemetery is now listed as a Class 1 Heritage Site. Following your visit, transfer to the nearby Suffolk House. The former residence of explorer Francis Light until his death in 1794, this simple, Anglo-Indian Garden House-style home was built within his pepper estate, also named 'Suffolk'. Leaving Suffolk House, re-board your coach and proceed for a light refreshment stop at the Eastern & Oriental Hotel.

Eastern & Oriental Hotel, Colonial Museum, Antiques, Artefacts, Marble and Stained-Glass Artwork

Founded in 1885, it is among the finest hotels in Southeast Asia, and has played host to some of the world's most celebrated artists, writers, and heads of state. Your final stop is at the Colonial Museum. During your visit, relive Penang's colonial past and the lifestyle of its wealthy merchants through various antiques and artefacts, a personal, handwritten document by Captain Francis Light, founder of Penang, and intricate marble and stained-glass art pieces sourced from large, renowned mansions around Penang. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

KEL-A / Kuala Lumpur City Orientation

Explore the diverse architecture, cultures and landmarks of Kuala Lumpur during this scenic city tour.

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 90-minute drive to the New King Palace, the official residence of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong. The palace opened in 2011 and replaced the old king palace which was located at a different compound in central Kuala Lumpur.

National Mosque and Old Railway Station

Next, you will proceed to National Mosque, built in 1965, shortly after Malaysia's declaration of independence, its 73 meter minaret and "blue umbrella" roof are distinctive and impressive. One of the largest mosque in Asia, it is situated among 13 acres of gardens, reflecting pools and fountains.

After strolling through the mosque grounds, walk over to the Old railway Station, a Moorish style structure that contains a small museum dedicated to the history of Malaysian railways.

Independence Square

Continue, you will have an opportunity to have a photo stop at Independence Square. The former site of the Royal Selangor Club, Independence Square Overlooks the main historical buildings of the city.

KL Tower

After Lunch, your tour concludes with a visit to KL Tower. Upon arrival, proceed to the Observation Deck for breath-taking panoramic views of the city.

Following your visit, re-board the coach and commence the approximately one hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking for approximately 765 yards (about 700 metres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and ten steps at the sites visited. King Palace

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 90-minute drive to King Palace for a photo stop, official residence of the Yang-di-Petuan Agong, the Monarch of Malaysia.

Independence Square & Jamek Mosque

Then proceed to the Independence Square. The former site of the Royal Selangor Club, Independence Square overlooks the main historical buildings of the city. After a photo stop here, walk over to the Jamek Mosque. Built in 1909, it is the oldest mosque in Kuala Lumpur, and features graceful arches and domes that are reminiscent of Moorish architecture.

Central Market, Sze Yeh Temple & Chinatown

Your walk continues on to the Central Market. Once a bustling wet market, this heritage building houses many shops offering antique clocks, jewellery, gems, woodcarvings, batik, pewter, and more. From here, walk to Chinatown for a visit to the Sze Yeh Temple, believed to be the oldest Chinese temple in Chinatown. 'Chi-Chong-Kai', as the local Chinese call Chinatown, is a fun place to shop and eat.

Petronas Twin Towers & Shopping

After lunch, a photo stop is made at the entrance to the magnificent, world-renowned Petronas Twin Towers, the world's tallest twin buildings. This 88-story structure soars to a dizzying height of 1,483 feet (452 metres) above the city skyline. Your tour concludes with approximately one hour of free time at the Suria KLCC, a modern, six-level shopping mall. You can sit and relax, or browse for mementoes in the wide array of retail shops.

At the designated time, re-join your coach and commence the approximately 90-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a total extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.2 miles (about 2 kilometres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and a total of 15/20 steps to go to the second floor of the Central Market. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Shoes must be removed at the Sri Maha Mariaman Temple prior to entering; you may wish to bring socks. The drive from Port Klang to Kuala Lumpur is approximately 1,5 hour in each direction. KEL-D / Batu Caves & Kuala Lumpur Sightseeing

Explore the natural and manmade treasures of rural Kuala Lumpur during this memorable, full-day sightseeing excursion.

