In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore Excursions are available on a first-come, first served basis. Guests should note that some shore excursions are very popular with guests and often ending up being waitlisted. In order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate in excursions are subject to availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge Desk within the cancellation deadline. For our selected Shore Excursions Tickets returned after the cancellation deadline will be charged 100% cancellation fee to the guest's onboard account. Cancellation deadlines for the majority of our shore excursions is 48hrs prior to the port of call. Please note that certain shore excursions might have a different cancellation deadline; all cancellation deadlines are stated in the please note section of the shore excursion, booking form and shore excursion tickets.

ON BOARD RESERVATIONS

Shore Excursion tickets will be delivered to your suite and your selected excursions charged to your shipboard account. Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. SHORE EXCURSION SUITABILITY

Silversea offers a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. However, certain excursions are more appropriate for physically fit and active guests. All excursions offered are clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. We also offer a good variety of Accesible Shore Excursion worldwide (according to the ports availability and local structure) that are designed for guests unable to negotiate motor coach steps or for full time wheelchair/scooter users. The vehicle used on this type of shore excursion is adapted with an access ramp (or lift where available) to accommodate a limited number of mobility devices. In order to use the ramp and/or lift, guests are required to be seated on a wheelchair or scooter. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain to select excursions that meet your physical capability. We therefore encourage guests to review the excursion description carefully including the PLEASE NOTE section which includes useful information. Silversea also offers Destination Experience

The Shore Concierge team is available onboard on sea days from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Office opening hours in port may vary whilst staff is shore-side assisting those on excursions. Once onboard, those considering a bespoke excursion should contact the Shore Concierge team at their earliest possible convenience, as time may be a factor in reaching local contacts. Please be aware that once arrangements are confirmed they are non-refundable.

DESTINATION EXPERIENCE BRIEFINGS

Throughout the voyage the Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant will offer port and shore excursion information prior to arrival in each port of call. Their aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and answer as many of your questions as possible. The information is presented in the theatre or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system, and will allow more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicles. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. Children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment. Such harnesses' and secure

seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately, guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY CHARGES

Please note that photography at some museums, sites and monuments and/or the use of video cameras may not be allowed or may incur a charge. These charges are not included in the tour price and are at guests' own expense. Further details will be in the detailed shore excursion description and please note section. Please ensure to review these in detail prior to departing on your shore excursion.

SHOPPING STOPS

JMK-A / The Sacred Island of Delos

Difficulty



Price: \$99 - Duration: 4.00 hr(s)

Experience the ancient beauty and ruins of Delos during a scenic and informative half-day discovery of this sacred island.

Ferry Transfer to the Island of Delos

Depart the ship for the brief transfer to the local ferry dock, then board a ferry for the 45-minute ride to the tiny, uninhabited island of Delos. Upon arrival, your tour continues on foot.

Guided Walking Tour

Although Delos Island only has an area of approximately 1.5 square-miles (about four square-kilometres), it was once a very important religious, cultural and commercial centre. Today, the island is covered with ruins from fallen columns, sections of the famous mosaics that adorned the houses of the wealthy, a stadium and seats from a theatre. A row of five marble lions also stands amidst these ruins. Other interesting monuments found at the site and spread over a wide area include the Agora, the treasuries of the various cities, the Sanctuary of Apollo, the Theatre, the Sanctuary of the Foreign Gods, and the sacred Mt. Cynthus.

Ferry Transfer Back to Mykonos

After your visit, re-board the boat for the approximate 45-minute return ride to Mykonos. Upon arrival, you may opt to return directly to the pier via shuttle bus, or remain in town to explore picturesque Chora and return to the ship at your own convenience.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately two hours, mostly on uneven ground. Exploration of the archaeological site is entirely on-foot. It is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. The trip to-and-from Delos is via local boat on seas that may be choppy at times. Please note that the local boat is not exclusive to Silversea. Operation of this tour is subject to favourable weather and sea conditions. Air-conditioned coaches are the best available, but not deluxe, and can be described as 'well-travelled', island-style motor coaches. Wear light-weight, comfortable clothing with closed-toe walking shoes, and bring protection from the sun (hat, sunglasses, sun block). There is limited shade at the archaeological site. Restrooms are available at the cafeteria located approximately 975 feet (about 275 metres) from the tender area at Delos; however, the cafeteria is privately owned and might not always be open.