Batu Caves

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 1.5-hour drive to the limestone outcrops of the Batu Caves. Incorporated with interior limestone formations said to be around 400 million years old, the temple is considered an important religious landmark by Hindus. Cathedral Cave, the largest and most popular cavern in Batu Caves and houses several Hindu shrines beneath its 100-metre-high arched ceiling. The truly amazing feat is the 272 steps that could only be described as a feast for the eyes after the somber stairs were transformed into an Instagram-worthy background with a myriad of colors and the trek requires a stunning amount of endurance. Monkeys frolic around the caves.

Light Rail Train, Petronas Twin Towers

After the visit, you will have the opportunity to take the Light Rail Train from Batu Caves for approximately 45 minutes journey to the magnificent Petronas Twin Tower for photo stop. Petronas Twin Towers were once the tallest buildings in the world. Now the world's tallest twin structures, the 88-storey buildings were designed with both towers joined at the 41st and 42nd floors (175m above street level) by a 58 meter-long, double-decker Sky Bridge. You will continue to proceed to a restaurant for your lunch.

Independence Square, Central Market

After the lunch, you will head to the Independence Square also known as Dataran Merdeka, it is set in front of the Sultan Abdul Samad Building. Directly in front is the Royal Selangor Club and to the north is St. Mary's Church, one of Malaysia's oldest Anglican churches. This is the historical place where the Union Flag was lowered and the Malayan flag was raised for the very first time at the struck of midnight of 31st August 1957.

You will continue to walk to the Central Market. Built in 1928, it used to be a simple wet market but in the early 1980s was revamped into a handicraft's outlet. Central Market has been classified as a Heritage Site by the National Heritage Department. Similar to London's Covent Garden or San Francisco's Fisherman's Wharf,

Following your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 90-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.2 miles (about two kilometres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach, 272 steps up and again down at the Batu Cave and approximately 28 steps at the other sites visited. This tour is not suitable for guests who are claustrophobic, guests with limited mobility and those who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing, flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Shorts, short pants or short skirts are not permitted in the Batu Caves. The drive from Port Klang to Batu Caves is approximately one hour and 30 minutes in each direction. Local traffic conditions can cause traffic jams and therefore delays in the driving time.

Following the one-hour drive from Port Klang, the coach delivers you to the Pavilion Shopping Complex. With over 450 retail shops spread across seven levels offering some of the world's most renowned brand names, you will be spoilt for choice. Within walking distance are Starhill, Lot 10, Bukit Bintang Plaza and Berjaya Times Square. From here, follow your own programme - your itinerary, on your schedule.

At the appointed time, meet the waiting coach where you originally arrived at the Pavilion Shopping Complex for the transfer back to Port Klang.

Please note: This coach transfer tour is intended for guests wishing to pursue their own interests in Kuala Lumpur. It provides round-trip coach transportation, accompanied by an English-speaking hostess. Lunch is on your own. The drive from Port Klang to Kuala Lumpur is approximately one hour in each direction. National Museum

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 75-minute drive to the National Museum. The country's premier museum, the National Museum is a repository for the nation's rich heritage and history. Built in 1963, the façade features a Minangkabau-styled roof with two impressive front murals. The museum showcases four main galleries; 'Early History', 'Malay Kingdoms', 'Colonial Era' and 'Malaysia Today'.

Independence Square & Heritage Building

Next, re-board your coach and proceed to Independence Square. A photo stop is made at the historical site where the Union Flag was lowered, and the Malaysian flag was raised for the very first time, at midnight on 31 August 1957. The flagpole is the highest in the world, towering 328 feet (100 meters) above the ground. Surrounding Independence Square is the Sultan Abdul Samad Building, which houses the Federated Malay States administration and High Court.

Suria KLCC

Leaving Independence Square, take a stroll to the Suria KLCC, one of the Kuala Lumpur's top shopping mall. The mall was conceived as part of the Petronas Twin Tower project, having been constructed alongside the towers. The back of the mall is designed to offer views of KLCC Park and Lake Symphony and open pool between the parkland and the mall.

Petronas Twin Towers

Head to the Petronas Twin Towers, twin skyscrapers in Kuala Lumpur. At a height of approximately 1,483 feet (about 452 metres), they were the tallest buildings in the world from 1998 to 2004, and remain the tallest twin towers in the world today. The buildings are a landmark of Kuala Lumpur, along with nearby Kuala Lumpur Tower. Take in amazing panoramic views over the city during a visit to the 42nd-storey SkyBridge connecting the two towers, and 88th-floor Observatory of the eastern tower. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 90-minute drive back to the pier.

KEL-J / Historical Heritage of Kuala Lumpur

Discover some of the most revered and historic local sites in Kuala Lumpur during this picturesque, full-day sightseeing excursion with lunch.

Port Klang, Kuala Lumpur, National Museum

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 1.5-hour drive to Kuala Lumpur. En route, pass by industrials and commercial developments, small townships and impressive expressway developments. Upon arrival in Kuala Lumpur, your first stop is at the National Museum, an excellent introduction to Malaysian history, economy, geography, culture, arts and craft. The building has a sweeping, traditional, Minangkabau-style roof, and its main entrance is flanked by two large Italian glass mosaic murals portraying the country's major historical events and cultural activities.

Kampung Bharu, Master Mat's House

Next, re-board your coach and continue on to Kampung Bharu (New Village), located off Jalan Razak. Founded in 1899, Kampung Bharu is the oldest residential area in Kuala Lumpur. Through much of Kuala Lumpur has been modernised, Kampung Bharu still maintains a strong sense of history, as seen through the many traditional Malay wooden houses. Upon arrival, visit Master Mat's House, the handsome, traditional Malay home of a former school headmaster. Built in 1921, the blue-painted, Palladian-style house is raised on stone pillars with a concrete balustrade staircase. As Kampung Bharu is redeveloped, this kind of home is an increasingly rare sight.

Rumah Limas, Masjid Kampung Baru Mosque, Souvenir Stalls

Leaving Master Mat's House, head to Rumah Limas ('Limas' is the Malay word for the pyramid-shape of a thatched roof). Built in 1913, the house is one of the biggest existing traditional Malay houses in this area. Although it has undergone several renovations, the house still retains a touch of its original Colonial-Malay design. Following your tour of Rumah Limas, stop by Masjid Kampung Baru. Founded in the late-1880s, it is the principal mosque in Kampung Baru. The mosque has recently been expanded, and sports a handsome gateway decorated with eye-catching tiles in traditional Islamic patterns. Stalls around the mosque sell religious paraphernalia, including white 'kopiah' and black 'songkok', the traditional head coverings for Malay Muslim men.

Gurdwara Tatt Khalsa Temple

Following your mosque visit, re-board your coach and drive to Gurdwara Tatt Khalsa. The largest Sikh temple in south-east Asia, Gurdwara Tatt Khalsa is located in Jalan Raja Alang, at the border of the Chow Kit Road Market and Kampung Baru. In 1922, the British Government allocated this approximately 1.5-acre (about 0.6-hectare) site to the Sikh community, and construction for the temple was funded entirely by the gurdwara.

At the conclusion of your visit, proceed for lunch. After lunch, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 1.5-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately two miles (about 3.25 kilometres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the entrance to Master Mat's House. This tour is not suitable for guests prone to motion sickness, guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Guests must be at least eleven years old to participate on this tour. Guests must be at least 21 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. Coaches, guides, hotels, restaurants, equipment, and services are the best-available in the area, but may not be up to the standards of those found on other excursions. The driving time between the pier and Kuala Lumpur is approximately 1.5 hours in each direction. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is extremely limited; we suggest you book in well in advance to avoid disappointment.

KEL-K / Malaysian Culinary Highlights

The passion for food has made Malaysia one of the best destinations for a culinary adventure. There are new tastes to savor, and delightful surprises to be discovered in almost every part of the country. You will enjoy your 1st course meal; half-boiled eggs and 'kaya' butter toast with a cup of 'Kopi-O-Kau' [local black coffee] at 'Chong Kok' Kopitiam or similar in Klang, where is a well-known local breakfast meeting place. This decade-old melting pot is one place where you can see Malay, Chinese and Indian customers having their packed 'nasi lemak'.