JMK-B / Mykonos Panorama

Scenic Drive & Aghios Ioannis

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximate 30-minute drive south to the beach of Aghios Ioannis. En route, take in splendid views of Delos Island in the distance and pass by Ornos Beach, one of the most beautiful and cosmopolitan beaches in Mykonos. After a photo stop at Aghios Ioannis, resume your drive past the beaches of Kalafatis and Aghia Anna, and on to the center of the island for a visit to the traditional village of Ano Mera.

Ano Mera Village, Monastery Visit, Refreshment & Free Time

Next, take a guided tour of the nearby Panagia Tourliani Monastery, founded in the 16th century, built by monks in 1542, restructured in 1767, and dedicated to the Virgin Mary. The monastery has a whitewashed exterior and a colored dome and features wonderful, unique island architecture, an ornately-carved marble fountain in the courtyard, an impressive marble tower, and a carved wooden screen in the church that was imported from Florence. From here, proceed to the peaceful little village-square for some Greek appetizers and 'ouzo' and free time.

Kalafatis Beach

Next, drive through scenic villages to Kalafatis beach situated on the southeast side of the island. Mykonos is world famous for its beaches with golden white sand lapped by the blue Aegean sea. Kalafatis Beach is a prime example and a stop is made here to enjoy the view before your coach continues back to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves a minimal to moderate amount of walking and is recommended for guests with limited mobility and those who utilize a wheelchair, however guests must be able to negotiate few steps to get on and off the coach. The total amount of walking involved on this tour is approximately 75 minutes on paved and on uneven ground and guests need to negotiate 3 stairs at the entrance of the Monastery. Walking at Aghios Ioannis, Ano Mera Village and Kalafatis Beach is at the discretion of the guest. Guests are advised to wear light-weight, comfortable clothing with closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection and bottled water from the ship. Ladies must wear skirts and cover their shoulders for the visit to the monastery; shorts are not permitted inside. Guests must be at least 18 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. When the ship is anchored in the bay, a walk of approximately one mile (1.2 kilometres) is required to reach the bus parking area.

JMK-D / Mykonos Town Highlights on Foot

Mykonos is probably the most well-known and talked about of all the Greek islands. Your guided walk will showcase both the lifestyle and the true history of this unique town.

Mykonos Town Walking Tour

Commence your walking tour through the narrow whitewashed streets; here you can appreciate the fact that its' confusing layout was designed to foil the attacking pirates. The picture-perfect "Little Venice", so called due to its striking resemblance in design to the famous canal city and the nearby windmills (an island trademark) offer wonderful photo opportunities.

Folklore Museum

Visit the Folklore Museum. Set in a traditional family house, a visit to this small but intriguing museum will provide an insight into the life of Mykonos in the 19th century.

Refreshment & Free Time (Optional)

Finally, do as the Mykonians and enjoy a refreshment of ouzo with some traditional 'mezedes'. Afterwards, you may return to the pier by shuttle service or you can choose to remain in town at your leisure and return back to the ship at your own convenience.

Please note: Tour involves an extensive amount of walking over cobbled and uneven surfaces. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or for those who utilise a wheelchair. We suggest guests wear lightweight, seasonal clothing, flat, walking shoes and sun protection.

Mykonian Spiti

Depart pier for a short drive to the Mykonian Spiti where you will be invited into the local's beautiful home. Learn about Mykonian culture and history through stories of local life that will make you feel as you are visiting close relatives or friends.

Taste Local Specialities

Upon arrival, you will be warmly welcomed with the traditional 'loukoumi' (Greece's very own version of Turkish delight), and a cheery glass of Teta's liqueur. You will get a chance to taste some of local specialties, such as rusk with 'kopanisti' (a local cheese), louza (a local smoked ham), tomatoes and olives, along with locally-made wine and raki.