You will drive past Little India, one of Klang's oldest district. Enjoy 'Putu Bambu' [traditional cylindrical-shaped and green-colored steamed cake] at the Central Market. The cake is made of rice flour called suji and colored green with extract acquired from Pandan leaf, filled with palm sugar, and steamed in bamboo tubes, hence its name, and served with grated coconut.

Central Market

Next visit the Central Market, dating back to the year 1888, the location that it now stands upon was then used for an open wet market. Slated for demolition in 1970's, Central Market Kuala Lumpur was saved by local conservationists who fought to preserve its elegant art décor facade, architectural uniqueness and historical value. Today, the Central Market is a great place to celebrate and enjoy Malaysia festivals, cultural showcases and local artistic talent. It is also an excellent destination for a great variety of local souvenirs, arts, crafts and collectibles.

China Town

Walk to China Town to shop as well as tasting 'Air Mata Kuching' or Fresh Soya Bean Milk. 'Air Mata Kuching' made from winter melon, monk fruit, dried longan and sugar; it is an ideal drink to beat the warm sunny day. There is a hot and cold offering to choose from, same goes with the Fresh Soya Bean Milk.

Brickfield/Little India

Next proceed to Brickfield, which is Malaysia's official Little India and used to be a simple residential neighborhood just outside Kuala Lumpur, but was recently transformed into a wide street with Indian stores and restaurants run by the country's Indian community. From here, board a monorail and travel to Berjaya Time Square shopping mall, where you will get to try banana leaf rice. A staple South Indian fare, the banana leaf rice features a mound of steaming plain rice with a generous amount of spicy curry and accompanied by an assortment of delicious side dishes, all served on a banana leaf. 'Papadum', or crispy lentil crackers, yoghurt and pickles complete the meal. Banana leaf rice is generally a vegetarian fare, but meat-based curries, deep fried chicken and fish are readily available. It is believed that the steam from the rice releases the banana leaf's coating, which helps to ease digestion.

Kampung Bahru

Last but not least is the Traditional Malay Dessert easily to get at the Kampung Bahru, the oldest residential area in Kuala Lumpur, founded in 1899. Though much of KL has been modernised, Kampung Baru still maintains a strong sense of history, as seen through the many traditional Malay wooden houses.

Photo stop Petronas Towers

Before returning to the port, you will have a photo stop of the magnificent Petronas Twin Towers. They were the tallest building in the world from 1998 to 2001 when they were surpassed by Taipei 101.

Please note: This tour requires a total extensive amount of walking and standing for approximately 1.2 miles (about 2 kilometres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and a total of 15/20 steps to go to the second floor of the Central Market. KEL-M / Multi Cultural Food Exploration

With an epic and legendary history, we will be exploring Royal Klang Town Heritage Walk within a half day. Coffee was a major plant in Malaya in the early days and Klang was also a major planting area. On this journey we will travel to Chuan Hoe Coffee Factory, which has 60 years of history and is still roasting coffee beans on a wood-fire.

Royal Gallery

At Klang Town, you will begin the walk to the Royal Gallery Sultan Abdul Aziz in the stately Sultan Sulaiman Building for a photo stop. Built in 1909, the Neo-classical building was the British colonial administrative headquarters in Klang. The regal building was designed by AB Hubback who was also responsible for many grand buildings in British Malaya, including the iconic railway station in Kuala Lumpur.

The Chartered Bank

A short walk from the Royal Gallery is another Neo-classical building which is the former home of the Klang branch of The Chartered Bank, Klang's oldest financial institution. Built in 1874, where bankers in pinstripe suits used to hurry through its halls, the grand dame now houses one of Klang's largest saree shops where ladies patiently pick their way through rolls of exquisite silks.

Church of Our Lady of Lourdes

Next stop is the Church of Our Lady of Lourdes, a Catholic church built in 1923 to serve the Chinese and Indian Catholic community in Klang. This church along Jalan Tengku Kelana is fashioned after Notre-Dame de Paris, widely considered the finest example of French Gothic architecture.