Cooking Lesson & Lunch

Next, tour the kitchen and garden Patio and learn how to cultivate your own vegetables all year-round. You will be guided through the whole procedure, giving the opportunity to understand their Greek cooking skills. During your cooking lesson you'll learn how to make Greek spinach pie, stuffed tomatoes and peppers and the famous Greek dip, tzatziki. Afterwards, indulge in a delicious lunch and relish the fruits of your labor.

Mykonos Town

Once back in Mykonos, enjoy a guided walking tour through this picturesque town with a labyrinth-like maze of tiny streets, white houses and red-roofed churches. Don't be fooled by its small size; it is one of the most cosmopolitan towns of the Aegean. But despite the many shops, boutiques and stylish cafes, the town has not lost its charm and the island's strict building regulations have kept its Cycladic architectural style beautifully intact. Your walk through the narrow, winding streets introduces you to some of the area's most treasured landmarks. Mykonos experience would not be complete without the opportunity to taste a local locoum accompanied by mastic liqueur.

Ano Mera, Monastery Visit, Greek Lunch

Next, board your coach and continue your island discovery with a scenic drive through the rocky countryside. Visit the charming village of Ano Mera at the center of the island, home to the lovely Panagia Tourliani Monastery, built by monks in 1542 and dedicated to the Virgin Mary. The monastery features wonderful, unique island architecture, an ornately-carved marble fountain in the courtyard and a carved wooden screen in the church that was imported from Florence. After a guided tour of the site, proceed for a Greek typical lunch with wine at a local tavern where a folkloric show will take place.

At the end, re-board your coach for a return drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking on uneven ground and cobblestones. Exploration of the archaeological site of Delos is entirely on-foot. It is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. The trip to-and-from Delos is via local ferry boat on seas that may be choppy at times. Mykonos, Town Centre, Guided Culinary Walking Tour

Depart the pier for the short transfer to Mykonos. Upon arrival at the coach parking area, join your local culinary guide for a stroll to the town centre, and begin your gastronomic walking tour through the tiny streets and alleys of Mykonos.

Local Landmarks & Tastings

Along the way, pass by the signature landmarks and whitewashed wonders of Mykonos, and stop by five unique eateries specialising in delectable Greek specialities. Among the savoury local treats to be sampled at each venue are pork 'souvlaki', 'locoum', a variety of Greek appetisers, and a deliciously sweet and sticky vanilla dessert.

Optional Shopping and Exploring in Mykonos Town

At the conclusion of your culinary walking tour, you can walk back to the coach parking area, re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier, or choose to remain in Mykonos Town for shopping and further exploration, and return to the pier at your own expense.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.55 miles (about 2.5 kilometres), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and five steps at the entrance to the bakery. This tour is not suitable for guests with food allergies, guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection, bottled water and local currency for purchases from the ship. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is very limited; we suggest you book in advance to avoid disappointment.

Discover one of the world's most beautiful ancient cities during this scenic and memorable half-day excursion to Ephesus.

Ephesus

Depart the port for the scenic drive to the spectacular ancient city of Ephesus, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is one of the greatest outdoor museums in Turkey and perhaps in the world. Although now in ruins, it was originally founded by the Carian and Leleg native peoples. Magnificent vistas wait including Odeon Theatre, Hadrian Temple, the glorious Celsus Library façade, Terrace Houses and the Grand Amphitheatre. The Odeon Theatre had a seating capacity of about 1,500 seats. Built in 150 A.D., it was primarily used for small plays, concerts and official public ceremonies. The Hadrian Temple was dedicated in 118 AD to both Hadrian and to the goddess Artemis; it underwent reconstruction in the 4th century. This impressive Corinthian-style temple has beautiful reliefs on the porch. According to the belief of the Ephesians, the head of Medusa on the porch would protect the city from invaders and enemies.

Terrace Houses

Next, continue on to the recently-renovated Terrace Houses. They were inhabited by wealthy Ephesians, and are finely decorated with incredible mosaics and frescoes. The Terrace Houses were discovered in excavations carried out since the 1980s by a team of Austrian archaeologists. Along with those in Pompeii, they constitute some of the most vivid examples of Roman domestic architecture to survive today.

Celsus Library

The library is the best preserved structure of its kind. The inscription on the side of the building's front staircase states that the library was built by Julius, in his father's honor, after his death. His father, Celsus, was the Roman governor of Asia Minor early in the 2nd century AD; Celsus' sarcophagus is buried beneath the library.

Great Theatre

In the 1st century AD, it was successfully reconstructed and expanded by the Romans until it reached the seating capacity of 25,000. This is also the place where it is believed that St. Paul preached. It is believed to be the largest theatre in the ancient world.

At the end of the tour, re-board your coach for the return drive to Kusadasi. Upon arrival, you may opt to return directly onboard or to remain in town at your leisure.

Please note: This tour involves extensive walking for approximately 1.36 miles (about 2.2 kilometres), with many steps (over 200) in the terrace houses section of Ephesus and is not recommended for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Ancient Ephesus

You will get a chance to explore of what used to be one of the largest Mediterranean cities in the first century BC. See the most magnificent structure in Ephesus, which is the breathtaking Great Theatre. This was first constructed in the Hellenistic Period, in the third century BC, but it was enlarged and formed to its current style during the Roman Period. Throughout time, it was used not only for concerts and plays but also for religious, political and philosophical discussions and for gladiator and animal fights. While here, you will also see the Theatre Gymnasium which used to house lobbies, warm bathing pools, recreation rooms and halls for training.

Celsus Library

During your tour, see the exquisite Celsus Library. Built in 135 B.C. by a son in homage to his father, this magnificent library is lavishly decorated with facades, columns and sculptures. The library once housed 12,000 scrolls of papyrus manuscripts, making it one of the largest in the ancient world and second only to the library in Alexandria, Egypt.

Following your visit, re-board your accessible van for the return drive to the port.

The museum is recognized as one of the finest of its kind in the world. It contains many objects discovered by submarine archaeology, including amphora and large copper ingots recovered from a ship, which sank by Cape Gelidonya. Some of the relics once belonged to ancient vessels that foundered off Bodrum. In the

Shipwreck Hall there is an outstanding collection of hundreds of colorful, almost phosphorescent glass jars, bottles and vases, salvaged from shipwrecks.

Following your visit, re-join your transport for the return drive to the pier and your awaiting ship.

Turkish Coast

Living in Bodrum between the two World Wars, Turkish writer Cevat Sakir Kabaagac wrote an account of his idyllic sailing excursions along the Turkish coast, an area completely untouched by tourism at the time.Kabaagac entitled his book Mavi Yolculuk (Blue Voyage), and any cruise along this coast now shares that name.

Wooden Gulet

From the Bodrum pier, a short shuttle ride transfers you to the marina where you board the traditional Turkish 'Gullet.'The locally crafted gulet's are built of pinewood and feature pointed bows and rounded sterns.

Karaada/ Black Island

Admire Karaada, or Black Island, which is the large hump-backed island you will leaving Bodrum. In calm weather you will see bubbles rising up into a sea-cave in the rocks, where a hot spring said to have therapeutic qualities and fine grey mud is reputed to have been used by beauty guru Elizabeth Arden for some very expensive facial mudpacks.

Swimming

Doric Temple of Athena Lindia, a double-winged portico, a

Byzantine church and the fortifications of the Knights, including the remains of the Governor's quarters. Next, enjoy some free time in Lindos before re-boarding your coach for approximate 40-minute drive back to the Old town of Rhodes.

Lunch, Rhodes Old Town & Grand Masters Palace

Upon arrival, leave your coach and proceed to a typical restaurant located in the square right in the medieval town for a Greek lunch. Afterwards, take a guided walking tour through the streets of the Knights of St. John of Jerusalem, and visit the Palace of the Grand Masters which served as a wartime fortress, a peacetime residence for the Grand Master and a meeting place for senior knights.