Little India

Next, walk right into Klang's bustling and colourful Little India centred on Jalan Tengku Kelana which grew out of old Klang's Chinese tin miners' settlement. There are many silk shops and goldsmiths along this stretch. Check out the restaurants, sweet shops and even vegetable markets. Indian Muslim Mosque Tengku Kelana founded in 1904 started as a simple wooden structure to serve Klang's Indian Muslim community. It was then known as Masjid India. A stone's throw from Masjid India is the Sri Nagara Thendayuthapani Temple built in 1925 by Nattukottai Chettiar merchants from South India. The Hindu temple is dedicated to Goddess Parvathi. Lord Ganesha and Lord Muruga are also worshipped here. At Little India, you will stop for local snack delicacies to spice up your taste bud.

Then it's time for lunch at the Royal Selangor Yacht Club, the largest and most active yacht in Malaysia. The half day ends with a transfer back to port.

USM-A / Landscape & Temples of Ko Samui

Discover the coastal beauty, lush countryside, and local highlights on this half-day introduction to Ko Samui.

After tendering ashore, begin your exploration of Ko Samui with a coastal drive, passing beaches and lush coconut plantations along the way.

Wat Phra Yai (Big Buddha Temple)

Located off the northern shore of Ko Samui, on a small rocky island connected by a causeway, stands the 'Temple of the Big Buddha', or Wat Phra Yai. The temple is a popular site; its 36-foot (11-metre)-high statue provides an impressive silhouette against the sea and sky. Surrounding the Buddha image are kutis or meditation huts. Although the monks welcome visitors, a sign requests that proper attire be worn on the temple premises.

Plai Leam Temple

This very ornate temple follows in the tradition of temple art, dating back centuries and provides a good example of the influence and style that are still significant in modern Thai religious architecture. The elaborate entry doors were made from two enormous slabs of Laotian hardwood and are intricately carved with images of the life of the Buddha. The highlight is the big statue of the Goddess of Mercy which is housed elegantly outside the shrine in the temple compound.

Guan Yu Shrine

The Chinese have a long history on Ko Samui, with the first immigrants arriving from Hainan in the late Ayutthaya era. In 1872, a small shrine was built, dedicated to Guan Yu, a legendary warrior who died almost 2,000 years ago. His statue was built in 2008. The interior is decorated with golden murals featuring Chinese calligraphy, fabulous dragons, photos of the pioneers and other assorted images.

A photo stop is made at local restaurant overlooking turquoise water of Chaweng Bay, a drink included choice of soft drink or local beer.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking. There are 72 steps to climb to fully view the temple, 25 steps at Guan Yu Shrine which are optional. Guests must be able to embark/disembark the coach via the bus steps. This tour is not suitable for those who utilise a wheelchair. As the weather is expected to be hot and humid, we recommend wearing lightweight clothing. Modest dress is requested of those wishing to visit temples where shoes must be removed to enter. The order of sites may vary.

USM-B / Scenic Drive by Jeep

Board a 4X4 jeep that will take you to visit the Kunaram Temple, the Grand Parent Ricks, to visit coconut plantation and enjoy the scenic drive along the Southern Coast of Ko Samui.

Part of an archipelago of 80 small islands, Koh Samui is an island of forested hills, majestic coconut palms and alluring pristine beaches.

Kunaram Temple

After tendering ashore, enjoy the approximate thirty minute ride by 4x4 jeep from pier. Arrive at the Kunaram Temple, visit a small monastery with the sense of simplicity and tranquility where body of Samui's most famous mummified monk, Luang Poh Deang, is displayed in a sitting posture for more than 20 years ago.

Grand Parent Rocks

Continue to Grand Parent Rocks, strangely shaped rocks south of Lamai Beach are locally dubbed Hin Ta- Hin Yai. According to legend, an old couple was shipwrecked in the bay and their bodies washed ashore creating the rocks. The views from the rocks and vicinity are spectacular, stretching across the sea to nearby islands.