The tour concludes back at the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking on cobblestone streets and uphill areas, with many steps to negotiate. A walk of approximately ten minutes is required to reach the Lindos village from the coach parking area; its centre allows only pedestrian and donkey-borne traffic. The 290 steps to the fortress have no railing. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and those who utilise a wheelchair. Wear light-weight clothing and bring sun protection. Scenic Drive and Grand Masters Palace

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximate 30-minute drive to Rhodes. En route, pass by the old port of Mandraki, and stop for photos at Agios Stefanos, which offers lovely views over the Bay of Rhodes. Upon arrival in Rhodes, enter the Old Town from D'Amboise Gate, the closest point to the Palace of the Grand Masters. A visit is then made to the palace, which served as a wartime fortress, a peacetime residence for the Grand Master and a meeting place for senior knights.

Old City Walking Tour

Next, take a guided walking tour along the cobblestone streets of the Avenue of the Knights, where the knights once lived. To this day, the street exudes a noble and forbidden aura; its lofty buildings stretch in a 1,968-foot-long (600-metre-long) unbroken wall of honey-coloured stone blocks, and its flat façade is punctuated by huge doorways and arched windows.

Archaeological Museum

A visit is then made to the Archaeological Museum, which is housed in the 15th-century Knights Hospital. Here, see many artefacts and exquisite statues dating back as far as the 4th century B.C. The most famous exhibit in the museum is the parian marble statue, the Aphrodite of Rhodes. At the conclusion of your tour, you may opt to re-board the coach for the brief drive back to the pier, or remain in town for further exploration and return to the ship on your own.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.5 miles (about 0.8 kilometres) on cobblestone streets, with approximately 50 steps to negotiate at the Palace of the Grand Masters. Scenic Drive and Old Town Walk

This first hour reveals sights like Mandraki Harbour, beloved for its deer statues and ancient windmills, and sensational views over the island from a stop at Monte Smith, home to the Acropolis ruins.

Switching to pedestrian mode, enter Old Town on foot through the impressive archway at D'Amboise Gate. For the next half-hour, enjoy a guided wander through Europe's largest active medieval enclave \ a UNESCO World Heritage Site revered for its fabulously preserved cobblestone lanes and Street of the Knights, lined with 16th and 17th-century inns.

Greek Cooking Experience

Having feasted on multiple landmarks, we walk to a nearby restaurant for a nourishing session focused on the making and enjoyment of traditional Greek cuisine. Alongside a seasoned chef, learn how to prep, cook, serve, and savour a traditional meze \ that delicious assortment of hearty appetizer plates the Greeks do so well. Depending on availability of ingredients that day, these might include tzatziki, eggplant salad, greek salad, moussaka, or savory soutzoukakia meatballs. To quench your thirst, local wine, beer, soft drinks, or water will be served . Post-feast, the walk back to the ship takes barely 15 minutes.

The tour concludes with the return drive back to the pier.

In prehistoric times, the people who inhabited what today is known as Santorini, called the island Strongoli (round). These people enjoyed a high standard of living; they built two-story houses, tilled the earth and were skilled artists, recognizing the beauty of colour. Discover the excavation site of famed Akrotiri during this half-day tour.

Akrotiri Excavations

Depart the ship by a local tender to Athinios, where you join the waiting motor-coach. Enjoy your scenic drive to the southern end of the island and the archaeological site of Akrotiri. A volcanic eruption circa 1,600 BC destroyed all life on the island, and the island itself sank beneath the waves. The excavations here, led by Professor Spyros Marinos, began in 1967 and document the existence of life on Strongoli, legendary Atlantis; although no written records have ever surfaced to support this. It is an amazing city with houses, streets, squares and workshops, all of which had been covered under a thick blanket of pumice for over 3,500 years. You are able to walk around this ancient city among well-preserved buildings, which will give you an insight into the ancient civilization of Santorini, the center of a civilization akin to the Minoans of Crete.

Akrotiri Village

After the tour of the excavations discover the nearby village and explore one of the 5 fortified settlements on the island in medieval times. At the end of tour, return through the beautiful countryside back to the port of Athinios where your tender will await to take you to the ship.

Please note: This tour involves moderate walking and is not suitable for guests in wheelchairs or with limited mobility. Guests should wear seasonal clothing, flat walking shoes and sun protection. A brief stop here, the highest point of the island, offers a spectacular panorama of the caldera below. Re-board your coach for the drive to Oia.