Coconut Plantation

Enjoy the scenic surroundings while driving past plantations, local life and some beaches before a stop is made at a coconut plantation and local farmer house, see how the coconuts are still processes in small family business. Afterwards board the jeep for the wonderful journey back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking, 15 steps to climb at the temple, you will also walk stone surfaces, slopes and unpaved areas. Portions of the drive are over a rough surface and the ride might be bumpy, therefore this tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility, back/neck/hip problems, those who are pregnant or suffer from motion sickness or guests who utilise a wheelchair. Grand Palace

During this 90-minute visit, listen and look in awe as the guide points out the major highlights.

Although King Vajiralongkorn lives today in the Dusit Palace in the northern part of the city, the Grand Palace is still used for certain ceremonial occasions. The grounds encompass over 100 buildings, representing 200 years of history and architectural experimentation. Most of the architecture, royal or sacred, can be classified as old Bangkok style - all of it simply overwhelming. The wat (temple) structures are colourful, comprising gilded stupas, polished orange and green tiled roofs, mosaic-encrusted pillars and rich marble pediments. Fabulous murals line the walls of the palace complex and glittering temple spires provide endless photo opportunities.

Temple of the Emerald Buddha

Also known as Wat Phra Kaew, this temple adjoins the Grand Palace on common ground. It was consecrated in 1782 and houses the most important image, the 23-inch (58-cm) high Emerald Buddha. The jade statue, enshrined in a glass case standing above the worshippers, is clothed with a different robe for each of the three seasons - hot, rainy and cool. The mystical figure and its legendary spiritual power draw pilgrims from all over.

Returning, head to Riva Surya Bangkok Hotel for Thai buffet lunch served in Thai family style (a modern boutique hotel on the bank of Chao Phraya River). Board a private boat at the restaurant's pier for a cruise on the Chao Phraya River and through some of the canals. Watch the fascinating activities along the busy waterway. Stop along the way at the following locations (Take caution getting in and out of the boat).

Wat Arun

At the 'Temple of Dawn', Wat Arun, you will disembark the boat to visit this magnificent temple, which is among Bangkok's most recognised landmarks. While the temple is best seen from the river, its curious decorations and statues of mythical figures are well worth a visit.

Royal Barge Museum

Leaving Wat Arun, resume your cruise through the klongs (canals) and head toward the Dockyard, home to the ceremonial royal barges. Once a year, the king would proceed down the river to Wat Arun in a flotilla of royal barges. Today, these elaborately decorated boats are preserved in this specially constructed museum and are a rare treat to visit.

Following your cruise, re-join the coach and start the journey back to Laem Chabang.

Bang Pa-In Summer Palace

Built in the 17th century and left unoccupied when Bangkok became the capital, the palace gained importance again in 1851 when King Mongkut restored it and resumed residence there. Enjoy a visit and marvel at the richly decorated turn-of-the-century European aristocratic style, interspersed with whimsical Thai touches.

Ayutthaya Historical Park

Continue drive to the ruined city of Ayutthaya was once the ancient capital of Siam for four centuries and in its heyday was said to be more beautiful than either London or Paris. Located on a 2.5-mile (four kilometre) island at the confluence of three rivers, Ayutthaya was once encircled by a seven-mile (11-kilometre) wall. After the destruction of the city by the Burmese in 1767, a new dynasty was established and the capital was moved to Thonburi. Today, much of the ancient fabled city is contained within a Historical Park, where archaeological studies are still carried out.

While many of the buildings are in ruins, those drawn to relics of the past still find a visit to the remaining temple compounds and numerous structures awe-inspiring and a memorable experience. Begin the historical park tour with a noteworthy visit at the spectacular Wat Chai Wattanram, reminiscent of Angkor Wat in Cambodia.

Take a break from sightseeing and enjoy lunch at the *Krungsri River Hotel* (or similar).

Afterwards, visit Wat Maha That, the major original construction was the high pagoda which was destroyed by Burmese invaders. Then visit Wat Phra Si Sanphet, the most important temple within the Royal Grand Palace compound, the equivalent of the Emerald Buddha Temple in Bangkok's Royal Grand Palace.

Following your visit, re-join your coach for the trip back to Laem Chabang and the ship.