Village of Oia

Nestled in a fertile countryside, the village of Oia is among the most picturesque towns of the Cyclades Islands. This dramatic little village, built on a steep slope of the caldera, has many of its dwellings nestled in niches hewn into the volcanic rock. Once the home of wealthy seafarers of the past; still evident are their two story mansions painted in a spectrum of pastel colors. As you traverse its narrow cobbled streets you will come across many tiny shops which offer a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewelry. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

Canava Distillery & Ouzo Tasting

Departing Oia, your next stop is at Canava distillery & museum. Here, guests can enjoy a visit of the distillery, with its antique distilling equipment, and a stroll through the museum. Within the newly-restored home, guests can see its recreated workplaces and rooms reflective of the people in Santorini's recent past. Every room is replicated using original items tirelessly collected over the years. Afterward, enjoy a taste of the spirits produced in Santorini's first distillery. Guests wishing to purchase some products can do so (please note that credit cards are not accepted).

At the end of tour, return through the beautiful countryside back to the port of Athinios where your tender will await to take you to the ship.

Akrotiri Excavations

Depart the ship by a local tender to Athinios, where you join the waiting motor-coach. Enjoy your scenic drive to the southern end of the island and the archaeological site of Akrotiri. A volcanic eruption circa 1,600 BCE destroyed all life on the island, and the island itself sank beneath the waves. The excavations here, led by Professor Spyros Marinos, began in 1967 and document the existence of life on Strongoli, legendary Atlantis; although no written records have ever surfaced to support this. It is an amazing city with houses, streets, squares and workshops, all of which had been covered under a thick blanket of pumice for over 3,500 years. You are able to walk around this ancient city among well-preserved buildings, which will give you an insight into the ancient civilization of Santorini, the center of a civilization akin to the Minoans of Crete.

Venetsanos Winery & Wine Tasting, Panoramic Views, Local Tavern & Lunch

After your visit, continue to Venetsanos Winery where you will sample the famous Santorini wines and admire panoramic views of the Caldera of Santorini. Continue to a local tavern where your lunch awaits and taste Greek delicacies.

Village of Oia & Free Time

Depart for the scenic drive to the northern tip of the island, and a visit to Oia. This quaint little village was once the home of wealthy seafarers of the past, and features beautiful old cliff-side mansions and houses. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour through the narrow cobbled streets of Oia. Following your walking tour, enjoy free time for additional independent

exploration. See many tiny shops offering a varied and unusual collection of handmade works of ceramic art, paintings and semi-precious jewelry. Coffee shops perched on the edge of the cliffs offer spectacular views of Fira and the volcano.

Mountain of Prophet Elijah, Clifftop Views, Pyrgos Village, Castle and Churches

After transferring to Athinios via ship's tender, board a coach for the scenic, approximately 30-minute drive along the rocky sides of the caldera on your way to the island's highest point, the Mountain of Prophet Elijah. Upon arrival, marvel at the clifftop view of the deep blue sea surrounding island and volcanic caldera of Santorini, and your ship in the distance. Continue on to Pyrgos, a hilltop village that served as the capital of the island until the early-1800s. It is comprised of traditional houses built around the Venetian castle, and its small streets follow the shape of the hill. Some free time is made available to climb from the square up to Pyrgos Castle, view the stone houses densely packed together, visit any of the village's 33 churches, stroll through the labyrinth of narrow, vaulted lanes, or simply relax and enjoy a coffee at a local café.

Megalochori Village, Mansions, Traditional House, Narrow Alleyways, Wine Canavas

Next, re-board your coach and head to Megalochori. This beautiful village is home to historical mansions, restored old traditional houses built into the rock and narrow alleyways, pirate hideaways and wine canavas. It also has a history of merchants and wealthy land barons exporting Vinsanto wine, which is still produced on the island. A great effort is been made by local residents and businessmen to preserve the characteristics and beauty of this traditional settlement, and many of the original houses that had fallen into disrepair have been restored to their former glory. Upon arrival, some free time is made available to explore the village with your guide.

SDH-F / Agia Triada Monastery, Akrotiri & Chania Old Town

Visit the renaissance Agia Triada Monastery as well as the Venizelos Tombs, the resting place of the famous Greek statesman Eleftherios Venizelos and his son, Sophocles and at the end explore the charming old town of Chania.

Agia Triada Monastery

Sit back, relax and enjoy a short scenic drive, passing olive groves and vineyards along the Akrotiri Peninsula. A visit to this region is not complete without visiting one of the most impressive Venetian period monasteries. Enjoy the tranquil atmosphere and stunning views as you visit Agia Triada Monastery. The fortress like complex is one of the best examples of the Cretan Renaissance. Over the centuries, the complex has been expanded and now contains a large church, seminary and vaulted storerooms, all meticulously maintained. The monastery also produces a revered olive oil and several varieties of wine.

British Commonwealth Cemetery

Afterwards, a short photo stop is made at the British Commonwealth Cemetery, a resting place of soldiers who fought the Battle of Crete during the World War II.

Venizelos Tombs

Continue to the tombs of Eleftherios Venizelos, a charismatic political figure who fought for Cretan independence, and his son, Sophocles. As Prime Minister, he was profoundly influential in the founding of modern Greece, until his death in 1936. From his modest, unadorned tomb, you will have a panoramic views of Chania, your next stop.

Chania Old Town

Upon arrival in the old city of Chania, follow your guide on a walking tour. Walk through the irresistible Old Town admiring the architecture, becoming immersed in Crete's history, and later, enjoying the bounty of shops around the harbor. Learn about Chania's Roman, Byzantine, Venetian and Ottoman past. Admire Venetian and Ottoman monuments and delve into the old Jewish and Ottoman districts. With its Venetian Harbor, the old port, the narrow shopping streets and waterfront restaurants the old town attracts hordes of visitors and locals alike. The atmosphere has a touch of Florence and Venice, with an ambience combined with the culture and character of Cretan people and traditions.

Afterwards, guests may remain in town for further exploration and return back to the pier with a shuttle bus.

Please note: This tour includes an extensive amount of walking and standing. There are some uneven surfaces and steps to negotiate. Arkadi Monastery

Depart the pier and drive approximately 90-minutes east onto a fertile plain towards the acclaimed Arkadi Monastery built in 1587. Constructed of honey-colored stone in a Renaissance style, the monastery has played a significant role in Cretan history. It has long been a pilgrimage site and a symbol of resistance after being attacked by Turkish troops in 1866. Many of the items from that conflict, including weapons and military banners, are proudly displayed in the monastery's small museum. There are also a number of religious objects, the highlight being a 17th-century vestment embroidered in gold that depicts Christ and the 12 disciplines.

Rethymnon, Walking Tour & Free Time

Afterwards, continue your tour to Rethymnon. This region as a whole is rich with ancient history, most notably through the Minoan civilisation centred at Kydonia east of Rethymnon. Rethymnon itself began a period of growth when the Venetian conquerors of the island decided to put an intermediate commercial station between Heraklion and Chania, acquiring its own bishop and nobility in the process. Today's old town is almost entirely built by Venetians. It is one of the best preserved old towns in Crete. The town still maintains its old aristocratic appearance, with its buildings dating from the 16th century, arched doorways, stone staircases, Byzantine and Hellenic-Roman remains, small Venetian harbor and narrow streets.

After a walking tour in the old town, enjoy some free time to explore this beautiful city on your own before meeting your guide and boarding your coach for the return journey.

Please note: This tour includes a moderate amount of walking over uneven surfaces with steps to negotiate. The tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilize a wheelchair. Manousakis Winery Visit

Arrive at Manousakis Winery, only recently opened to the public for tours and tastings. The generous stone multi-level home and rolling hills of vineyards place you back in time, part of a family tradition that has been carried on for generations. Stroll through the beautiful garden as your guide shares with you the history and process of wine making as well as the history of this place, which began as a traditional residence before opening to the public.

Wine Tasting & Snacks

Learn where the wines are produced and bottled and see the cellar where the wines age to their perfect vintage. You will get a chance to taste five of the Maousakis wines and learn what makes them so spectacular as you sample them, paired with delicious Cretan cheeses and the traditional Cretan wheat rusks.

At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your jeeps for approximately 1-hour drive back to the pier.
